LEGAL SERVICES & AWARENESS STALL AT NANDASTHAMI MAHOTSAV, NAINITAL:

As per directions of the Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand SLSA, 08 days long campaign were carried out by the Uttarakhand SLSA in cooperation with DLSA Nainital in the regional fare namely **Nandashtami Mahotsav** at Nainital by setting-up a Legal Aid Services Stall at the said Nandasthami congregation from 10.09.2024 to 17.09.2024.

The Hon'ble Patron-in-Chief and Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand SLSA and Hon'ble Judges of the Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand, the Registrar General and Registrars of the Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand, Member Secretary, Officer on Special Duty, Uttarakhand SLSA, the District Judge/Chairperson and Secretary of DLSA Nainital, attended the legal services & awareness camp. Staff of Hon'ble High Court and Uttarakhand SLSA, PLVs and Panel Lawyers of DLSA Nainital were also participated in the said programme. Further, **07 Wheelchairs** provided to the disabled persons and **Certificates to Trainers and Trainee** participants; certificates and prize to winners of Painting and Drawing Competition were also provided by the Hon'ble Patron-in-Chief and Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand SLSA and by the Hon'ble Judges of the Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand.

It is also kindly submitted that the services of Panel Lawyers have also been made available to the legal aid seekers. During the period total 34 persons/litigants/legal aid seekers were benefited by writing their applications for legal aid, to avail scheme benefit, providing them legal aid/advice.

During the said campaign 1041 **Saral Kanooni Gyan Mala (SKGM)** booklets were picked-up/received by 347 visitors as per their requirements.





NATIONAL LOK ADALAT ORGANIZED ON 14.09.2024:

The National Lok Adalats, organized across State of Uttarakhand according to NALSA's annual calendar, have played a crucial role in bridging the gap between litigants and justice. This ensures speedy and cost-effective dispute resolution, promote social harmony and community cohesion, and enhance public trust in the judicial system. These initiatives have significantly contributed to making justice more accessible and efficient for all. During the period National Lok Adalat was organized on 14.09.2024 right from Hon'ble High Court to Outlying Courts.

By including pre-litigation cases in the National Lok Adalat framework, potential disputes were resolved at an early stage, effectively preventing them from escalating into formal court proceedings. This approach promotes quicker and more accessible justice, reducing the burden on the judicial system. In the said National Lok Adalat, total 12619 Pre-Litigation cases were taken-up and out of them **10648** cases were settled amicably and ₹ 19,05,52,601/- was as settlement amount.

In the said National Lok Adalat total 13576 Pending cases were referred and out of them total **12596** cases were settled amicably and a sum of ₹ 71,74,87,477/- was as settlement amount.

The National Lok Adalat was also organized in the Quasi-Judicial Courts such as Consumer Courts and Debt Recovery Tribunals on 14.09.2024. Total 96 cases were referred in such Quashi-Judicial Courts and out of them 94 were settled and ₹ 69,88,16,789/- was as settlement amount.

MEGA/MULTI-PURPOSE LEGAL SERVICES & AWARENESS CAMP:

During the period July to September, 2024 total 17 Multi-Purpose Legal Services & Awareness Programmes were organized by the District Legal Services Authorities throughout the State of Uttarakhand. **Out of above camps, 03 Multi-Purpose Legal Services & Awareness Programmes were organized in the benign presence of Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand SLSA, Nainital.**

During these Programmes/Camps 33 disabled persons were provided Wheelchair & Crutches, 155 persons were provided Hearing Aid Machine, 221 persons were get benefited by health check-up and 690 by providing medicine, 225 farmers/persons were get benefited by providing them Agriculture Package, 89 persons benefited by providing them different kind of Certificates through e-Services, Adhar Card Update, benefits of Disability Pension/Widow/Old AGE. Nukkad Natak on drug de-addiction, Anti-Drug Campaign were also presented by the students and others in few camps/programmes. People at large were also made aware about, National Legal Aid Helpline 15100; 112 Police Helpline Number and 1930 Cyber Helpline Number.

Various Government Departments have also set-up their stalls to provide benefits and information to the common mass about different kind of pension and Government Welfare Schemes and to resolve the issues related to their departments.





- In September, 2024 DLSA Pauri Garhwal, in collaboration with the District Administration, organized "Multi-purpose Legal Services & Awareness Camp" at GBPEIT Ghurdauri, Pauri Garhwal. The event was graced by the **Hon'ble Executive Chairman, UKLSA**, Nainital in presence of Director of GBPEIT Ghurdauri, as the main speaker/resource person. The camp aimed at educating the public on various legal services and rights, benefiting a total of 1000 participants.



- On 29.09.2024, DLSA Rudraprayag organized a Multi-Purpose Legal Services & Awareness Camp at the Multi-Purpose Sports Hall, Augustmuni, Rudraprayag. The event was held in the benign presence of the **Hon'ble Shri Justice Vivek Bharti Sharma**, Judge, Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand, Administrative Judge, District Rudraprayag, and was attended by the Secretary of DLSA, who served as the main speaker/resource person. The campaign aimed at raising awareness about the Multi-Purpose Legal Services & Awareness Act, focusing on providing legal support and educating the public about their rights and available legal resources.



- A mega Multi-Purpose Legal Services and Awareness Camp was organized on 26th July 2024, the Secretary of DLSA Almora organized in the remote and interior area of Chaukhutiya Block Office, following the NALSA module. The event was conducted in collaboration with various government departments under the district administration of Almora. The attendees were informed about a wide range of topics, including the rights of women and children, rights of persons with disabilities, Fundamental Rights and Duties, the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, the NALSA (Legal Services to Victims of Acid Attacks) Scheme 2016, the importance of cleanliness and trees, free legal aid, Child Helpline (1098), NALSA Helpline (15100), POCSO Act, the PoSH Act, gender sensitization, and more.



Additionally, a free medical checkup camp was organized in collaboration with the District Health Department Almora and Hedakhan Charitable Trust.



This camp provided disability certificates to several individuals, free eye checkups, and other medical services. Several government schemes were also extended to the attendees.



- On 28th July 2024, DLSA Chamoli, in collaboration with the District Administration, Police Administration, and Health Department, organized "**Mega/Multi-Purpose Legal Services & Awareness Camp**" and observe "**World Hepatitis Day**" at the G.I.C. Savreesen School ground in Tehsil Chamoli. The



event, led by the ADJ Karanprayag and Chairperson TLSC, and raise awareness on various issues, including constitutional provisions, cyber-crime, child welfare schemes, drug abuse, plastic waste management, POCSO, and women's rights. Key officials and panel lawyers participated as speakers. The camp saw a total of 956 attendees, with DLSA receiving 8 applications, while 12 were addressed by other departments. Additionally, 473 health check-ups were conducted, and free medicines (Allopathic, Homeopathic and Ayurvedic) were distributed.

- DLSA, Champawat organized, a multipurpose camp at Government Inter College Sipti, Champawat, on 28th July 2024. The camp provided legal information to the local community.



- In alignment with the directives and under the guidance of the District Judge/Chairman DLSA, Champawat, a comprehensive multipurpose camp was conducted at Government Inter College Sipti, Champawat, on 28th July 2024. The event also marked the observance of **World Hepatitis Day**, where participants were sensi-



tized and provided with crucial information regarding hepatitis, fostering greater awareness and understanding of the disease within the community.

- On July 23, 2024, the DLSA Dehradun organized a **multi-purpose** legal literacy and awareness camp at the Maharana Pratap Community Hall, Chhatriya Chetna Manch, Nanurkheda, Dehradun. The camp was inaugurated by Secretary DLSA Dehradun. The event saw the participation of representatives from



various Government and Non-Government departments, who provided detailed information about the schemes and services offered by their respective organizations. The camp aimed to raise awareness about legal rights, available welfare schemes, and other services that could benefit the local community. By engaging with the attendees, the representatives helped ensure that individuals were better informed about the legal and governmental resources available to them.

- DLSA, Pithoragarh organized a Multi-Purpose awareness camp in collaboration with Mission Inter College, Pithoragarh titled awareness on NALSA (legal services to victims of acid attacks)

The event was headed by Secretary DLS, Penal lawyer, Social Welfare Officer, District Probation Officer, District Education officer. The campaign aimed at raising awareness on the provisions of the Sexual Harassment of women at workplace Act, 2013, POCSO Act, transgender people, gender equality.

- Tehri Garhwal, in collaboration with various government departments, organized a Multi-Legal Awareness Programme at Government Inter College, Lambgaun, on 25th July 2024. Led by the Chairperson DLSA, the event focused on raising awareness about legal subjects such as NALSA schemes, the Indian Constitution, the POCSO



Act, Juvenile Justice Act, cyber-crimes, and women's protection from domestic violence. Key officials, including the Addl. District & Sessions Judge, C.J.M., Civil Judges, SDM Pratapnagar, Secretary DLSA, and members of the District Bar Associations, also participated.

- The **DLSA, Udham Singh Nagar** organized a Multi-Purpose Legal Services Programme on **31-07-2024** by adopting the newly designed “Legal Services Camp Module” of NALSA. The event was held at the Govt. Primary School Midanapur, Post-Majra Anand (Chakki Mod), Tehsil Gadarpur, Udham Singh Nagar. The programme aimed to



provide a range of legal services and raise awareness about legal rights

and resources available to the public, ensuring broader access to justice for the local community.



- On **27.07.2024**, the Secretary of DLSA, Uttarkashi organized a **Multi-Purpose** Legal Camp in Tehsil Purola, Uttarkashi. During the camp, the Secretary meticulously briefed the attendees on the array of services available through the NALSA Portal, emphasizing key initiatives such as NALSA Schemes and Free Legal Aid Assistance. The session also provided in-depth insights



into vital resources, including the Child Helpline Number, the Cyber Cell, the NALSA Toll-Free Number, and the Legal Services Authority App, ensuring that the public was thoroughly equipped with essential information to access



legal support and assistance effectively.

INAUGURATION OF LEGAL AID CLINIC:

A Legal Service Clinic has been opened at Sushila Tiwari Hospital, Haldwai which was inaugurated on 17.07.2024 by **Hon'ble Shri Justice Manoj Kumar Tiwari**, Hon'ble Executive Chairman UKSLSA, Nainital. On that day legal awareness camp was also organized at the newly inaugurated clinic wherein general public and doctors were apprised about concept of free legal aid, legal aid clinic, role of DLSA, and media conference was also organized on the above subject.



AWARENESS CAMP IN JAIL IN BENIGN PRESENCE OF HON'BLE EXECUTIVE CHAIRMAN, UKSLSA, NAINITAL:

A legal awareness camp was organized by DLSA Nainital at Sub-Jail Haldwani on 17.07.2024 in the benign presence of **Hon'ble Shri Justice Manoj Kumar Tiwari**, Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand SLA, Nainital where in the issues raised by prisoners were addressed and they were also made aware about various schemes like support to poor prisoners scheme and various other rights of prisoners. Jail inmates were also made aware about benefits of skill development. A Bakery Unit, established in the jail with combined efforts of DLSA Nainital And District Administration (Jila Udyan Kendra), was also inaugurated. **Medical Camp** for prisoners was also organized.



CELEBRATION OF HARELA FESTIVAL:

In recognition of the **Harela Festival**, which is celebrated every year in the month of July in Uttarakhand, marking the **Day of Green** and the onset of the rainy season, a large-scale plantation drive was organized across the State. This initiative was especially important given the recent forest fires that had caused significant damage to the forests, highlighting the need for environmental restoration.

In light of these circumstances, the Hon'ble Executive Chairman of the Uttarakhand State Legal Services Authority (UKSLSA) directed that a major plantation campaign be carried out to contribute to environmental conservation. The goal was to mitigate the damage caused by the fires and promote a healthier environment for the state.

As per these directions, a **15-day Plantation Drive** was organized from **16th July 2024 to 30th July 2024**, with active participation from Legal Services Institutions throughout Uttarakhand. This initiative was a collective effort to raise environmental awareness and promote tree planting across the state.

During this campaign, a total of 40,832 plants were successfully planted, significantly contributing to the state's environmental restoration efforts and supporting the preservation of its natural resources. The plantation drive played a vital role in reinforcing the importance of protecting the environment and promoting sustainable practices across the region.

During the legal awareness camp at Sub-Jail Haldwani, on 17.07.2024 the Hon'ble Shri Justice Manoj Kumar Tiwari, Executive Chairman, UKSLSA, Nainital along with his spouse, planted saplings to boost the plantation drive conducted during Harela Celebration.

CAPACITY BUILDING/TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR PLVs:

As per directions of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, Ms. Ritu Bahari, Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand/Patron-in-Chief, UKSLSA, Nainital and Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manoj Kumar Tiwari, Senior Judge, Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand/Executive Chairman, UKSLSA, Nainital, District wise Training Programme for the PLVs were imparted by the NGO '**Migration & Asylum Project (MAP)**' The exclusive training programme were organized as per National Legal Services Authority (**NALSA**) **Scheme for PLVs (Revised) & Module for the Orientation-Induction-Refresher Courses for PLVs Training** including Training Module prepared by the NGO- MAP.

It is to pertinent to mentioned here that as per National Legal Services Authority (**NALSA**) **Scheme for PLVs (Revised) & Module for the Orientation-Induction-Refresher Courses for PLVs Training**, PLVs are not only expected to impart awareness on laws and the legal system, but they must also be trained to counsel and amicably settle sim-

ple disputes between the parties at the source itself, which could save the trouble of the affected travelling all the way to the Legal Services Authority/ADR Centers.



- On 1st July 2024, the Secretary of DLSA Almora organized an intensive capacity-building training program at the District Court Campus Almora for PLVs (Para Legal Volunteers). The training focused on the timely identification of prisoners who may be minors, the necessary actions to be taken for filing applications, and the Juvenile Justice Board (JJB) Act, in compliance with letter no. 1155/UKSLSA/2024-25 dated 20th June 2024. The session aimed to enhance the capacity of PLVs in handling cases related to juvenile prisoners. A total of 20 participants attended the training program.



- DLSA Chamoli conducted an **Internship Training Program for law students**, titled 'NALSA, SALSA, DLSA, TLSC, Front Office, Retainer Lawyer, Jail Visiting Lawyers, PLVs Role, Mediation, Legal Aid, JJ Act, JJ Rules, Victim Compensation Scheme 2013/2020, and NALSA Scheme', at the auditorium of

the District Court campus in Gopeshwar from 25th to 31st July 2024. Internships offer law students direct ex-



posure to client cases, helping them develop into advocates well-equipped to serve low-income and vulnerable clients. This hands-on experience instills a sense of responsibility that students can carry into their future legal careers. Additionally, law students can play a vital role by conducting research into systemic challenges within the legal aid system, contributing to its improvement and effectiveness. The training focused on the provisions and roles of various legal bodies and schemes, including NALSA, SALSA, DLSA, TLSC, the Juvenile Justice (JJ) Act, JJ Rules, and the Victim Compensation Scheme. A total of 20 law students from Gopeshwar participated in the event, gaining valuable knowledge on these legal frameworks and their applications.

- DLSA, Chamoli conducted Training Programme titled 'Induction Course' at the auditorium of the district court campus, Gopeshwar on 09.09.2024 to 11.09.2024. The participants were imparted training relating to the provisions of Role of PLVs, Criminal law, laws for Child Protection against violence and Sexual Violence, laws for Senior Citizens, SC &ST Act, NALSA Portal (LSMS and LAIS), NALSA Scheme and other Topics'.



- From 20th to 22nd September 2024, DLSA Chamoli held a '**Orientation –Induction-Refresher Courses**' in Gopeshwar. Topics included Criminal Law, Victim Compensation, ADR, Uttarakhand State Prison Manual, Senior Citizen Laws, RTI, Right to Education, SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, Labor Laws, Female Worker Protections, Disability Rights, and Social Security for Workers, aimed at enhancing legal awareness and skills.



- **DLSA** Pithoragarh conducted a **Training-cum-Sensitization Session** titled "New PLVs Training Programme" at the Meeting Hall on 26/27/28 September 2024. The sessions focused on educating participants about the functions of DLSA, raising awareness through organic awareness programs, and providing legal services to marginalized and helpless individuals. The training aimed to enhance the skills and knowledge of the participants, preparing them to effectively assist in delivering legal aid to those in need.



- The DLSA of Rudraprayag conducted a **Training-cum-Sensitization Session** titled "Awareness Camp/Workshop on the Provisions of Drug Abuse" from 25 to 27.09.2024 for PLVs. The event was held at the District Court Compound in Rudraprayag. During this training, the participants were provided with valuable training related to the provisions of drug abuse and how to address issues surrounding it. The session aimed to raise awareness about the legal framework for preventing and dealing with drug abuse, along with promoting better understanding and support systems



for affected individuals. The training equipped participants with the necessary knowledge and tools to understand and navigate the legal processes related to drug abuse and legal representation.

OBSERVATION OF IMPORTANT DAYS/EVENTS:

- On 11th July 2024, the Secretary of DLSA, Almora, organized a Legal Literacy and Awareness Camp at Almora Inter College to commemorate **World Population Day**. The event featured the Secretary of DLSA, Almora, as the main speaker, along with doctors from the Medical College Almora. The students were sensitized about the ill effects and causes of overpopulation, and the importance of addressing population-related issues. Additionally, a medical health checkup camp was organized for the students, with 350 participants benefiting from the event.



- On 11th July 2024, the DLSA, Bageshwar, in collaboration with the Government Higher Secondary School, Aare, organized an awareness camp to observe "**World Population Day**." A total of 52 students participated in the camp. During the session, participants were educated about the impact of overpopulation, the need for family planning, and the measures required to ensure sustainable population growth. The students were informed about various aspects of population control and its relevance to social and economic well-being.



- The Secretary DLSA, Dehradun organized a virtual meeting/seminar on 11th July 2024 in observance of **World Population Day**. This event was attended by PLVs, panel advocates, and Legal Aid Defence Counsel. The theme for World Population Day 2024 was "**Leave no one behind, count everyone.**" The Secretary addressed the audience by discussing the **negative effects of the rising global population**. They emphasized how increasing population growth poses significant challenges to **humans, animals,** and the **environment**, contributing to issues such as resource depletion, habitat loss, and environmental degradation. The Secretary urged everyone to consider the long-term consequences of unchecked population growth and the importance of **inclusive development** that accounts for every individual.



- DLSA, Haridwar in collaboration with, Karpal Sikshan Sasthan, Shivalik Nager, Haridwar organized an awareness camp titled "**World Population Day**" on 11-07-2024, the event was headed by Secretary, DLSA. The campaign aimed at raising awareness about the increase population in Our Country.



- The DLSA Pithoragarh organized an awareness camp titled "**Importance of Population Issues**" in observance of **World Population Day** at Himalaya Public School, Pi-



thoragarh, on 11th July 2024. The event was led by the Secretary of DLSA, who delivered the keynote address. The primary aim of the camp was to raise awareness about the significance of addressing population-related issues. The participants attended the event, engaging in discussions and activities focused on population awareness.

- DLSA Pithoragarh organized an awareness camp on **World Hepatitis Day** at Village Munakote on 28th July 2024. The event, led by the Secretary of DLSA and the Health Department, focused on raising awareness about hepatitis and its global health impact.



- PLVs observed **“World Population Day”** on 11-07-2024 in Udham Singh Nagar. The event took place at various locations, including Gram Panchayat Gokulnagar Rudrapur, Block Campur Kashipur, Gram Panchayat Kunda Jaspur, and Gram Panchayat Balkhera Sitarganj, among others.

- The DLSA Bageshwar organized a legal awareness camp on August 21, 2024, to celebrate **“World Senior Citizen's Day”** at the Old Age Home in Bageshwar. The event, led by the Secretary of DLSA, aimed to educate people about the NALSA (Legal Services to Senior Citizens)



Scheme, 2015. A total of 35 students and senior citizens participated in the event, where they learned about the benefits and provisions of the NALSA scheme. This initiative is a great step towards empowering



senior citizens and ensuring they receive the legal support they deserve.

- On August 21, 2024, the **TLSC, Garur**, commemorated **World Senior Citizen's Day** with a impactful awareness camp at Village Kotfulwari. Under the guidance of the TLSC Secretary, 50 participants gained valuable insights into the NALSA (Legal Services to Senior Citizens) Scheme, 2015, empowering them with knowledge of their rights and entitlements.



- On 15.09.2024, the TLSC Joshimath organized an awareness camp to mark the occasion of the **International Day of Democracy**. The event, held under the umbrella of the **Legal Awareness Programme** at Ghaghariya, Tehsil Joshimath, was led by the Chairperson of the TLSC, Joshimath, along with the participation of PLVs from Joshimath and representatives from the Police Department. The keynote address was delivered by these leaders, focusing on key issues such as the harmful effects of **population growth**, the dangers of **psychotropic substances**, cy-



bercrime, and drug abuse.

- On the occasion of **International Day of Democracy**, DLSA PLV Nainital organized multiple awareness camps across the district. The camps focused on informing the general public about free legal aid, the NALSA Scheme, and the importance of Fundamental Rights and Duties. Key topics discussed included the drug menace, issues related to substance abuse and related offenses, the POSH Act, the provision of free legal aid at different stages, and the rights of women, senior citizens, and persons with disabilities. The camps also highlighted issues such as cyber offenses and road safety, aiming to raise awareness and empower citizens with legal knowledge.



- On 15.09.2024, DLSA Pithoragarh organized an awareness camp to mark the **International Day of Democracy** at Laxman Singh Mahar Parisar, Pithoragarh. The event was led by the Secretary of DLSA, who delivered the keynote address. The primary focus of the campaign was to raise awareness about the importance of democracy, emphasizing the value of democratic rights, participation, and the role of citizens in sustaining democratic processes.



- An event was held on the occasion of the **International Day of Democracy on 15.09.024** at the Bhimraw Ambedkar Hostel, Baurari, District Tehri Garhwal. The event focused on raising awareness about important topics such as environmental issues, physical and mental health, and the eradication of the drug menace. Special emphasis was placed on educating participants about health issues, the victims of drug abuse, and the importance of addressing drug addiction in the community. In addition, the event highlighted the Indian Constitution, emphasizing Basic Fundamental Rights, Human Rights, and the importance of understanding these rights in everyday life.



DISASTER MANAGEMENT & RELIEF TRAINING AND AWARENESS CAMPAIGN ORGANIZED BY THE DLSAs:

As per directions of the Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Uttarakhand SLSA, Nainital and with reference to **NALSA's Scheme for Legal Services to the Disaster Victims through Legal Services Authorities**, Basic Training and Rescue/Disaster management Training was imparted to the PLVs and other Volunteers. The said Disaster Relief Training was organized by the DLSAs in cooperation with State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) for providing immediate and effective relief and rescue work by the PLVs during natural and unnatural disasters. During the said train-

ing programme NALSA (Legal Services to the Disaster Victims through Legal Services Authorities) Scheme, 2010, Disaster Management Act, 2013 was also underlined to the participants.

The objective of these training programmes is, to develop skills of the Para-Legal Volunteers and other Volunteers about rescue/relief work during occurrence of disasters such as cloud burst, earthquake, forest fire, landslide, building collapse, flash flood, glacier burst etc. in an effective manner while deployed for disaster response duties.



BIODEGRADABLE & NON-BIODEGRADABLE AND PLASTIC WASTE MANAGEMENT:

In compliance of the Order dated 07.07.2022 and Order dated 24.11.2022 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand in **WP (PIL) No. 93/2022 (Jitendra Yadav Vs. Union of India & Others)** and as per the directions issued by the Hon'ble Executive Chairman, UKSLSA, with reference to the aforesaid order, different legal awareness camps have been organized on different dates and places by the District Legal Services Authorities across the State of Uttarakhand.

PLVs were directed to visit different rural and urban areas, their deputed areas and uploaded Google Map Photos of the heaped/dumped garbage, also sent complaint of the locations at E-mail ID: solidwaste-complaint@uk.gov.in and to the concerned authorities.

Further, during the period April to June 2024, to make aware the common mass about Uttarakhand Plastic and other Non-Biodegradable Garbage (Regulation and Use of Disposal) Act 2013; Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 with amendment Rules 2018; Environment Protection Act, Uttarakhand Panchayat Solid Waste Management Policy, 2017 and Ban on single use of plastic etc., **36 Legal Awareness Camps** were organized and people at large were made aware. Total **09 Meetings** were also convened by the Secretaries of the DLSAs with Executive Officer, Nagar Palika to discuss the waste management in the district, for fixing dustbins at the collection centers and for removal/disposal of the collected garbage.

WORKSHOP/AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON POSH ACT:

During the period, District Legal Services Authorities organized, workshops on the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal) Act, 2013 (PoSH Act). The event was attended by a diverse group of participants, including men, women, students, police personnel, various Self-Help Groups, ASHA workers, and staff from the B.D.O. Office. During the program, the participants were informed that the PoSH Act applies to all workplaces across India and aims to ensure a safe and harassment-free working environment for female employees.

- On 29th July 2024, the Secretary of DLSA Almora organized a workshop at G.B. National Institute of Himalayan Environment (NIHE), Katarmal, Kosi, focusing on the PoSH Act, women empowerment, and relevant judicial pronouncements regarding women's rights. The Secretary of DLSA addressed and highlighted the importance of legal protections for women and highlighting key judicial developments in the field. The workshop saw the participation of 180 individuals.



- On 27th July 2024, DLSA, Bageshwar, in collaboration with the TLSC, Garur, organized an awareness camp titled "Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace Act, 2013 (PoSH Act)" at the Tehsil Auditorium in Garur. The event was headed by the Secretary of DLSA, with the primary objective of raising awareness about the provisions of the PoSH Act and the importance of creating a safe working environment for women. A total of 91 participants attended the camp, where they were informed about the legal frameworks, preventive measures, and procedures for addressing sexual harassment in the workplace. The participants were sensitized about their rights under the PoSH Act and how to seek redressal in case of violations.



- TLSC Tharali, in collaboration with the Nagar Panchayat Tharali, on 24th July 2024, organized a Legal Awareness Programme at the Nagar Panchayat Tharali. The event was led by the Chairperson of TLSC, Tharali, with the Chairperson of Nagar Panchayat and other resource persons contributing to the discussions. The programme aimed to raise awareness on critical issues such as the Sexual Harassment of Women at the Workplace (PoSH Act), gender justice, the rights of transgender individuals, drug abuse, and other relevant legal matters.



- On July 12, 2024, the Secretary of DLSA, Dehradun, conducted a detailed briefing on the POSH Act for girls undergoing training at the Government Industrial Training Institute (Women) in Dehradun. The session was held at the Girls Polytechnic College, Survey Chowk, Dehradun. During the briefing, the Secretary addressed and clarified all the queries and doubts raised by the girls, ensuring they had a thorough understanding of the POSH Act.



- On **09-07-2024**, PLVs organized an insightful **Awareness Camp/Workshop** focused on the provisions of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal) Act in Udham Singh Nagar. The event, led by the PLVs, was conducted across key locations, including the Aganwadi Center Milak Sitarganj, Medicity Rudrapur, and other areas within U.S. Nagar. The workshop aimed to inform participants about their rights and legal avenues for addressing workplace harassment, emphasizing the importance of a safe and respectful work environment.



- The DLSA of Rudraprayag conducted a Training-cum-Sensitization Session titled "Awareness Camp/Workshop on the Provisions of Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal) Act, 2013 (**PoSH Act**)" on 20.09.2024. The session was held at the Forest Department in Rudraprayag. The primary goal of this event was to raise awareness among the participants, about the legal provisions and procedures under the PoSH Act. This includes understanding the prevention, prohibition, and redressal mechanisms available for sexual harassment cases in the workplace. The workshop emphasized creating a safe and secure environment for women employees and ensuring compliance with the legal framework set forth by the PoSH Act.



PREVENTION OF SALES OF EXPIRY ITEMS:

As per directions of the Hon'ble Executive Chairman, UKSLSA, Nainital, monthly meetings are being convened by the Secretaries of District Legal Services Authorities (DLSAs) across the State of Uttarakhand with Food Safety Officer and Drug Inspector of the concerned district with regard to prevention of sales of expiry items/packages/ packed foods, drinks. Raid/Inspections are also being done to the malls, shops, markets, medical stores, general stores etc.

The committee constituted for the purpose has been directed to conduct all needful exercise as per law, if any such matter found in the district.

During the said period the District Legal Services Authorities convened **23 Meetings** with Food Safety Officer and Drug Inspector and Anti-Drug Team Members, **157 surprise inspections/visits** to shops, stores, medical stores, malls by the concerned officers, about 225 **samples collected** from the shops, malls and stores and were sent to laboratory. The concerned officers also informed that show cause notices were issued to different firms as per Medicine Act, 1940 and Rules 1945.



- On 13th July 2024, PLVs of District Almora conducted an inspection to check the sale of expired items and medicines at various medical stores, shops, and establishments in the Main Market area, from Dharanaula to Makedi. The inspection aimed to ensure that no expired goods were being sold to the public. During the activity, awareness was also created among shopkeepers and the general public about the harmful effects of selling expired products and the legal implications of such actions. The initiative was part of an effort to protect consumers and promote safe trading practices in the district.



AWARENESS AND OUTREACH PROGRAMMES AT COMMUNITY LEVEL:

During the month July to September, 2024 total **3163 Legal Awareness Camps** were organized at community level in remote far-flung areas, at market places and in urban areas by all DLSAs including TLSCs, PLVs and Panel Lawyers. These camps were attended by 129212 person across the State of Uttarakhand and they were sensitized about NALSA (Legal Services to the Workers in the Unorganized Sector) Scheme 2015, Cybercrime, Internet & Social media frauds/scams, Revenge Porn, Cyber Stalking, Cyber Harassment, Cyber bullying, Child help line 1098, NALSA helpline no. 15100, Prevention and Treatment, Early Access to Justice at Pre-arrest, Arrest and Remand Stage, Child Marriage Ban, Child Labour Ban, e-initiatives as e-True Copy, e-filing, Drug Abuse, POCSO Act, D.V. Act, NALSA Portal (LSMS and LAIS) etc.



OUTREACH PROGRAMME AT SCHOOLS AND COLLEGES:

During the period total **3746** Legal Awareness camps were organized at school and college level at District, Tehsil and Block level and the said camps were attended by Students, Teaching and non-teaching Staff and Parents. In the said camps people at large were informed about the NALSA (Legal Services to victims of acid attacks) Scheme, 2016, NALSA (Child Friendly Legal Services to Children and their Protection) Scheme, 2015, Cyber Crimes, Social Media Scams, Cyber Harassment, Revenge Porn, Cyber stalking, Child Labour, Child Marriage, Child Trafficking, Juvenile Justice Act, 2015, Labour laws, Minimum wages, POCSO Act, Good touch & Bad touch etc. These programmes were attended by about 12,98,302 students.



JAIL ACTIVITIES:

As per directions of the Hon'ble the Executive Chairman, UKSLSA and in order to strengthen Jail Legal Aid Clinics and Prisoners Focused Legal Services, all the District Legal Services Authorities are being organized "**Jail Samiksha Diwas**" inside District/Sub-Jails and at Legal Aid Clinics/Judicial Lock-up on every Wednesday of the week. The Secretaries of DLSAs along with Jail Vesting Panel Lawyers, Chief Legal Aid Defense Counsel and PLVs visited District/Sub-Jails/Judicial Lock-ups and made interaction with jail inmates during the programme. The necessary legal aid has been provided to the Jail Inmates by the Jail visiting Panel Lawyers and Secretaries of the DLSAs.

During the period July to September, 2024 total 151 Legal Awareness Camps, 79 visits/inspections were conducted and total 1033 Jail Inmates/Under Trial Prisoners were get benefited by providing them free Legal Aid Services by the Panel Lawyers enrolled with District Legal Services Authorities.

- On 10th July 2024, a Medical Health Checkup camp was organized by the Secretary of DLSA, Almora, in collaboration with the Medical College Almora, for inmates. A total of 235 inmates benefited from the comprehensive health services provided during the camp, which included mental health assessments and general medical checkups. The initiative aimed to ensure the well-being of the inmates by addressing both their mental and physical health needs.



- The Secretary of the DLSA Chamoli, along with the Chief Legal Aid Defense Counsel and the Jail Visiting Lawyer, visited the local jail to engage with prisoners and raise awareness about the Legal Aid Defense Counsel System. During the visit, they interacted with 22 prisoners, providing them valuable information regarding their legal rights and access to legal representation. Additionally, legal aid and advice were offered to 32 prisoners based on their specific requirements, ensuring that those in need received the necessary legal assistance.

- The inspection of the District Jail Dehradun was conducted on 24.07.2024 by Secretary DLSA, Dehradun. During the visit, the first female barrack was inspected in collaboration with the District Probation Officer. Women prisoners were given an opportunity to meet with the inspection team, where their concerns and problems were heard and addressed. Among the issues raised, some women reported that their children, who are being cared for by relatives outside the prison, were not receiving proper care. This concern highlights the challenges faced by female prisoners who have young children, and further attention is needed to ensure the well-being of these children while their mothers are incarcerated.



- On 04.09.2024, the District Judge/Chairman DLSA Dehradun, District Magistrate Dehradun, Senior Superintendent of Police Dehradun, Chief Judicial Magistrate Dehradun, and Secretary DLSA Dehradun jointly conducted an inspection of the **District Jail Dehradun**. During the visit, they interacted with all the inmates of the **First Women Barrack**, addressing and resolving their concerns. The team also reviewed the cleanliness and arrangements within the barracks, as well as inspected the women prisoners' kitchen. Additionally, an interaction was held with the inmates aged 18 to 21 years, focusing on their welfare and needs.



- On 27th July 2024, the DLSA Haridwar conducted an **inspection** of the **District Jail, Roshnabad, Haridwar**. During the inspection, the entire jail premises were thoroughly visited, and detailed observations were made regarding the facilities and operations. The inspection also included a review of the

work of the Jail Visiting Lawyer, CLADC and the functioning of the PLAC. Additionally, the roles and activities of the Jail PLVs were assessed to ensure they were effectively supporting the legal needs of prisoners. As part of the awareness initiatives, an **awareness program** titled **"DLSA and Prisoners"** was organized with the help of the **Jail Radio Station**. Through this program, approximately **1200 prisoners** were addressed, providing them valuable information about their legal rights and the services offered by the DLSA. Following the program, interactions were held with the prisoners who had sought legal aid. This allowed the legal team to assess their needs and offer appropriate support, reinforcing the DLSA's commitment to ensuring access to justice for incarcerated individuals.

- DLSA, Udham Singh Nagar, in collaboration with the Sub-Jail Haldwani and Central Jail Sitarganj, U.S. Nagar, organized an awareness camp



in July, 2024 titled "Plea Bargaining, Probation of Offenders, Compounding of Offences, Rights of Remission, and Commutation Awareness". The camp aimed to educate participants about various legal provisions, including the processes of plea bargaining, probation, and the



compounding of offences, along with the rights related to remission and commutation.

- On 28th September 2024, a joint inspection of the District Jail in Almora was conducted by several key officials. The inspection team included the District Judge and Chairperson of the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) Almora, the District Magistrate (DM), the Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) Almora, the Secretary of the DLSA Almora, and other relevant authorities. During the inspection, the officials also interacted with the inmates to assess their well-being and address any concerns



they might have. In addition, the prison's legal aid clinic was inspected by the Chairperson of the DLSA Almora, ensuring that inmates have access to legal resources and assistance. Furthermore, the inspection day included the inauguration of a **prison bakery**, aimed at providing vocational training and improving conditions within the jail. The bakery initiative may also help in rehabilitation by offering inmates valuable skills for their future reintegration into society.



- The Secretary of the DLSA in Chamoli, along with the Chief Legal Aid Defense Counsel and the Jail Visiting Lawyer, visited the District Jail in Chamoli during September, 2024. The purpose of the visit was to educate and raise awareness among the pris-



oners about the Legal Aid Defense Counsel System. This initiative aimed to inform the inmates about their legal rights, particularly the availability of legal aid services to ensure that they have access to justice. The visit likely involved explaining how prisoners can seek legal assistance through the system, ensuring that those who cannot afford legal representation are still provided with a fair trial and legal support.

- The DLSA, Udham Singh Nagar, in collaboration with **Sub Jail Haldwani**, Nainital, organized an awareness camp focused on Plea Bargaining, Probation of Offenders, Compounding of Offences, Rights of Remission, and Commutation Awareness. The camp aimed to educate inmates and staff about these crucial legal provisions, providing insights into processes like plea bargaining, the possibility of probation, how certain offences can be compounded, and the rights of prisoners to seek remission or commutation of their sentences, ensuring a better understanding of legal rights and options within the justice system.



ANTI-DRUG CAMPAIGN:

As per directions of the Hon'ble Patron-in-Chief and Hon'ble Executive Chairman, UKSLSA, Nainital, Legal Services Institutions carried out **Anti-Drug Campaign** across the State of Uttarakhand during July to September, 2024. It has also been directed to ensure wide publicity of Toll Free National Anti-Narcotics Helpline MANAS (Madak Nisedh Asuchhna Kendra) Number 1933, E-mail: info.ncbmanas@gov.in and Website: ncbmanas.gov.in launched by the Government of India. Through MANAS helpline citizens can share information on drug trafficking and connect with the Narcotics Control Bureau anonymously 24 hours a day to get advice on de-addiction and rehabilitation. The objective of this initiative is to keep the younger generation away from the scourge of drugs and MANAS will address various drug-related issues including trafficking, illegal sales, storage, manufacturing and cultivation of narcotics. It assures confidentiality and promise prompt action under the NDPS Act.

In order to aware the common mass about ill effects of drugs and drug-addictions Legal Awareness Camps were organized and during the campaign **Anti-Drug Campaign Videos** created by the famous personalities were displayed across the State of Uttarakhand in the Government Offices, Schools, Colleges, Universities, Law Colleges, Degree Colleges, District & Sub-Jails, Judicial Lock-ups, Children/ Observation/Juvenile/Correctional Homes and prominent public places, Court Campuses at frequent intervals and during legal awareness camps.

DEHRADUN



- A mega tree plantation program was organized by Technical Worker Umeshwar Singh Rawat on July 27, 2024, at PM Shree Kendriya Vidyalaya, Upper Camp Gadi Cantt, Dehradun, as part of the Harela Programme, which ran from July 16 to July 30, 2024. The theme of the tree plantation initiative was "the name of a tree," and it saw enthusiastic participation from children,

their mothers, and the school's Principal, Awadhesh Dubey, along with all the teachers. During the event, approximately 50 saplings of various medicinal and fruit-bearing plants were planted, including mango, guava, herbal plants, bahada, amla, jamun, and bel patri. The Principal and teachers expressed their gratitude to the District Legal Services Authority for their support in making this event a success, highlighting the importance of environmental awareness and the role of the community in preserving nature.



- The Secretary of District Legal Services Authority, Dehradun, participated in the Sela Parva festival with the Van Gujjar community on July 27, 2024, at Bhaniawala village in Badhkot. During the event, various fruit and medicinal plants were planted, and guards were installed. The Van Gujjar community has been observing the **Sela Parva** festival for years,



where they plant trees for 10 consecutive days in July to promote environmental conservation and sustainability. However, despite their efforts in environmental conservation, the community faces challenges in accessing basic rights and services. Many members of the Van Gujjar community lack essential documents such as

Aadhaar cards and birth certificates, which hinders their access to government schemes and services.

- On 18-07-2024, the DLSA, Dehradun, organized a legal awareness program focused on gender justice, the rights of transgender people, gender equality, full and equal representation and participation at all levels, and the empowerment of women and girls. The event aimed to raise awareness about these critical issues and promote inclusivity and equality. Panel Advocates and PLVs of DLSA, Dehradun, were present at the program.

They provided valuable insights into the rights of the transgender community and highlighted the importance of gender equality. Additionally, they shared information about the free legal assistance available through the DLSA, ensuring that individuals, including transgender people and women, are aware of their legal rights and the support they can access.



- The **Secretary DLSA, Dehradun** conducted an inspection at the State Institute of Mental Health, Selaqui on 18th July 2024. During the inspection, it was observed that the institute was housing a total of 30 mental health patients, with an equal distribution of **15 male** and **15 fe-**

male patients. The available infrastructure consisted of 30 beds, which was precisely the number required to accommodate the patients. This visit highlighted the current capacity constraints of the institute, raising potential concerns regarding the availability of adequate facilities, especially if the number of patients were to increase in the future. The inspection aimed to assess the conditions and ensure that the rights and needs of the patients are being met within the available resources.

This elderly woman used to apply for her pension for the last several years, but due to lack of information, she used to apply for her pension through her wrong documents, then her pension used to get cancelled again and again through the department. Sir, this elderly woman came in contact with PLV, District Legal Services Authority, immediately after getting information about her, all the documents related to her pension were corrected by going to the departments, then her old age pension was done online on 13 September 2024 by District Social Welfare Champawat, this elderly woman is from a poor family, her pension has currently been restarted by the Social Welfare Department Champawat. PLV Amit Kumar, District Legal Services Authority Champawat, Tanakpur Purnagiri.

2. Neema Devi, daughter of Shri Chani Ram, is a resident of Village Adhchali, Tehsil Bhanoli, District Almora, Uttarakhand. This lack of documentation prevented them from availing benefits of various government schemes. Currently, Neema Devi works as a Tailoress in Almora to support herself and her son.

The guardians of these girls expressed their gratitude to the District Legal Services Authority, Dehradun, and the technical workers involved for their support in securing this financial aid, which will help improve the girls' lives and education.
