Department of Education, Ali Yavar Jung National Institute of Speech and Hearing Disabilities (Divyangjan), Mumbai (AYJNISHD(D)) in collaboration with Cochlear is pleased to announce SPARSH Certificate Course starting from 18 July 2025.

As guided by the Joint Committee for Infant Hearing (JCIH), to achieve best outcomes, a child's hearing screening should be completed by 1 month, audiologic diagnosis by 2 months and enrollment in early intervention along with Auditory Verbal Therapy (AVT) by 3 months of age.

AVT is a highly specialized and evidencebased approach practiced globally to habilitate children for mainstream education. AVT principles and techniques can help in bridging the learning gap and improving outcomes for children with cochlear implant(s). With this background, AYJNISHD(D) and Cochlear launched **SPARSH** in November 2021 and since then, it has indeed been an enriching experience to successfully enable over 800 hearing healthcare professionals to develop their AVT skills.
