If the appellant fails to appear at the scheduled hearing of the instant appeal, it will be presumed that he is satisfied with the reply given by the PIO, and, accordingly, the instant appeal will be decided on merits and in the light of documents available on the records of the instant appeal.</p> <p>5. The appellant is requested to bring with him a legally valid photo identity-card in original issued by the Central/State Govt. so as to enable the undersigned to request the Security in-Charge of Raj Bhawan to allow his entry to the official chamber of the undersigned located inside the Raj Bhawan Premises as per the established security protocol of the Raj Bhawan, Bihar.</p> <p>6.
