Financial Assistance and Benefits under ADIP Scheme

1. Aids and Devices:

• For devices costing up to ₹15,000: Full financial assistance is provided for basic aids like hearing aids, prostheses, orthotic devices, crutches, walking sticks, and standard wheelchairs.



• For devices costing between ₹ 15,001 to ₹ 30,000: Financial assistance up to ₹ 15,000 is provided for high-quality prosthetic limbs, advanced mobility aids, customized orthotic supports, and low vision devices.

2. Cochlear Implants:

- Children with Pre-Lingual Hearing Loss (Ages 1 to 5 years): Up to ₹ 7 lakh is provided for cochlear implants, including surgery, implant cost, therapy, mapping, travel expenses, and pre-surgical assessments.
- Children with Post-Lingual Hearing Loss (Ages 6 to 18 years): Up to ₹ 6 lakh is provided, covering the same cost aspects as pre-lingual cases.

3. High-End Prostheses and Motorized Aids:

• **High-End Prostheses:** A subsidy of up to ₹ 30,000 is provided for high-quality prosthetic limbs with advanced functionalities for PwDs with 40% or more disabilities.



Motorized Tricycles and Wheelchairs: Up to ₹
50,000 is provided for individuals with severe disabilities (80% and above) including those with conditions like cerebral palsy and stroke. Under ADIP SSA, the minimum disability requirement is relaxed to 40% for eligible students.



4. Travel and Lodging Provisions:





- Travel Allowance: ₹ 250 per visit for the PwD and one escort.
- Lodging Allowance: ₹ 100 per day for up to 15 days, depending on the type of fitment or surgery.

Eligibility Criteria for the Scheme

Eligibility Criteria for PwDs:

- Must be an Indian citizen with at least 40% disability.
- Should possess an UDID card or enrollment number and Aadhaar card.
- Monthly income should not exceed ₹30,000 for the individual or, for dependents, the parental income should not exceed ₹30,000.

Should not have received assistance under the scheme within the last three years (except children under 18 years, where the period is one year).

Note: Income proof can include a BPL Card, Disability Pension Card, or a certificate from the MP/MLA/Gram Pradhan.

Income Criteria for Assistance:

- 1. Full Financial Assistance: Available for PwDs with an income of up to ₹22,500 per month.
- 2. Partial Financial Assistance (50%): Available for PwDs with an income between ₹22,501 to ₹30,000 per month.

How to apply for benefits & assistance?

Camp Activity:

Eligible beneficiaries can attend district-level camps for assessment and device distribution. Camps focus on underserved areas and are scheduled periodically.

National Institutes & NGOs:

National Institutes, CRCs, ALIMCO, DDRCs, and specific NGOs offer services at their headquarters or regional centers. These organizations may also provide outpatient and surgical assistance.

Mobile App:

Beneficiaries can request new devices or repairs via the ADIP mobile app. Requests are directed to the nearest implementing agency, and after document verification, devices are distributed within six months.

ARJUN Portal:

Beneficiaries can apply online for devices through the ARJUN Portal, with processing and distribution completed within six months.
