The **Vice-Chancellor** would be appointed as per provisions laid down in Section 20(5) of the Bihar Agricultural University Act, 2010, which States that "*the Vice Chancellor's shall hold office for a term of five years from the date on which he enters upon his office or until he/she attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier*".

The essential qualification for the post should be as ten years of experience of working in the grade of Professor/ Principal Scientist out of which, five years should be as Dean/Director / equivalent or higher positions.

The Chancellor's Secretariat invites applications from eligible academicians, for the post of Vice-Chancellor of the Bihar Agricultural University, Sabour. All necessary details are available on the website of Chancellor's Secretariat, Bihar, governor.bih.nic.in.



Search-Committee may invite short listed applicants with higher merits for a presentation and /or personal interaction, for which no TA/DA shall be paid.
