NOTIFICATION

Whereas, eligible students admitted to 4-Year Choice-Based Credit System Under Graduate Programmes will progress to the 1st Year of 2-Year Post Graduate Programmes;

And whereas, the Syllabi of various Subjects taught in Post Graduate Programmes in the 13 (traditional) Universities had yet not been notified;

And whereas, the Subject Experts have prepared the Syllabi of the following 46 Subjects for Semester-I and Semester-II of the 1st Year of 2-Year Post Graduate Programmes and have duly been vetted by the Subject Experts:

And whereas, the duly-vetted Syllabi of the above 46 Subjects were sent to the Universities for approval by their respective Statutory Bodies (i.e., the Academic Council and the Syndicate) in accordance with the First Proviso to S.-39 (2) (ii) of the BSU Act, 1976 and the identical provision of the First Proviso to S.39 (2) (ii) of the Patna University Act, 1976, as also to the Bihar State Higher Education Council for its opinion in accordance with the provisions of S.-11 (2) (v) of the BSHEC Act, 2017;

And whereas, most of the 13 (traditional) Universities have conveyed the approval of their respective Statutory Bodies (i.e., the Academic Council and the Syndicate) to the Syllabi of the above 46 Subject;

And whereas some of the 13 (traditional) Universities are to still convey the approval of their respective Statutory Bodies (i.e., the Academic Council and the Syndicate);

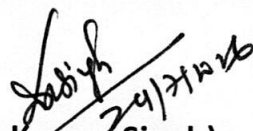
And whereas, the Bihar State Higher Education Council is still not conveyed its opinion;

And whereas, there is urgency to accord approval to the Syllabi of the above 46 Subjects at the earliest so that the students progressing to the First Year Post Graduate Programmes in July, 2026 do not suffer, they get orientation/induction of the Syllabi at the very outset of their studies in Post Graduate Programmes and the officials of the Universities also get some reasonable time to make necessary arrangements.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Hon'ble Chancellor in him by the First Proviso to Section-39 (2) (ii) of the Bihar State University Act, 1976 and the identical provision of the First Proviso to Section-39 (2) (ii) of the Patna University Act, 1976, and all other enabling provisions obtaining in this behalf, the Hon'ble Chancellor is pleased to assent to the Syllabi of 46 above Subjects with the following **two conditions**:

- i. the Universities, **which have thus far not obtained the approval of their Statutory Bodies** (i.e., the Academic Council & the Syndicate), in accordance with the First Proviso to S.-39 (2) (ii) of the BSU Act, 1976 and the identical provision of the First Proviso to S.39 (2) (ii) of the Patna University Act, 1976, **must obtain the approval of the Statutory Bodies** (i.e., the Academic Council & the Syndicate) **before commencing studies in the afore-noted 46 Subjects**; and
- ii. the Universities must obtain the approval of their respective Senate in its Next Meeting, whenever it is held, to the above 46 Subjects.
