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
ORDINANCE FOR ADMISSION

**1. Admission and Selection procedure**

- 1.1 The selection of candidates for admission to the Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) in Regular mode shall be made on the basis of merit obtained in B.El.Ed. Entrance Test conducted by the University.
- 1.2 The Entrance Test fee may be revised by the statutory bodies of the University with the Approval of the Hon'ble Chancellor.
- 1.3 Admission shall be made strictly in order of merit i.e. percentage of marks secured by the candidate at the B.El.Ed. Entrance Test held for the purpose.
- 1.4 Reservation of seats for the candidates of reserved categories shall be as per State Government's rules.
- 1.5 5% seats will be reserved for person with disability (PWD) Candidate i.e. Visually Impaired (1%),Hearing impaired (1%) & Orthopedically Handicapped or Martyr's of sanik ward (Wife, Son or Daughter) (1%) . 3% seats are within the intake limit percentage of disability will be taken into consideration at the time of selection.
- 1.6 Appearance at the Entrance Test is mandatory. The reserved category candidates shall have to submit a copy of the certificate mentioning that the candidate belongs to a particular reserved category issued by Block/ Anchal/SDM level .
- 1.7 Joint B.El.Ed. Entrance Test will be conducted centrally by the University. Date of B.El.Ed. Entrance Test will be announced by the University and Merit List will also be prepared by the University after evaluation of answer Books.  
Admission merit lists shall be prepared by th University and seats allotment will be done through counselling.
- 1.8 List of admitted students must be submitted to the University within one month after deceleration of merit list.

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- 1.9 Reservation of Seats provided in the general ordinance for admission shall be applicable only when candidates fulfils the minimum requirements of clause 1.3
- 1.10 ✓ That the selection of candidates for admission to the Bachelor of Elementary Education ( B.El.Ed.) in regular mode shall be made on the basis of merit obtained in B.El.Ed. Entrance Test conducted by the University. Entrance Test shall be conducted for single setting of (3) Three hours . Duration for one paper of 100 marks containing 100 multiple Choice questions of general Knowledge and Inter level knowledge test.
- 1.11 That the minimum qualifying cut off marks in entrance test shall be 42% for Unreserved category and 36% for reserved category.
- 1.12 The name of successful candidate shall be arrange in order of merit as follows :-

Percentage of Marks	Grade
Above 85%	'O' (Outstanding)
Above 75% & Up to 85%	'A+' (Excellent)
Above 65% & Up to 75%	'A' (Very Good)
Above 55% & Up to 65%	'B' (Good)
50% & Up to 55%	'C' (Average)
Less than 50%	'D' (Fail)

- 1.13 If at any time it is found that candidate has furnished any false information , his/her admission will be cancelled and the deposited fee shall forfeited and suitable legal action may be initiated
- 1.14 In case of any dispute or irregularity pertaining to four years B.El.Ed. Programme, The respective University shall take the final decision as per approved Ordinance and Regulations.

**2. Eligibility**

- 2.1 Admission shall be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination / entrance examination.

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- 2.2 Candidates with at least 50% Marks in the senior secondary/+2 or it's equivalent are eligible for admission.
- 2.3 However , there shall be relaxation of 5% marks for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/ Differently Abled persons /Women or any other category as per the rules of the States Government .
- 2.4 The reservations policy of the State Government shall be followed in the process of admission .

**3. Intake**

There shall be a two units of basically 50 students in each. This intake capacity will be modified as per norms and guidelines prescribed by NCTE time to Time in accordance with the approval of University.

**4. Fee**

4.1 The fee structure for the four years B.El.Ed. course will be decided after every three years by the statutory bodies of the University in accordance with the approval of the Hon'ble Chancellor. After three years revision of fee will be for new entrance.

4.2 **Every students fee per year – 69000/-.**  
**Total fee for Four(04) years B.El.Ed. course – Rs. 2,76,000/-** as also approved draft Ordinance and regulation for B.A., B.Sc., B.Ed. integrated 4 years course.
