## **INTRODUCTION**

The Arunachal Pradesh State Council for Technical Education (APSCTE), an autonomous body under the Directorate of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Arunachal Pradesh will conduct the Online Counselling for nomination in the various Degree courses (PCB group) against the seats made available to the State by the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh and other Regional bodies. The selection of candidates shall be on the basis of Rank in the NEET 2021 conducted by NTA.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

1. The children of Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribe (APST), children of Non-APST employees of the State Government, All India Services (AIS), the Central Government & the Central Public Sector Undertakings serving in Arunachal Pradesh and all the others residing in Arunachal Pradesh for the last 3 years or more and who have passed Class XII from any of the schools within Arunachal Pradesh and who have appeared the NEET 2021.

2. For admission to MBBS, BHMS, BAMS, BUMS & BDS candidate should have obtained marks above CUTOFF declared alongwith the result of NEET 2021.

2. The minimum academic qualifications to be eligible for counselling and admission in the various courses will be as follows:

i) FOR DEGREE COURSES:- Passed Class XII (with atleast 40% marks) from a Govt. recognized Board with Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

3. The age limit for admission in the various courses will be as follows:

i) FOR DEGREE COURSES:- Minimum 17 years as on 31-December-2021.

The age limits for admission will further be governed by the norms of the Medical Council of India and other respective affiliation bodies.

The status of candidates claiming for Persons with Disabilities (PwD) quota will be verified on the basis of the declaration made at the time of filling up of the forms for NEET 2021. Further, the candidate claiming for PwD quota will have to submit relevant Certificate issued by a duly constituted Medical Board. Such candidate will also have to undergo further medical examination before issue of nomination.

**CATEGORIES OF CANDIDATES:**

On fulfilling the eligibility as mentioned above, the candidates shall be placed in the following 2(Two) categories depending on the criteria as mentioned against each:

Categories	Criteria
a) CATEGORY-I (APST)	All the APST candidates which also include children of AIS/Central Govt./State Govt. employees belonging to APST
b) CATEGORY-II (Non-APST)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Children of Non-APST State Government employees.</li> <li>ii. Children of employees of All India Services/ Central Government organizations &amp; Central Public Sector Undertakings serving within the territory of Arunachal Pradesh</li> <li>iii. All others, not included in any of the above categories with the condition that the candidate should have passed Class XII or equivalent from any of the schools within Arunachal Pradesh and his/her parent(s) should have been residing in Arunachal Pradesh for atleast the last 3(three) years. Both the criteria should be fulfilled.</li> </ul>

**REGISTRATION FEE**

The interested candidates desirous of taking part in the Online Counseling has to pay one time Non-refundable registration fee as under:

Category – I (APST)	-	Rs. 500/-
Category – II (Non-APST)	-	Rs. 700/-

**DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS:**

The distribution of seats will be as per the Reservation Policy of the State for admission to technical / professional institutions as may be notified and / or amended from time to time.

As per the Reservation Policy of the State Govt. the distribution of the seats amongst the various categories as mentioned above will be as follows:

The details of the seat distribution is given in the Seat Matrix at page no. 13. From the above distribution **1 (One) seat is** reserved for PWD candidate under Cat-I. However, the candidate should have fulfilled the eligibility criteria as described above. Further, the candidate should be capable of undergoing the course with his/her physical condition.

**Allotment Policy**

As per the allotment policy seat allotment will be done in two rounds (Online). In the first round, the seats will be allotted to the candidates and the result containing the institute and the branch allotted will be available on the website. In the second round, seats will be allotted against the available vacancies at the end of first round and the results will be available on the web site. In the second round, no fresh registrations or choice filling will be permitted; registered candidates will not be allowed to alter or resubmit their choice. Therefore, all candidates are advised to fill in their choices in the first round itself. Allotment of seat will be based on a candidate's merit and his/her choices of branch/institute as per business rule.

After the 2<sup>nd</sup> round a Spot Round may be conducted to fillup the remaining vacant seats, if any.

**Registration and Choice filling steps :**

- All eligible candidates will register Online on **www.apdhte.nic.in** as per the schedule.
- During online registration, candidates are required to provide/verify information viz. name, Gender, age, State of Domicile, Category, PwD Status, marks of Class XII or equivalent examination etc.

- The candidates will also have to upload relevant documents viz, Category Certificate, Class X certificate, Class XII marksheet, NEET 2021 Rank Card, Photograph, PWD certificate, etc.
- After official verification of the aforementioned uploaded documents, all eligible candidates will be able to fill, change, reorder and delete their choices of courses/institutes as per their preference. Once locked, candidates will not be able to unlock or change their choices.
- FILLING OF CHOICES WILL BE ALLOWED ONLY ONCE DURING THE SCHEDULED PERIOD. THEREFORE, CANDIDATES ARE ADVISED TO FILL THEIR CHOICES IN THIS PERIOD WITHOUT FAIL TO BE CONSIDERED FOR SEAT ALLOTMENT IN BOTH THE ROUNDS.
- Candidates can fill as many choices as they desire.
- If a candidate fails to explicitly lock his/her choices by the stipulated time, his/her last saved choices will be automatically locked after this deadline. Candidates are therefore strongly advised to lock their choices themselves. Candidates must take printout of their locked choices for future references.
- A registered candidate, who have not filled any choice and/or has failed to save them even once during the choice filling, will not be considered for seat allotment and admission in second round.
- If the information submitted by any candidate is found to be fraudulent, incorrect or untrue, the seat allotted (if any) is liable to be cancelled. Moreover, such candidates will no longer be considered eligible for admission and will also be liable for legal action.

**Seat Allotment and reporting to the Directorate / Institutes for Round 1.**

- The first round of seat allotment will be displayed on [www.apdhte.nic.in](http://www.apdhte.nic.in).
- Seats will be allotted to the candidates in order of the choices they have filled during online choice filling, on the basis of their merit as per NEET 2021 and availability of seats in their respective categories/Institutes/courses.
- Candidates, after the declaration of result of 1<sup>st</sup> round of counseling will have the following options under **Submit Willingness tab** after logging into their account:
  1. **Floating Option:** This option is to be chosen if the candidate is not interested with the seat allotted in the present round and wants to be considered for all of his/her higher preference choices during the subsequent round (second round) of seat allotment.

OR

  2. **Freezing Option:** This option is to be chosen if the candidate is satisfied with the seat allotment and wants to accept the institute and course allotted to him/her.
- Candidates choosing Freezing option will have to pay relevant Security deposit / seat acceptance fee Online from the option "Pay Fee" available in the dashboard. The Security deposit / seat acceptance fee shall be refunded on submission of admission receipt within one month from the date of admission in the allotted Institute to this Directorate or else the amount will be forfeited.



- All the candidates who get an allotment for medical related courses like MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BUMS, BHMS, B.Sc (RIT/OOT/MLT/Nursing), B. Pharma and opt for **Freezing Option**, and paid the Security deposit / seat acceptance fee as detailed above, will report to the Directorate of Medical Education, Research and Training, A Sector, Naharlagan within the stipulated date, along with all relevant documents.
- Candidates allotted non-medical courses like B.V. Sc & AH, B.Sc (Agri/Hort/Forestry/Fishery/Community Sc/Nutrition & Dietetics/Seri) and opt for **Freezing Option**, and paid the Security deposit / seat acceptance fee as detailed above, will report to the Directorate of Higher and Technical Education, ESS Sector, Itanagar within the stipulated date, along with all relevant documents.
- If the candidates fail to Freeze the seat or pay the Security deposit / seat acceptance fee or report to the respective Directorate within the stipulated date, their seat allotment shall stand cancelled and they will not be considered for seat allotment during the second round.
- Candidates who opt for **Floating Option** in the first round will only be considered for seat allotment in the second round.
- Candidates who have neither opted for **Floating / Freezing option** shall be treated as not interested and such candidates will not be allowed in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round. However, they may participate in the Spot round if held.
- Candidates are therefore, advised to at least choose the **FLOATING OPTION** if they are interested to be considered in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round.
- **Floating Option** candidates, who are allotted other seats against their higher preference choices during second round, will forfeit their claim on seats allotted to them in first round, and the allotment of first round shall automatically stand cancelled.
- Candidates who have opted for **Freezing Option**, will have to download the A Provisional Allotment Letter, print it and then report to the respective Directorates.

#### **Seat Allotment and reporting to the Directorate / Institutes for Round 2.**

- The second round of allotment will be displayed at the website [www.apdhte.nic.in](http://www.apdhte.nic.in).
- Candidates, after the declaration of result of 2<sup>nd</sup> round of counseling will have the following options under **Submit Willingness tab** after logging into their account:
  1. **1. Floating Option:** This option is to be chosen if the candidate is not interested with the seat allotted in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round and wants to be considered for participation in the Spot round. The seat allotted in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round shall be assumed as surrendered.

**OR**

  2. **2. Freezing Option:** This option is to be chosen if the candidate is satisfied with the seat allotment and wants to accept the institute and course allotted to him/her.

- Candidates choosing Freezing option will have to pay relevant Security deposit / seat acceptance fee Online from the option “Pay Fee” available in the dashboard. The Security deposit / seat acceptance fee shall be refunded on submission of admission receipt within one month from the date of admission in the allotted Institute to this Directorate or else the amount will be forfeited.
- All the candidates who get an allotment for medical related courses like MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BUMS, BHMS, B.Sc (RIT/OOT/MLT/Nursing), B. Pharma and opt for **Freezing Option**, and paid the Security deposit / seat acceptance fee as detailed above, will report to the Directorate of Medical Education, Research and Training, A Sector, Naharlagan within the stipulated date, along with all relevant documents.
- Candidates allotted non-medical courses like B.V. Sc & AH, B.Sc (Agri/Hort/Forestry/Fishery/Community Sc/Nutrition & Dietetics/Seri) and opt for **Freezing Option**, and paid the Security deposit / seat acceptance fee as detailed above, will report to the Directorate of Higher and Technical Education, ESS Sector, Itanagar within the stipulated date, along with all relevant documents.
- If the candidates fail to Freeze the seat or pay the Security deposit / seat acceptance fee or report to the respective Directorate within the stipulated date, their seat allotment shall stand cancelled.
- Candidates who have neither opted for **Floating / Freezing option** in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round shall be treated as not interested for the allotted seat and the seat will be assumed to be vacant for the Spot round. Such candidates may participate in the Spot round if held.

#### **Surrender / Withdrawal of Seats**

- Candidates who have been issued provisional admission / nomination letter during the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> round but had not taken admission in the allotted Institution and want to withdraw the seat can do the same ONLINE within the stipulated schedule. Such candidates can participate in the Spot round if they so desire.
- Candidates who have taken admission in the allotted Institution will not be allowed to withdraw or surrender the seat.

#### **Spot Round**

- A Spot round may be conducted after the second round to fill the remaining vacant seats, if any.
- The following candidates will be eligible for participation in the Spot round:
  1. Candidates who have opted for Floating option in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round.
  2. Candidates who have withdrawn their allotted seat within the stipulated time.
  3. Candidates who have not been allotted any seat up to second round.
  4. Fresh candidates who could not register before the first round, can participate in the spot round. Such candidates have to register Online and pay the requisite registration fees.

- However, those candidates who have a confirm seat allotted and have not withdrawn their seat, cannot participate in the spot round. Candidates who have taken admission in an Institution against a allotted seat will not be permitted to join the Spot round.

#### Reporting at Allotted Institute.

- Candidates, who opts for **Freezing Option**, should report to the respective Directorates, collect the Provisional Admission / Nomination letter and report to the allotted institution for admission as per its admission schedule.
- Allotment to candidates who have been offered seats but do not report at the allotted Institute within the scheduled period shall stand cancelled.

#### Other information

- Candidates should themselves ensure that the personal information provided by them is genuine and authentic.
- Candidates should not disclose/share their password with anybody. They must understand that they are solely responsible for safe guarding their passwords.
- Candidates should be aware of the fee structure of the institutes where they are interested to take admission. The fee structure of different participating institute may be different. For details about the infrastructure, hostel facility, fees, placement record etc., candidates are advised to contact the respective institute or to visit their website.
- Moreover, if a student reports and joins at the allotted Institute and makes the payment of fees etc. but subsequently quits the college, the fee etc. deposited at the Institute may or may not be refunded by the Institute.
- Candidates may take a printout (hard copy) of the registration form containing the above personal data. It is solely the responsibility of the candidates to verify that their personal data, including category, subcategory, state of eligibility, gender etc. are consistent with documentary evidence.

#### Payment of Security Deposit

In order to avoid unnecessary blockages of seats till the last date of admission till the last date of admission by some of the candidates thereby causing loss of seats, security deposit as detailed may be levied before the issuance of the nomination letter.

The amount shall be forfeited if the candidate do not take admission within the due date of admission. However, if the candidate take admission in the Institution and submit a proof of the same, the amount shall be refunded to the candidate.

### Conversion Rules.

Before allotment of seats in the first round, if the number of registered PWD candidates is less than the seat available, conversion of PWD seats to non PWD is possible within the categories i.e. Cat I PWD to Cat I and Cat II PWD to Cat II separately to the extent of availability of PWD candidates.

If there is any resultant vacancy in the seats reserved for the PWD candidates after the first round of counselling, such seats will be converted to non PWD seats within the separate Categories for the second and subsequent round(s).
