## PREFACE

The present report relates to the annual series on "Family Budgets of Cultivators in Haryana" and it refers to the agricultural year 2003-04 (July,2003 to June,2004). It contains a comprehensive analysis of family budgets of 116 selected cultivator households.

The study attempts to provide a comprehensive analysis of cultivator's household income and expenditure. It also highlights in detail their sources of income, dietary habits, consumption pattern and availability of goods obtained from farm and procured from market.

The study inter-alia reveals an average annual income per household of Rs.147029 and expenditure of Rs.122870 leaving an annual surplus of Rs.24159 during 2003-04. The main source of household income was farm cultivation which contributed as much as 55.15% of the household income. A major portion i.e. 43.33% of the total expenditure was incurred on food items whereas the remaining 56.67% accounted for non-food items.

The report has been prepared by Sh. R.N.Dalal, Research Officer with the assistance of Sh. J.S. Malik Asstt. Research Officer, Smt. Sushma Kapoor, Field Assistant, Sh. Shamsher Singh, Junior Field Investigator and Smt . Kamlesh Stenographer under the supervision and overall guidance of Sh.O.P. Dhankar, Joint Economic and Statistical Adviser.

I hope this report will prove useful to planners, policy makers, sociologists and administrators who are interested in socio-economic development of the cultivators.

I thank all the selected cultivators of Haryana for maintaining the requisite information on voluntary basis and District Statistical Officers in the State for undertaking the work of scrutiny of records pertaining to day-to-day agricultural operations as maintained by the cultivators.

## CHAPTER -I

### INTRODUCTION

#### **1.0 General**

The present report relates to the annual series on " Family Budgets of Cultivators in Haryana and refers to the agriculture year 2003-04". It presents the comprehensive analysis of budget accounts of 116 selected cultivators spread throughout the state and was undertaken with a view to study their source of income, pattern of their household expenditure and their domestic consumption. The households whose budgets have been analysed are the same as those covered under the concurrent study on "Economics of Farming in Haryana 2003-04".

#### **1.1 Objectives of the study**

The objectives of the study are as under:-

- i) To find out the extent of contribution by different sources to household income.
- ii) To study the pattern of their domestic expenditure.
- ii) To find out the proportion of consumption of goods produced at farm and of those procured from outside.
- iii) To examine the dietary habits of cultivators and their overall standard of living.
- v) To study the impact of the size of holdings on income and expenditure.

#### **1.2 Methodology and sampling technique**

To carry out the main study i.e. "Economics of Farming in Haryana" 232 holdings were selected from different agro-climatic zones of the state. Keeping in view the size of holdings, willingness and capability of the cultivators in maintaining the day-to-day record of their income and domestic expenditure in the prescribed format 116 out of 232 households were selected for conducting the study on "Family Budget of cultivator in Haryana. The results extracted in this study are purely indicative in nature and may not represent the actual situation prevailing in the state because the size of sample is very small.

The study is based on the data collected from selected cultivators through District Statistical Officers of the respective district. The selected cultivators were imparted necessary training in recording the necessary data. Each cultivator was given an incentive of Rs.110/- per annum as an honorarium for recording the data on income and expenditure of the household in the prescribed schedules. To ensure proper recording and accuracy of data, timely supervision was done by the staff of Headquarter and District Statistical Offices.

### **1.3 Reference period**

The study was conducted in the agricultural year 2003-04 i.e from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2003 to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2004.

### **1.4 Presentation of the report**

Chapter -I of the report on " Family Budgets of Cultivators in Haryana 2003-04" is introductory and provides details about its objectives, sampling technique and methodology adopted .Chapter-II deals with various sources of income of selected cultivators i.e. income from farm cultivation, milk and milk products, interest on capital investment and miscellaneous sources. To assess the impact of size of holding on the income of the households, the income from each source has also been classified according to different size of holdings.

Chapter-III contains information pertaining to household expenditure on food as well as non-food items and quantity of various items consumed by the households during the year. The cost of production of milk per quintal has also been worked out for buffaloes and cows separately alongwith the pattern of disposal of milk. The data pertaining to possession of household assets has been analysed to throw light on the level of living standard of the selected cultivator families.

Chapter-IV Indicates the main findings of the report. The household-wise details have been presented in appendices attached with the report.

## CHAPTER-II

### Sources of Income of Cultivators

#### **General**

Haryana is predominantly an agricultural state. Introduction of improved technology in the field of agriculture has encouraged the Haryana cultivators to adopt latest farm practices, thus enabling them to increase their farm yield per hectare as well as income. To augment their earnings, the cultivators have also diversified their economic activities into dairy farming, poultry and other small enterprises. The present chapter highlights the various sources of income of selected farming households.

#### **2.1 Household size**

The family size of the selected cultivators under study varied considerably. It ranged from 2 to 22 members. The average size of family was, however, 8. This simple average does not provide a true picture of household size as it gives equal weight to the Children and Women, therefore, the Atwator's scale of Adult Male Unit (Appendix -II) has been applied to work out the true family size of the cultivators. Children and Women do not equalize male adult and are, therefore, to be reduced to adult male units in order to ascertain their real capacity to earn and spend. This Conversion is universally applied in National Sample Survey and other allied surveys conducted through out the country. According to the "Atwator's Scale of Adult Male Unit of the Chinese Farm Economy by Buck", the average size of family worked out to 6. The data regarding number of household and household members was collected from the cultivators and is shown in Table 2.1.

The above table reveals that average no. of members per household of 116 selected families was 8. The maximum household size of 12 members was reserved in the households belonging the holding size group of 7.5-to 10.0 hectares and minimum of 7 members in the households pertaining to holding size group of below 2.0 hectares.

## 2.2 Sources of income

The different sources of income of cultivators have been classified into following four broad categories:-

- i) Farm cultivation.
- ii) Milk and milk products.
- iii) Interest on capital investment (It includes farm equipments and machinery, farm and residential buildings, milch animals and durable household goods).
- iv) Income from miscellaneous sources such as rent received from leased out land, remittances received from outside, imputed value of fuel, wood and dung cakes, sale of farm yard manure and income from sources other than farm cultivation, etc.

## 2.3 Net Income of selected cultivators

The source-wise average annual net income per household, per capita and per adult male unit is presented in Table 2.3.

\*Miscellaneous includes items such as remittances received from outside, income from leased out land, family labour, rent & pension, etc.

It may be observed from the above table that the main source of income of farming families during 2003-2004 was farm cultivation which accounted for 55.15% of their total income. The contribution of the other three sources i.e. (i) Miscellaneous (ii) capital investment and (iii) milk and Milk products was 23.27, 15.26 and 6.32 percent respectively. The average annual income per family, per capita and per adult male unit during 2003-2004 has been worked out to Rs. 147029, Rs. 19272 and Rs. 24775 respectively. The source-wise analysis of income of the cultivators is given below:-

#### 2.4 Net Income from farm cultivation

The net income from farm cultivation has been worked out after taking into account gross income and the expenditure on various items of input like hired manual labour, bullock labour, seeds, fertilizers, implements/machinery and tubewells/pumping sets etc. Table 2.4 gives in brief the gross income, total expenditure and net income of selected cultivators.

Inferences can be drawn from the above table that the average net farm income per household, per capita and per adult male unit worked out to Rs.81085, Rs.10628 and Rs.13663 per annum, respectively.

#### 2.4 (a) Income from farm cultivation and size of holdings

In order to assess the impact of size of holdings on the annual farm income of a household, the size-wise average income per household, per capita and per adult male unit have been worked out. The details in this regard is presented in Table 2.4 (a).

The above table shows that the average income per household from farm cultivation for the households belonging to the holding size group of below 2.0 hectares was minimum (Rs. 34366) whereas the maximum average income (Rs.198684) was recorded in the size group of 7.5-10.0 hectares. The average per capita income was lowest (Rs. 5287) in

the size group of below 2.0 hectares and it was highest (Rs. 21948) in the size group of 10.0 hectares and above.

## 2.5 Income from milk and milk products

Dairying was another important source of income. The net income all the selected household from milk and milk products worked out to Rs. 1077929 during agricultural year 2003-04. The following table indicates the total number of milch animals owned, milk produced and the income accrued therein.

Table 2.5 shows that the cultivators normally prefer to keep buffaloes for milk production because they yield more milk as compared to cows. The cows were mainly kept for the purpose of supplying male calves to be ultimately used as bullocks in the fields. The annual milk production of all 172 milk animals possessed by 114 households was 3030.81 Qtls. worth Rs. 3466808 and the milk produced per annum per family was 26.13 Qtls. The net income per

household from milch animals after meeting out all the maintenance expenditure on milch animals was Rs.9456.

### 2.5 (a) Income from milk production

The total income from milk production of all the selected households has further been classified according to size of holdings to find out the correlation between the income from milk production and the size of holding pertaining to a household. This has been shown in the following Table:-

Table 2.5 (a) reveals that the minimum average income from milk production per household was RS. 7586 in the holding size group of below 2.0 hectares whereas it was the maximum of Rs. 13606 in the size group of 7.5-10.0 hectares. The average income from milk production per household, per capita and per adult male unit has been worked out to Rs.9292, Rs.1218 and Rs.1566, respectively during the year 2003-04.

### 2.6 Income from capital investment

15.26% of the annual income of the selected households accrued from capital investment . The imputed income by way of interest @ 9% per annum from capital investment on items such as milk and drought animals, farm equipment and machinery, farm and residential buildings, cattlesheds, wells, tubewells & pumping sets, and durable goods is given in table 2.6.

The average imputed income per household during 2003-04 from capital investment was Rs. 22437. The major contribution of 28.37% was from farm equipment and machinery followed by farm and residential buildings 27.19%, durable goods 14.95%, wells, tubewells & pumping sets 10.73%, milk and drought animals 10.71% and sheds for animals 8.05%.

#### 2.6 (a) Income from capital investment according to size of holdings

To assess the impact of size of holdings on capital formation, the total imputed income from capital investment has further been classified according to various size of holdings in Table 2.6 (a).

The above table reveals that the average income per household, per capita and per adult male unit from capital investment was Rs.22437, Rs.2941 and Rs.3781 respectively. It may also be observed that the lowest average income of Rs.7201 per household was recorded in the size group of below 2.0 hectares and the highest of Rs.43443 was registered in the holding size group of 10.0 & above hectares.

## 2.7 Income from miscellaneous sources

The contribution of miscellaneous sources to the total income of cultivators was 23.27 percent. The income from miscellaneous sources has further been classified into nine different categories such as remittances received from outside, income from leased out land, fuel, rent, manure and pension etc. The details are presented in Table 2.7.

Table 2.7 indicates that the total income of all the selected households from miscellaneous sources amounted to Rs.3968782. An average income of a family from this source was Rs. 34214..The highest contribution of 50.42% came from remittances received from outside followed by 18.86% from pension, 12.37% from family labour, 8.00% from rent and 4.16% from fuel etc. The remaining contribution of 6.19% was from, manure, honorarium for keeping records of farm accounts and family budgets etc.

### 2.7 (a)    Income from miscellaneous sources according to size of holdings

In order to study the effect of size of holdings of a household on its income from miscellaneous sources, the total income from this source has further been classified in table 2.7 (a).

Table 2.7 (a) depicts that the highest average income of Rs.38873 per household from miscellaneous sources was observed in the size group of 2.0-4.0 hectares and above whereas it was lowest of Rs.20915 in the holding size group of 10.0 & above hectares . However, the average income per household, per capita and per adult male unit worked out to Rs. 34214, Rs.4484 and Rs.5765, respectively.

## 2.8 Income of cultivators according to size of holdings from all sources

The analysis made in the foregoing table reveals that the size of holdings has a significant effect on the income of the cultivators. Generally, the average income of cultivators increases with the increase in the size of holdings because farmers with large holdings follow better agricultural practices and can afford a better package of inputs. The details of income of cultivators according to size of holdings is given in Table 2.8.

It is observed from the above table that the average income of a selected family in the size group of below 2.0 hectares was Rs. 74118 while it progressively increased to Rs.130017 in holdings size group of 2.0-4.0 hectares, Rs. 182923 in holdings size group of 4.0-7.5 hectares and Rs.285948 in holdings size of 7.5-10.0 hectares and Rs. 257917 in the size group of 10.0 hectares & above. It was also observed that per household income in the holding size of 7.5-10.0 hectares and above was RS. 285948 which was 3.86 times higher than the income of RS. 74118 in the holdings size of below 2.0 hectares. The overall average income per household per capita and per adult male unit from all sources was RS. 147029, 19272 and 24775 respectively.

## CHAPTER-III

### Household Expenditure of Cultivators

#### **General**

This chapter deals with the household expenditure incurred by selected cultivators during 2003-2004. It throws light on the expenditure made on food and non-food items, annual and daily consumption of food, input and output of milk production overall financial position of the selected cultivators. The detailed study of the household expenditure of cultivators has been made under the twelve major heads.

#### **3.1 Household expenditure of selected cultivators**

The household expenditure per family, per capita and per adult male unit under the below mentioned heads is shown in Table 3.1.

It is seen from Table 3.1 that the average annual expenditure per household, per capita and per adult male unit was Rs.122870, Rs.16105 and Rs.20704, respectively. Analysis of total expenditure shows that the food claimed the highest expenditure i.e. 43.33% of the household expenditure followed by marriage and social ceremonies 12.82%, Housing 12.75% clothing 9.32 %, education 6.98%, fuel 3.79% Health 3.63% and transport 1.90%, etc. The expenditure on basic necessities of life i.e. "Roti, Kapra and Makan" accounted for 69.19% of the total household expenditure.

### 3.2 Expenditure of households according to size of holdings

The annual expenditure per family, per capita and per adult male unit under different size of holdings is presented in the table given below : -

The above table shows that the size of holding has great impact on the expenditure of cultivators. The average annual expenditure of a family with land holding 4.0-7.5 hectares was found to be the highest (Rs. 163270). Where as the lowest (Rs.70075) per family expenditure was recorded under the holding size group of below 2.0 hectares .

### 3.3 Sources of availability of household items

The value and proportion of the household expenditure on goods and services procured from farm and purchased from outside are presented in Table 3.3.

The above table reveals that the bulk of cultivator's household requirements (69.15%) were met from the goods and services purchased from outside while 30.85% of the household requirements were met from the goods produced at their farms. The table further shows that 66% and 59% of the requirements of food and fuel were met from his own farm, whereas for the remaining items, the farmers were totally dependent on outside sources.

### 3.4 Expenditure on food items

43.33% of the total household expenditure was incurred on food items only. Thus, it has become imperative to further study the pattern of household expenditure on various food items. All the food items have been summarized into various broad groups which are as under :-

The above table depicts that the annual expenditure on food items during 2003-04 per household, per capita and per adult male unit was Rs.53242 Rs.6979 and Rs.8972, respectively. The table also throws light on the dietary habits of cultivators and clearly establishes that Haryana Cultivator is primarily a vegetarian. His expenditure on milk and milk products was the highest i.e. 52.94% followed by cereals 16.69%, Misc.8.28%, fruits/vegetables 7.33% and sugar 5.51%. The expenditure on meat and meat products was only 0.40%. It is found that 77.95% of the household expenditure was on cereals, pulses, milk and sugar.

### 3.5 Consumption of food articles

In order to study the dietary habits of Haryana cultivator's the annual and daily consumption of various food articles like cereals, pulses, milk & milk products and sugar, etc. has also been worked out in Table 3.5.

It may be observed from the above table that wheat is the stable food of Haryana cultivators because its daily consumption per adult male unit was 475 grams as compared to 35 grams than that of rice. Incidentally, the daily consumption of desi ghee was 107 grams and edible oil was 94 grams per household, daily consumption of sugar was 456 grams as against 100 grams of gur & shakkar. The daily consumption per adult male unit of gram, milk and milk products, desi ghee and edible oil was 9 grams, 1038 grams, 18 grams and 16 grams, respectively.

### 3.6 Cost of production of milk

52.94% of the total expenditure on food items was incurred on milk and milk products only. Hence, it has become essential to discuss in detail the cost of production of milk. The cost of milk production per quintal both for buffaloes and cows has been worked out by taking into account the various variable and fixed costs. Variable cost includes expenditure on items such as fodder, concentrates, labour ( family and hired) medical care, etc. and fixed cost

includes interest and depreciation on capital investment made on milch animals and cattlesheds etc. The details are as under :-

The cost per quintal and quantity of milk produced is given in the following table:-

Table 3.6 shows that it is the variable cost which almost determines the cost of milk production. Fodder and concentrates are the major components of variable cost. It constitutes about 3/4<sup>th</sup> of the total cost of milk production. The cost of production of milk per quintal in case of buffaloes and cows worked out to Rs 806.60 and Rs.650.96 as against the income of Rs.1167 and Rs.971 thus resulting a net income of Rs.360 and Rs. 320 per quintal, respectively. It is fact that the net income per quintal of buffaloes milk was significantly more than that of cows which clearly indicates that Haryana Cultivator does not keep cows for commercial gains.

### 3.7 Disposal of milk

Table 3.7 presents the quantity of buffaloes and cows milk produced, milk sold and consumed in the liquid form or as milk products.

The above table indicates that 96.42% of the total buffaloes milk produced was consumed at home and only 3.58% was sold. Further, 52.79% of the buffaloes milk was consumed in the liquid form and remaining 47.21% was converted into curd, butter, ghee etc. Out of the total 95.62 qtls. of buffaloes milk sold, 93.40% was sold in the form of liquid and the remaining 6.60% as milk products. Similarly, out of the total cows milk consumed at home 80.28% was used in liquid form and the remaining 19.72% in the form of milk products. The table also shows that cow's milk was not sold in the form of liquid and milk products.

### 3.8 Annual consumption of sugar, gur & shakkar

5.51% of the total food expenditure was incurred on sugar, gur and shakkar. Therefore, it has become essential to work out the annual consumption of sugar per household. The following table depicts the average quantity and current value of sugar consumed per household, per capita and per adult male unit.

Table 3.8 reveals that the annual consumption of sugar during 2003-04 per household, per capita and per adult male unit worked out at 202.99 Kgs, 22.94 Kgs., and 29.49 Kgs. valued at Rs.3126, Rs.353 and Rs. 454 respectively. Out of total, 23547 Kgs, 19323 Kgs. Sugar and 4224 Kgs. Gur & Shakkar was consumed by the selected cultivators during the year 2003-04.

### 3.9 Size of holdings and expenditure on food items

The expenditure on food items per household, per capita and per adult male unit according to size of holdings is presented in Table 3.9.

It may be seen from the above table that the per household, per capita and per adult male unit expenditure on food items was Rs.53242, Rs.6979 and Rs. 8972 respectively. The highest per household expenditure on food items (Rs.76874) was observed in the size group of 7.5-10.0 hectares and lowest (Rs.41141) in the size group of below 2.0 hectares.

### 3.10 Expenditure on non – food items

A bulk of 56.67% of the total household expenditure of selected cultivators was spent on non-food items .Among the non-food items, the clothing and housing claimed 9.32% and 12.75% respectively of the total expenditure. Hence, it is desirable to analyse the expenditure on these items in detail.

#### 3.10 (a) Expenditure on housing

The expenditure on housing includes expenditure on house construction/repairs, alterations and additions, utensils, furniture & fixtures, machinery and tools etc. The item-wise break up of the expenditure on housing is given in Table 3.10 (a).

It is observed from Table 3.10 (a) that per household and per capita expenditure on housing was Rs.15668 and Rs.2054, respectively. 64.30% of the total expenditure on housing was incurred on house construction and repairs, 20.87% on furniture & fixture, 8.88% on utensils and the remaining 5.95% was on miscellaneous items including machinery and tools etc.

### 3.10 (b) Expenditure on clothing

Expenditure on clothing includes expenditure on readymade garments, bedding, footwear, cosmetics and other miscellaneous items. The details are as under:-

Garments	These include shirts, pants, dhotis, turbans, underwears, sweaters, coats, towels, needles, thread and buttons etc.
Beddings	Beddings include bed sheets, bedcovers, quilts, blankets etc.
Footwears	All types of leather, rubber, plastic and canvas shoes and chappals, boot polish and brush etc. are included under footwear.
Cosmetics	These include bathing soap, comb, tooth brush, mirror, face powder/cream and bangles etc.
Miscellaneous	These include services rendered by tailor, barber, washerman, cobbler, dry cleaner and weaver etc.

It is clear from the above table that 45.50% of the total expenditure was incurred on garments 13.24%, on footwears, 14.33% on toilets and cosmetics, 11.39% on beddings and the remaining 15.54% was spent on miscellaneous items. The expenditure on clothing per household and per capita worked out to Rs.11454 and Rs.1501 per annum, respectively.

### 3.11 Expenditure on important non-food items according to the size of holdings

Expenditure in housing, clothing, marriage & social ceremonies and education constituted 41.87 percent of the total non-food expenditure of families. It has been presented according to size of holdings in Table 3.11.

Table 3.11 reveals that the expenditure incurred by the household on housing, clothing and social ceremonies had no direct relation with the size of holdings. The highest per household expenditure on housing was observed (Rs.36300) in the holding size group of 10.0 & above hectares whereas it was minimum (Rs.1614) in the holding size group of below 2.0 hectares.

The highest per capita expenditure of Rs.2201 on clothing was recorded in the holding size group of 10.0 hectares and above followed by Rs.1690 in the size group of 2.0-4.0 hectares, Rs.1470 in the size group of 4.0-7.5 hectares and the lowest of Rs.984 in the size group of 7.5-10.0 hectares. The households belonging to the holding size group of 4.0-7.5 hectares incurred the highest per capita expenditure of Rs.1840 on education where as the lowest expenditure of Rs.575 was recorded in the size group of 10.0 & above hectares. The per capita expenditure of Rs.459, Rs.2715, Rs.2759, Rs. 199 and Rs.1879 was worked out in the size groups of below 2.0, 2.0-4.0 hectares, 4.0-7.5 hectares 7.5-10.0 hectares and 10.0 hectares and above respectively under the head marriage and social ceremonies.

### 3.12 Expenditure on non-food items according to size of holdings

56.67% of the total household expenditure was incurred on non-food items by the selected households. The expenditure on these items has further been classified according to the different size of holdings in the table given below:-

It is evident from Table 3.12 that the per household, per capita and per adult male unit expenditure on non-food items was Rs.69628, Rs.9126 and RS.11733, respectively.

The highest per capita expenditure of Rs. 12158 on non-food items was recorded in the holding size group of 10.0 & above hectares and above followed by Rs. 11414 in the size group of 4.0-7.5 hectares. The households belonging to the holding size group of below 2.0 hectares incurred the lowest per capita expenditure of Rs. 4452 on non food item.

### 3.13 Possession of household assets

The possession of various household assets by the selected families is an indicative of their financial position and clearly reflects their standard of living. To study the improvement in standard of living of the selected households, the information pertaining to the possession of various household items collected from the selected households in the year 2003-2004 is presented in Table 3.13

The above table reveals that 35.34% of the total households were found in possession of motor cycle/ scooter in the year 2003-04. 43.97% of the total households were having refrigerators. Television has become the main necessity for the cultivator households in Haryana as 77.59% of the households were found in possession of a television. The table

further reveals that bicycle is the common means of transport as 81.90 % selected families were having bicycles.

### **3.14 Financial position of the selected households**

The overall financial position of the households has been worked out taking into account their gross income and expenditure. The net surplus income according to size of holdings has also been worked out in Table 3.14.

The above table reveals that on an average, a household spent Rs.122870 against the income of Rs.147029 thus leaving an annual surplus of Rs.24159 during 2003-04. This shows that families with large size of holdings were economically better off than the families with small size of holdings.

## CHAPTER – IV

### Summary and Conclusion

The present report on 'Family Budgets of Cultivators in Haryana' provides a comprehensive analysis of Haryana cultivator's household income and expenditure for the year 2003-2004. It also highlights the consumption pattern of a household, dietary habits and extent of dependence on goods other than those produced at his own farm.

The main findings of the study based on the analysis of data collected from 116 sampled cultivators are as under :-

1. The household size of selected cultivators ranged from 2 to 22 members. The average size of the household was worked out to 8 members. According to Atwator's Scale, the average size of the family was 6 adult male unit.
2. The average income per household was Rs.74118 in the holding size group of below 2.0 hectares which progressively increased to maximum Rs.285948 in the size group of 7.5-10.0 hectares .
3. Income from farm cultivation (55.15%) and dairying (6.32%) together accounted for 61.47% of the total income accruing to the cultivator households. Out of the remaining income of 38.53%, income generated from imputed interest on capital investment was 15.26 % and from other miscellaneous sources such as remittances from outside, income from labour, etc was 23.27%.
4. During 2003-04, the average annual income and expenditure of the sampled households was Rs.147029 and Rs. 122870 respectively leaving an average annual surplus of Rs. 24159. The corresponding figures of per capita income, expenditure and surplus were Rs.19272, Rs.16105 and Rs 3167 respectively.
5. 43.33% of the cultivator household expenditure was on food alone clothing accounted for 9.32%, marriage & social ceremony 12.82%, housing 12.75% and education 6.98% of the total domestic expenditure. The remaining 14.80% was on fuel, lighting, health, transport and recreations, etc.

6. Milk and milk products formed the major portion of normal intake of a cultivator's food as 52.94% of the total food expenditure on food items was incurred on milk & milk products, 19.50% on cereals & pulses, 7.33% on fruit & vegetables, 5.51% on sugar and remaining 14.72% on miscellaneous items.

7. 30.85% of the total consumption requirements of a selected household were met from the farm and the rest i.e. 69.15% procured from outside.

8. Haryana cultivator is primarily vegetarian and his expenditure on non-vegetarian items was negligible i.e. 0.40% of the total expenditure on food.

9. The study reveals that a farming family sold 3.58% of buffaloes milk and the rest was retained to meet domestic requirements. The daily consumption of milk and milk products per adult male unit was 1038 grams.

10. The cost of production of milk per quintal in respect of buffaloes and cows worked out to Rs.806.60 and Rs.650.96 respectively.

11. Bicycle was the most common mode of domestic transport i.e 81.90% families and 35.34% of the households were having motor cycle/scooter.

12. The main source of entertainment of the cultivator families ( 77.59%) was television.

It is interesting to note that the standard of living of the cultivators in Haryana is improving as the percentage of sampled cultivators owning items of comforts and luxuries is increasing as 98.28% cultivators owned fans, 43.97% refrigerators, 54.31% LPG connections, 78.45% sewing machines and 61.21 % pressure cookers.
