## Education & Therapeutic Support:

Children with autism benefit from structured support systems that focus on communication, learning, and social participation.



## Support may include:

- Speech and language therapy
- Individualized education plans
- Inclusive and special education options
- Parent training and home-based strategies

# Key Characteristics

- Delayed or limited speech and language development.
- Difficulty in social interaction and peer relationships.
- Repetitive behaviors or restricted interests.
- Sensory sensitivities (sound, touch, light, textures).
- Preference for routines and difficulty with change

- Enhance social interaction and play
- Reduce behavioral challenges
- Support school readiness
