No. GSR 269/Const./Art. 309/63.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules regulating the recruitment, and the conditions of service of the persons appointed, to the Punjab Economic and Statistical Organization (State Service Class 1), namely:—

PART 1-GENERAL

- 1. (1) These rules may be called the Punjab Economic and Statis- Short title, tical Organisation (State Service Class I) Rules, 1963.

 (2) The scholl care into formation application.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- (3) They shall apply to the posts specified in Appendix 'A' to these rules.
 - 2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires-

Definitions.

- (a) "Government" means the Punjab Government in the Administrative Department:
- (b) "Commission" means the Punjub Public Service Commission;
- (c) "recognised university" means-
 - (i) any university incorporated by law in any: of the States of India; or
 - (ii) in the case of a degree or diploma obtained as a result of an examination held before the 15th August, 1947, the Punjab, Sind or Dacca University; or
 - (iii) any other university which is recognised by the State Government for the purposes of these rules;
- (d) "direct recruitment" means an appointment made other wise than by promotion or by transfer of an official already in the service of a State Government or of the Union;
- (e) "Service" means the Punjab Economic and Statistical Organisation (State Service Class I).

PART II-CONDITIONS OF RECRUITMENT

3. The Service shall comprise the posts shown in Appendix 'A' Number and character of to these rules in separate sections mentioned therein:

Provided that nothing in these rules shall affect the inherent right of Government to make additions to or reductions in any section of the Service either permanently or temporarily.

Pay.

4. Members of the Service shall be entitled to such scales of pay including special pay, if any, as may be authorised by Government from time to time. The scales of pay at present in force in respect of specified posts are given in Appendix 'A' to these rules.

Appointing authority.

5. All appointments to the Service shall be made by Government.

Nationality, domicile and character.

- 6. (1) No person shall be appointed to the Service, unless he is-
 - (a) a citizen of India, or
 - (b) a subject of Sikkim, or
 - (c) a subject of Nepall, or
 - (d) a subject of Bhutan, or
- (e) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before the 1st January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India, or
- (f) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan with the intention of permanently settling in India:
- Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (c), (d), (e) and (f) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been given by the competent authority and if he belongs to category (f) the certificate of eligibility will be issued for a period of one year, after which such a candidate will be retained in service subject to his having acquired Indian citizenship.
- (2) A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to an examination or interview conducted by the Commission or any other recruiting authority on his furnishing proof that he has applied for the certificate and he may also provisionally be appointed to the service subject to the necessary certificate being given to him by the competent authority.
- (3) No person shall be appointed to the service by direct recruitment unless he produces a certificate of character from the principal academic officer of the university, college, school, or institution last attended, if any, and similar certificates from two responsible persons not being his relatives, who are well acquainted with him in his private life and are unconnected with his university, college, school or institution.
 - (4) No person shall be appointed to the service unless-
 - (a) in the case of a man, he has not more than one wife living; and
 - (b) in the case of a woman, she is not married to a person already having a wife living:

Provided that Government may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this subrule.

7. (1) Posts in the service shall be filled-

Mede of recruitment.

- (a) in the case of Economic and Statistical Adviser by promotion from amongst the Deputy Economic and Statistical Advisers (Class I), and if there is no suitable Deputy Economic and Statistical Adviser (Class I) for appointment by promotion then by direct recruitment;
- .(b) in the case of Deputy Economic and Statistical Adviser (Class I) by promotion of the Deputy Economic and Statistical Adviser (Class II), and if the Deputy Economic and Statistical Adviser (Class II) is not suitable for promotion, then by direct recruitment.
- (2) All promotions shall be mæde on the basis of seniority-cummerit and no person shall be entitled to claim promotion on the basis of seniority alone.
- 8. No person shall be appointed to any post in the service, unless Age and academic qualifications
 - (a) in case of direct recruitment is-
 - (i) not less than 35 years and not more than 50 years of age in the case of Economic and Statistical Adviser; and
 - (ii) not less than 30 years and not more than 40 years of age in the case of Deputy Economic and Statistical Adviser (Class I):
 - Provided that in the case of members belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes the maximum age limit for appointment to the service shall be such as may be fixed by the Government from time to time; and
 - (b) possesses the qualifications and experience prescribed for each post in Appendix 'B' to these rules. //
- 9. (1) Persons appointed to the service shall remain on probation probation of for a period of two years, if appointed by direct recruitment and one members of year if appointed otherwise:

 Service.

Provided that-

- (a) any period, after appointment to the service spent on deputation on a corresponding or a higher post shall count towards the period of probation fixed under this rule;
- (b) in the case of an appointment by transfer, any period of work on an equivalent or higher post, prior to appointment to the service may, at the discretion of the appointing authority, be allowed to count towards the period of probation fixed under this rule; and

- (c) an officiating appointment in the service shall be reckoned as a period spent on probation but no member who has thus officiated shall, on the completion of the prescribed period of probation, be entitled to be confirmed, unless he is appointed against a permanent post.
- (2) If the work or conduct of a person appointed to the service during the period of probation is, in the opinion of the appointing authority, not satisfactory, it may—
 - (a) if appointed by direct recruitment, dispense with his services;
 - (b) if appointed otherwise-
 - (i) revert him to his former post; or
 - (ii) deal with him in such other manner as the terms and conditions of his previous appointment permit.
- (3) On the completion of the period of probation of a person, the appointing authority may—
 - (a) if his work or conduct has, in its opinion, been satisfactory-
 - (i) confirm such person from the date of his appointment, if appointed against a permanent vacancy; or
 - (ii) confirm such person from the date from which a permanent vacancy exists, if appointed against a temporary vacancy; or
 - (iii) declare that he has completed his probation satisfactorily if there is no permanent vacancy; or
 - (b) if his work or conduct has, in its opinion, not been satisfactory—
 - (i) dispense with his services, if appointed by direct recruitment; or if appointed otherwise, revert him to his former post, or deal with him in such other manner as the terms and conditions of his previous appointment permit; or
 - (ii) extend his period of probation and thereafter pass such orders as it could have passed on the expiry of the first period of probation:

Provided that the total period of probation, including extension, if any, shall not exceed three years.

Sentority of 10. The seniority inter se of the members of the service shall be members of determined separately for each of the sections shown in Appendix 'A' service. to these rules by the date of their continuous appointment to a post in that very section:

Provided that in the case of members appointed by direct recruitment, the order of ment determined by the Commission shall not be disturbed and persons appointed as a result of an earlier selection shall be senior to those appointed as a result of a subsequent selection :

Provided further that in the case of two or more members appointed on the same date, their seniority shall be determined as follows:—

- (a) a member appointed by direct recruitment shall be senior to a member appointed otherwise;
- (b) a member appointed by promotion shall be senior to a person appointed by transfer;
- (c) in the case of members appointed by promotion or transfer, seniority shall be determined according to the seniority of such members in the appointments from which they were promoted or transferred; and
- (d) in the case of members appointed by transfer from different cadres, their seniority shall be determined according to pay, preference being given to a member, who was drawing a higher rate of pay in his previous appointment; and if the rates of pay drawn are also the same, then by their length of service in these appointments; and if the length of such service is the same, an older member shall be senior to a younger member.

Note.—In the case of members whose period of probation is extended under rule 8, the date of appointment for the purpose of this rule shall be deemed to have been deferred to the extent the period of probation is extended.

- 11. Every member of the service shall be liable to transfer under Liability the orders of the appointing authority anywhere within the State of to transfer. Punjab, Deihi or any other place in India where he may be required to proceed under the administrative control of the Punjab Government.
- 12. In respect of pay, leave, pension and other cognate matters pay, leave, not expressly provided for in these rules, the members of the Service pension and shall be governed by such rules and regulations as may have been or may hereinafter be framed by competent authority under Article 309 of the Constitution of India, or any law or rules made thereunder:

Provided that in the case of members of the Service who were employees of erstwhile State of Patiala and East Punjab States Union, leave, pension and other cognate matters shall, unless Punjab rules are made applicable to them with their consent or in accordance with law, be governed by the rules and regulations applicable to them immediately before the 1st November, 1956.

13. (1) In matters relating to discipline, punishment and appeals, Discipline, members of the Service shall be governed by the Punjab Civil Services penalties and (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1952, as amended from time to time: appeals.

Provided that the nature of penalties which may be imposed, the authority competent to impose such penalties shall be as specified in Appendix 'C' to these rules.

(2) The authority competent to pass an order under clauses (c) and (d) of sub-rule (1) of rule 10 of the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1952, shall also be as specified in Appendix 'D' to these rules.

Liability for vaccination and revaccination.

- 14. Every member of the Service shall get himself vaccinated or revaccinated when Government so directs by a special or general order.
- Oath of allegiance.
- 15. Every member of the Service, unless he has already done so shall be required to take the oath of allegiance to India and to the Constitution of India as by law established.

Power of relaxation.

16. Where the Government is satisfied that the operation of any of these rules causes undue hardship in any particular case, it may, by order, dispense with or relax the requirements of that rule to such extent "and subject to such conditions as it may consider necessary for dealing with the case in a just and equitable manner.

Repeal.

17. The PEPSU Economics and Statistics Directorate Gazetted Services Rules, 1956, are hereby repealed:

Provided that any thing done or any action taken under the provisions of the rules hereby repealed shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

No. G.S.R.76/Const./Art. 309/Amd.(1)/79.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules to amend the Punjab Economic and Statistical Organisation (State Service Class I) Rules, 1963, namely:—

- 1. These rules may be called the Punjab Economic and Statistical Organisation (State Service Class I) Haryana First Amendment Rules, 1979.
- 2. In the Punjab Economic and Statistical Organisation (State Service Class I) Rules, 1963 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), and its preamble, for the word and figure "Class I" wherever occurring, the word and letter "Group A" shall be substituted.
 - 3. In the said rules, in rule 2,--
 - (i) for clauses (c) and (d), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:—
 - "(c) 'Recognised university' means,-
 - (i) any university incorporated by law in India, or
 - (//) in the case of a degree, diploma, or certificate obtained, as a result of an examination held before the 15th August, 1947, the Punjab, Sind or Dacca University, or
 - (iii) any other university which is declared by Government to be recognised university for the purpose of these rules;
 - (d) "direct recruitment" means an appointment made otherwise then by promotion from within the service or by transfer of an official already in the service of the Government of India, or any State Government,".
 - (ii) after clause (e), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—
 - "(f) Appendix means an appendix to these rules.".
- 4. In the said rules, for rule 3, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—
 - "3. Number and character of posts.—The Service shall comprise the posts shown in Appendix "A" to these rules:

Provided that nothing in these rules shall effect the inherent right of Government to make additions or reduction in the number of such posts or to create new posts with different designations and scales of pay, either permanently or temporarily".

- 5. In the said rules, in rule 6,-
 - (i) for sub-rules (1) and (2), the following sub-rules shall be substituted, namely:—
 - (1) No person shall be appointed to the Service, unless he is-
 - (a) a citizen of India, or
 - (b) a subject of Nepal, or
 - (c) a subject of Bhutan, or
 - (d) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before the 1st January, 1962, with the intention of permanently settling in India, or
 - (e) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka and East African Countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanazania (formerly Tanganyike and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire and Ethiopia with the intention of permanently settling in India:
 - Provided that a person belonging to categories (b), (c), (d) or (e) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government.
 - (2) A person in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to an examination or interview conducted by the Haryana Public Service Commission or any other recruiting authority, but the offer of appointment may be given only after the necessary eligibility certificate has been issued to him by the Government.
 - (ii) sub-rule (4) shall be omitted.
- 6. In the said rules, after rule 6, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—
 - "6A. Disqualifications.—No person—
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having spouse living, or
 - (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to any post in the service :

1

- Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule."
- 7. In the said rules, in rule 10, the note thereunder shall be omitted.
- 8. In the said rules, for rule 12, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—
 - "12 Pay Leave pension and other matters.—In respect of pay leave pension and all other matters, not expressly provided for in these rules, the members of the Service shall be governed by such rules and regulations as may have been, or may hereafter be adopted or made by the competent authority under the Constitution of India or under any law for the time being in force made by the State Legislature.".
- 9. In the said rules, for rule 13, the following rule shall be substituted namely:—
 - "13. Discipline, penalities and appeals:—(1) In matters relating to discipline, penalities and appeals members of the Service shall be governed by the Punjab Civil Service (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1952 as amended from time to time:
 - Provided that the nature of penalities which may be imposed, the authority empowered to impose such penalities shall, subject to the provisions of any law or rules made under article 309 of the Constitution of India, be such as is specified in Appendix 'C' to these rules.
 - (2) The authority competent to pass an order under (c) and (d) of sub rule (1) of rule 10 of the said rule and the appellate authority shall also be as specified in Appendix D to these rules.
- 10. In the said rules, for rule 16, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—
 - "16. Power of relaxation.—Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons
 - to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.".
- 11. In the said rules, after rule 16, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—
 - "16-A. Special provision.—Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules the appointing authority may impose special terms and conditions in the order of appointment if it is deemed expedient to do so.".

12. In the said rules, for Appendix 'A', the following Appendix shall be substituted, namely:—

 - Provided that the nature of penalties which may be imposed, the authority empowered to impose such penalties and appellate authority shall, subject to the provisions of any law or rules made under article 309 of the Constitution of India, be such as also specified in Appendix C to these rules.

Provided that a person belonging to categories (b),(c),(d) or (e) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government.
