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ORDINANCE FOR ADMISSION

1. Admission and Selection procedure

- 1.1 The selection of candidates for admission to the Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) in Regular mode shall be made on the basis of merit obtained in B.El.Ed. Entrance Test conducted by the University.
- 1.2 The Entrance Test fee may be revised by the statutory bodies of the University with the Approval of the Hon'ble Chancellor.
- 1.3 Admission shall be made strictly in order of merit i.e. percentage of marks secured by the candidate at the B.El.Ed. Entrance Test held for the purpose.
- 1.4 Reservation of seats for the candidates of reserved categories shall be as per State Government's rules.
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1.5 5% seats will be reserved for person with disability (PWD) Candidate i.e. Visually Impaired (1%), Hearing impaired (1%) & Orthopedically Handicapped or Martyr's of sanik ward (Wife, Son or Daughter) (1%). 3% seats are within the intake limit percentage of disability will be taken into consideration at the time of selection.
- 1.6 Appearance at the Entrance Test is mandatory. The reserved category candidates shall have to submit a copy of the certificate mentioning that the candidate belongs to a particular reserved category issued by Block/ Anchal/SDM level.
- 1.7 Joint B.El.Ed. Entrance Test will be conducted centrally by the University. Date of B.El.Ed. Entrance Test will be announced by the University and Merit List will also be prepared by the University after evaluation of answer Books.
Admission merit lists shall be prepared by th University and seats allotment will be done through counselling.
- 1.8 List of admitted students must be submitted to the University within one month after deceleration of merit list.

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- 2.2 Candidates with at least 50% Marks in the senior secondary/+2 or it's equivalent are eligible for admission.
- 2.3 However , there shall be relaxation of 5% marks for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/ Differently Abled persons /Women or any other category as per the rules of the States Government .
- 2.4 The reservations policy of the State Government shall be followed in the process of admission .

3. Intake

There shall be a two units of basically 50 students in each. This intake capacity will be modified as per norms and guidelines prescribed by NCTE time to Time in accordance with the approval of University.

4. Fee

- 4.1 The fee structure for the four years B.El.Ed. course will be decided after every three years by the statutory bodies of the University in accordance with the approval of the Hon'ble Chancellor. After three years revision of fee will be for new entrance.

- 4.2 Every students fee per year – 69000/-.


Total fee for Four(04) years B.El.Ed. course – Rs. 2,76,000/- as also approved draft Ordinance and regulation for B.A., B.Sc., B.Ed. integrated 4 years course.

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BACHELOR OF ELEMENTARY EDUCATION (B.El.Ed.) DEGREE PROGRAMME

REGULAR MODE

Regulation and ordinance for admission in 4-Year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) Degree programme under Universities of Bihar.

Regulation

1. Preamble :

- 1.1 This regulation shall be called regulation for B. El. Ed. Course and shall be implemented with effect from 2018-19.
- 1.2 The Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) is a Four-Year professional degree programme of teacher education offered after passing Senior Secondary Examination.
- 1.3 It aims to prepare teachers for the elementary stage of education, i.e. for class I to VIII.
- 1.4 In addition, the programme prepares students for wide range of professional and academic options in elementary education including teaching for elementary school systems in various capacities; teaching and research in elementary education in the government and non-government sector, pursuing post-graduate and research studies in education and other disciplines and working as teacher educators in Universities offering programmes in elementary education.
- 1.5 The B.El.Ed. programme shall be offered only in a Govt./constituent/affiliated college of a University offering undergraduate studies recognised by NCTE for this course.

2. Duration of course :

- 2.1 There shall be of a minimum duration of four academic Years, including a school internship of a minimum of 20 working weeks of which 4 working weeks shall be in the third year of study and 16 working weeks shall be in the fourth/final year of study.
- 2.2 Candidates admitted in this programme shall complete the final year examination within six years from the year of admission. It is mandatory for all the 4-year B.El.Ed. programme candidates to pass the examination within 6 years from the date of admission. A candidate who fails in maximum two papers of the first/second/third year, he/she has to pass all

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such exam papers (first/second/third year) before appearing in the final year examination.

- 2.3 There shall be at least two hundred working days each year exclusive of admission and conduct of examination and inclusive of the period of classroom transaction, practicum, engaging with schools and school internship.
- 2.4 The Institution shall work for a minimum of thirty six hours in a week (Five/Sixdays), during which faculty shall be available for the requirements of the programme including interaction and mentoring with students.
- 2.5 The minimum attendance of student-teachers shall be 80% for theory papers and 90% for school-internship and practicum.

3. Curriculum

The curriculum of B.El.Ed. is to be designed to intergrate the study of subject knowledge of honours level, human development, pedogogical knowledge and communication skills. The programme shall comprise of compulsory and optional theory courses; compulsory practicum courses and a comprehensive school internship. As an integral part of the teaching programme, each institution shall arrange for field tours and visits to centres of innovative activity in elementary school education.

The B.El.Ed. curriculum seeks to prepare teachers for the elementary level of schooling through a programme curriculum which interweaves subject content with pedagogy and integrates practicum with theory, ICT/gender, yoga education and disability/inclusive education shall form an integral part of the B.El.Ed. curriculum.

The institutions imparting instructions shall follow the scheme of programmes given below:-

- In Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany and Geography paper H4 and H8 will be practical papers.

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4. Registration

Any such students who is not registered with the respective University shall have to get himself/herself registered with that University on payment of the required fee as decided by the university. The students who are not registered under the respective university shall not be allowed to appear at the examination.

5. Examination

5.1 To be permitted to appear at the examination for the Degree of the Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.), a candidate must have :

- Completed the course of study prescribed for the B.El.Ed. programme.
- Registered with the respective university as a student.
- Completed minimum 80% attendance in theory classes and minimum 90% in school internship and practicum of the total classes held.
- Completed the course in a maximum six years from the date of admission to the programme.

5.2 A candidate for B.El.Ed. degree shall be examined in twenty six papers carrying total of 2400 marks (600 per year).

- There shall be eight Honours papers carrying 100 marks each (80 marks for Theory and 20 marks for Internal assessment).
- There shall be eight core foundation papers and four pedagogy of school subjects carrying 100 marks each (80 marks for Theory and 20 marks for Internal assessment). The distribution of marks is indicated in the concerned tables.
- There shall be one optional paper to be offered for school's pedagogy subject (VI to VIII) for upper primary school such as Social Science/Science/Maths/Language carrying 100 marks (80 marks for Theory and 20 marks for Internal assessment).
- Internal assessment for all the theory papers (Honours, Foundation and Pedagogy) will be evaluated on the basis of individual/group assignments, observation records, diaries, etc as per NCTE guideline 2014 {4.6(iii)}.
- There shall be four Enhancing Professional Capacity (EPC) papers. on the basis of academic records of students 40 marks will be evaluated internally and 10 marks will be evaluated externally on the performance of students in the viva-voce and observation of the academic records. (40 marks internally and 10 marks externally).
- There shall be school Internship programme for 100 marks in Third year (evaluated internally) and 400 marks in Fourth year. The marks shall be

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awarded on the basis of overall performance of the student-teachers in the school during internship programme. The institution shall maintain cumulative record of activities of each student-teacher during internship programme for the assessment of overall performance for 300 marks. 100 marks will be evaluated by the external examiner in two pedagogical subjects; One from class I to V and one from the optional for class VI to VIII, selected by the student-teacher.

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5.3 The Written examination in each of the theoretical Honours papers, core papers and pedagogy of school subjects including optional papers 80 marks shall be of three-hour duration and 40 marks shall be of two-hour duration.

5.4 For the evaluation of school internship programme, there shall be provision of one external examiners to be appointed by the university after completion on school Intership programme in Fourth/ Last year.

5.5 If candidate who has completed the course, fails to appear at the examination or fails to pass the examination, shall be allowed to take subsequent examination on payment of prescribed examination fee without being required to repeat the course again. However, this opportunity shall be given only in two more examinations, within a period not exceeding six years from the date of admission.

5.6 A candidate shall be allowed to appear in the final/last examination of B.El.Ed. course only if he/she clears the First/Second/Third year examination.

6 Conduct of Examination and Moderation of Results :

6.1 The Examination shall be conducted by the University. The university shall finalise the programme for the examination and will charge the approved examination fee to conduct the examination.

6.2 In order to pass Bachelor of Elementary Examination a candidate shall have to obtain at least 45% marks in each theory paper seperately and 50% marks in practicum papers. The minimum aggregate pass marks will be 50% i.e. 1200 marks out of 2400 marks.

6.3 The name of Successful candidates shall be arranged in order of merit as follows:-

6.4 All student-teachers are required to go for school Internship programme for four weeks in third year and sixteen weeks in fourth year to different elementary schools for practical exposure.

7 Award of Degree :

Those who complete the programme successfully shall be awarded Bachelor of Elementary Education degree by the respective university in prescribed format specifying the class/Division/Grade in which he/she was placed.
