Industrialisation plays a vital role in the economy of a State. The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) is one of the prime short-term micro economic indicators of the economic development to measure trend in the behavior of the industrial performance over a period of time in comparison to a chosen base year. It indicates the relative change of physical production in the field of industries during a specified year as compared to previous year.

The Department of Economic and Statistical Analysis, Haryana has been compiling the Index of Industrial Production for Haryana State under the guidance of the National Statistical Office (NSO), Govt. of India since 1971-72 and publishes its report on annual basis. The present report containing information relating to IIP from the year 2016-17 to 2018-19 is the second issue of the series with base year 2011-12. This Index of Industrial Production of Haryana State relates to Manufacturing and Electricity Sectors with an analysis of use-based classification of the index numbers.

This report provides an useful information for planners, industrialists and researchers etc. interested in the industrial development of the State.

I take this opportunity to thank the National Statistical Office, Government of India for providing valuable guidance. Efforts made by the District Statistical Offices for timely collection of production data from various industrial units are also acknowledged. The cooperation extended by various industrial units of the State for providing required production data for computation of IIP are appreciated and acknowledged.

This report has been prepared by Sh. Bijender Kumar, Research Officer with the help of Sh. #### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Industrialization plays a vital and crucial role in the economic development of an economy. It accelerates economic growth of a State and thereby increases the contribution of industry sector in the State Domestic Product by way of increase in the production and employment. Index of Industrial Production (IIP) is one of the prime indicators of the economic development for measurement of trend in the industrial production over a period of time with reference to a chosen base year.

The Index of Industrial Production for the State is compiled in accordance with the guidelines of the National Statistical Office (NSO), Govt. of India. In Part-I of the report, the detailed methodology, source of data and computation of index number have been presented.

A total of 178 items have been selected from Registered Manufacturing sector for the year 2011-12. Electricity has been taken as single item. Mining and Quarrying sector has been excluded due to its insignificant contribution in GSDP which was 0.04% in 2011-12 in the State. The total weight of Industrial sector has been taken as 1000 which has been distributed to Registered Manufacturing & Electricity sectors. The weights of Registered Manufacturing sector have further been distributed at 2/3 digit as well as item level as per criteria suggested by NSO. Production data of selected items are collected directly from the selected factories in the State.

Presently, Index of Industrial Production is being prepared in the State with 2011-12 base year and covers Manufacturing and Electricity sectors. Index number has been calculated at sector level, group level (2 digits) and item level. The same has been presented in the report accordingly. Review of index numbers for the year 2018-19 has also been given in the report.

The General Index of Industrial Production with 2011-12 base year increased from 136.1 in 2017-18 to 141.9 in 2018-19, registering a growth of 4.3 percent. The Index of Manufacturing sector which carries the highest weight in IIP rose from 138.1 in 2017-18 to 144.7 in 2018-19, exhibiting a growth of 4.8 percent. The Index of Electricity sector indicates a negative growth of 4.4 percent as it decreased from 110.6 in 2017-18 to 105.7 in 2018-19.

In last part of the report, the use-based classification which represent the changing pattern of customer's needs, based on taste and habits towards the purchase of industrial product has been given. Review of the use-based classification for the year 2018-19 has also been given therein. The report elaborates that the Index of Primary Goods Industries like argon gas, urea, bitumen, LPG cylinder of iron and steel, electricity etc. has decreased from 117.5 in 2017-18 to 111.8 in 2018-19, which recorded a decrease of 4.9 percent.

The Index of Capital Goods Industries like conveyor belts, tractor tyres, link forging, optical components, acephate/speedometer, diamond tools, spring pins etc. increased from 142.1 in 2017-18 to 162.5 in 2018-19, which recorded an increase of 14.4 percent.

The Index of Intermediate Goods Industries like plywood boards, wooden chips, cast iron, stone dust powder, motor vehicle seats etc. has increased from 117.4 in 2017-18 to 127.1 in 2018-19, recording a growth of 8.3 percent.


The Index of Infrastructure/Construction Goods Industries like paints, ceramic tiles, scrap cast iron etc. has increased from 136.1 in 2017-18 to 145.9 in 2018-19, recording a growth of 7.2 percent.

The Index of Consumer Durables Industries like cotton fabrics, blankets, artificial fur hand bags, books, rexin, button plastic, glass components, water pump, AC motor car etc. has increased from 159.7 in 2017-18 to 161.9 in 2018-19, registering a growth of 1.4 percent.

The Index of Consumer Non-Durables Industries like dried vegetables, milk, rice basmati, sugar, biscuits, black tea, waste paper etc. has decreased from 66.5 in 2017-18 to 64.2 in 2018-19, which recorded a decrease of 3.5 percent.

The General Index of Industrial Production for the series with base year 2011-12 is as under:-

# Index of Industrial Production in Haryana

#### **INTRODUCTION**

Industrial sector occupies an important position in Indian Economy and has pivotal role to play in the rapid and balanced economic development. Index of Industrial Production (IIP) is one of the tools for measuring the growth of the industrial sector at a particular point of time. The index shows the relative change over time in the volume of industrial production and is an effective tool to measure the trend of current industrial production. IIP can be defined as a single representative figure (an abstract number) to measure the general level of industrial performance in the economy. It is a short-term micro- economic indicator of industrial growth which is used extensively by Government Departments, Industrial Associations, Research Institutes, Academicians etc. for research and policy making.

Due to liberal industrial policy and close proximity of the Haryana State to National Capital, the investment in the industrial sector is growing rapidly. There is need to continuously measure the growth of industrial sector with a view to assess and plan the industrial development schemes in the State. IIP is an effective indicator to assess the performance of State economy under industrial sector over a period of time. The need to prepare IIP was also felt to facilitate comparative studies on performance of various States/ UTs in the industrial sector and to bring uniformity in selection of items basket and preparation of weighting diagram, formula with a common methodology for preparation of IIP.

At the National level, National Statistical Office (NSO), Government of India prepares all India Index of Industrial Production. The Department of Economic and Statistical Analysis, Haryana is preparing Index of Industrial Production of Haryana since the year 1971-72. A number of State Directorates of Economics & Statistics are also engaged in compiling the State level Index of Industrial Production. The Govt. of India has constituted a Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) for an in-depth examination of various technical issues such as identification of representative items basket for individual State, development of corresponding weighting diagram with an appropriate linkage with the weighting diagram of all India's Index of Industrial Production etc. The TAC resolves technical issues relating to IIP and provides technical guidance in the matter of shifting the base year of current series to new series.

The recommendations of the Technical Advisory Committee on comparable Index of Industrial Production are examined by the NSO and the guidelines on compilation of State level Index of Industrial Production are prepared. According to criteria laid down in the guidelines issued by NSO, the Department of Economic and Statistical Analysis, Haryana prepared the comparable State level Index of Industrial Production with base year 2011-12 for the year 2016-17 to 2018-19.

#### METHODOLOGY

#### **Scope and Coverage**

The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) is prepared as per National Industrial Classification (NIC)-2008 for manufacturing and electricity sectors. The manufacturing sector covers the industries registered under section 2m (i) and 2m (ii) of the factory Act, 1948 and functioning within jurisdiction of Haryana State. The section 2m (i) refers to the units employing 10 or more workers with power and section 2m (ii) refers to the units employing 20 or more workers without power on any day of the preceding twelve months.

#### **Base Year**

To capture the changes in the industrial sector, the State series of IIP is revised from time to time by dropping obsolete items, including the new items in the items basket and also by shifting the base year to a more recent one. The current State series of IIP has been revised by shifting its base year from 2004-05 to 2011-12 under the overall guidance of National Statistical Office (NSO), Govt. of India, New Delhi.

The two stage methodology has been adopted for compiling an Index of Industrial Production. The first stage is to identify and select the items to be included in the items basket which could monitor and reflect the performance of the industrial sector. The second stage is to allocate the weights to the items included in the items basket.

The State level IIP with base year 2011-12 covers two major industrial sectors viz manufacturing (Registered) and electricity. Mining and Quarrying sector has been excluded due to its insignificant contribution in GSDP which was 0.04 percent in 2011-12 in the State. For selection of items weightage of each item in the base year has been determined. For this purpose total weight has been taken as 1000. The total weight of 1000 has been first distributed to registered manufacturing and electricity sectors on the basis of Gross Value Added of each sector for the base year 2011-12. For manufacturing sector, the weights of registered manufacturing sector have further been distributed to 2 digit industry groups (10-32) of NIC 2008. Previously, NSO (IS Wing), Kolkata used to explain the methodology, selection of item basket and preparation of weighting diagram and the States / UTs are to prepare item basket and weighting diagram etc. but many States / UTs could not do it properly, therefore, this time NSO (IS Wing), Kolkata has selected the item basket and prepared weighting diagram and also prepared the list of factories (both selected and reserved) and provided to the States / UTs. The electricity sector has been taken as single item.

In all 178 items have been selected for the collection of production data for registered manufacturing sector of the year 2011-12. The selected items have been assigned use based codes

i.e. primary goods, capital goods, intermediate goods, infrastructure / construction goods, consumer durables and consumer non-durables.

The selected items have been classified under 3 digit industry groups which in turn have been classified under 2 digit industry group. List of selected items of manufacturing (registered) sector alongwith their respective item weight have been shown in table no 1.1.

#### Weighting Diagram

For this purpose, total weight has been taken as 1000. The total weight of 1000 has been first distributed to registered manufacturing and electricity sectors on the basis of Gross Value Added (GVA) of each sector for the year 2011-12. The weights of registered manufacturing sector have further been distributed to various 2 digit industry groups 10-32 of NIC-08. After that the 2 digit level weights have further been distributed to represent 3 digit groups. The weighting diagram prepared at item level is further assigned use based categories. Since electricity sector is a single item sector, no apportioning of weight has been done.

Table number 1.2 shows the distribution of weights for the year 2011-12 at sector level. Distribution of weight among selected groups at 2 & 3 digit level of manufacturing sector have been shown in table no. 1.3. Item level distribution of weights of manufacturing sector is available at table no. 1.4.

#### Selection of units

For selection of industrial units for collection of production data for manufacturing sector the unit wise ASI frame of items selected in the items basket for the year 2011-12 is used. Item-wise frame of Industrial units has been supplied by NSO (ISW), Kolkata. The month-wise data on generation of electricity taken from the website (www.cea.nic.in) of the Central Electricity Authority is used. In this way, 544 industrial units have been selected for collection of data.

#### Source of data

For manufacturing sector, the Department of Economic & Statistical Analysis, Haryana has created necessary infrastructure for collection of data regularly from industrial units selected for the purpose. The data is collected directly from the selected industrial units by the District Statistical Officers of the department. Efforts are being made to promote online system for data collection. For electricity sector, the necessary data is obtained from the website of Central Electricity Authority www.cea.nic.in.

#### **Computation of Index Number**

The change in production of selected units producing the item in the current period viz-a-viz their production in base year is relative change in the production of the item. The total production of an item in the current period is estimated using the relative change in production of the selected units.

The Index is computed by using the Laspeyre's Formula: -

The production relative of an item is defined as percentage growth of the production compared to the base year production.

The production relatives are thus calculated at product (3 digit) level of NIC code and the ultimate indices are calculated up to major group (2 digit) level. Sectoral Indices and General Index are based on weighted Laspeyre's Index Number.

#### REVIEW OF INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION IN HARYANA 2018-2019

The industry sector recorded an annual growth of 4.3 percent in 2018-19 over the previous year as the Index of Industrial Production increased from 136.1 in 2017-18 to 141.9 in 2018-19. The sector-wise and group-wise details of IIP are given below: -

#### **Manufacturing Sector**

The Index of Manufacturing sector increased from 136.1 in 2017-18 to 141.9 in 2018-19 registering an annual growth of 4.3 percent over the previous year. The manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment (25) recorded the highest growth of 24.7 percent followed by manufacture of wood and products of wood & cork, except furniture, manufacture of articles of straw & articles (16) which recorded the growth of 22.2 percent. Manufacture of beverages (11) recorded a growth of 17.7 percent. Manufacture of other none metalic products (23) recorded a growth of 16.9 percent. Manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (26) recorded a growth of 15.8 percent, manufacture of textiles (13) recorded a growth of 12.0 percent, manufacture of other transport equipment (30) recorded a growth of 11.1 percent, manufacture of leather and related products (15) recorded a growth of 10.6 percent, manufacture of motor vehicles (29) recorded a growth of 10.3 percent respectively.

#### **Electricity Sector**

The Index of Electricity Sector decreased from 110.6 in 2017-18 to 105.7 in 2018-19 registering a negative growth of 4.4 percent over the previous year.

#### Index of Industrial Production at Major Group (2-digit level) of Manufacturing Sector:-1 - Manufacture of Food Products (10)

The food manufacturing industries carry a weight of 83.50 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group increased from 53.8 in 2017-18 to 56.4 in 2018-19, recorded a growth of 4.8 percent. Mud/molasses waste 59.4 percent, refined sugar 46.2 percent, black tea (CTC) 18.2 percent, dried vegetable 17.8 percent, butter and other fats and oils derived from milk from cattle 11.5 percent, sugar confectionery (including white chocolate), not containing cocoa; vegetables fruit nuts, fruit-peel and other parts of plants, preserved by sugar 7.3 percent. Skim

milk and whey powder 3.2 percent, rice basmati 0.7 percent. Husk (animal feed), milk sauces; mixed condiments; mustard flour and meal; prepared mustard, other vegetable oils and fats, refined, sugar gola (cattle feed), gaur kernel and biscuits decreased as compared to previous year.

#### 2 - Manufacture of Beverages (11)

The beverage carry a weight of 12.57 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased from 77.1 in 2017-18 to 90.7 in 2018-19, recorded a growth of 17.6 percent. Bear made from malt recorded highest growth 27.2 percent, rectified spirit 26.2 percent, soft drink, carbonated beverages other than soda water 23.2 percent. Country liquor and its variant recorded 10.0 percent, malt, whether or not roasted recorded a growth of 2.5 percent respectively.

#### **3 - Manufacture of Tobacco Products (12)**

Tobacco group carry a weight of only 0.75 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has decreased from 351.0 in 2017-18 to 289.0 in 2018-19, recorded a negative growth of 17.7 percent. Tobacco, chewing (scented or not) in this group recorded negative growth of 18.7 percent. Other shelled nuts have also negative growth of 0.5 percent.

#### 4 - Manufacture of Textiles (13)

The textiles industries carry a weight of 40.43 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased from 143.9 in 2017-18 to 161.1 in 2018-19 and recorded a positive growth of 11.9 percent. The index of carpets and other textile floor covering knotted recorded highest growth of 53.0 percent, followed by cotton, carded or combed 32.6 percent, fabrics cotton 21.9 percent, terry towel (cotton) 21.8 percent, lining cloth, cotton 12.0 percent, yarn dyed, cotton 11.9 percent, carpets and other textile floor covering, tufted 10.4 percent, blankets 6.9 percent recorded positive growth. Fabrics, polyester fiber, fabrics, mixed, fabrics/cloth, manmade fiber fabrics, cotton fabrics, yarn of wool, containing 85% or more by weight of wool, not put up for retail sale recorded as negative growth respectively.

#### **5** - Manufacture of Wearing Apparel (14)

The wearing apparel industry has been assigned the weight of 49.68 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group decreased from 241.1 in 2017-18 to 223.8 in 2018-19, recorded a negative growth of 7.2 percent. The index of garments made up of textile fabrics impregnated has recorded a growth of 21.4 percent.

#### 6 - Manufacture of Leather and related Products (15)

The leather industries have been allotted a weight of 27.44 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased 101.7 in 2017-18 to 112.5 in 2018-19, recorded a growth of 10.6 percent. The index of hand bag, artificial fur recorded a growth of 128.2 percent, other sports footwear, except skating boots 2.6 percent, footwear incorporating a protective metal toe-cap recorded a growth of 0.1 percent, footwear with uppers of leather recorded a negative growth 1.4 percent.

#### 7 -Manufacture of Wood & Products of Wood & Cork, except Furniture, Manufacture of Articles of Straw & Plaiting Materials (16)

The wood industry has been assigned a weight of 3.09 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased from 265.4 in 2017-18 to 324.2 in 2018-19, recorded a growth of 22.2 percent. The index of plywood board, plywood, wooden chips recorded a positive growth of 84.8 percent, 33.6 percent & 11.6 percent and plywood decorative, wood cutting processed sized recorded negative growth 1.2 and 5.7 percent respectively.

#### 8 - Manufacture of Paper and Paper Products (17)

The paper industries have been assigned the weight of 9.27 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has decreased from 231.4 in 2017-18 to 129.6 in 2018-19, recorded a negative growth of 44.0 percent. The index of paper, printing & writing 11.8, polythene coated 11.5, sheet laminated plastic 16.8, boxes, corrugated sheet 92.2 percent recorded a negative growth.

#### 9 - Printing and Reproduction of Recorded Media (18)

The printing and reproduction of recorded media carry a weight of 4.16 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group increased from 212.7 in 2017-18 to 223.1 in 2018-19, recorded a growth of 4.9 percent. The index of waste paper and books recorded a positive growth of 8.0 percent and 4.6 percent respectively.

#### **10 - Manufacture of Coke, Refined Petroleum Products (19)**

The petroleum industries carry a weight of 0.41 only. The index of this group increased from 143.0 in 2017-18 to 150.4 in 2018-19, recorded a growth of 5.2 percent. The index of oxygen liquid, argon gas & nitrogen liquid recorded a growth of 7.7 percent, 5.6 percent and 1.9 percent respectively.

#### 11 - Manufacture of Chemical and Chemical Products (20)

The chemical and chemical products industry group carry a weight of 23.19 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group increased from 143.7 in 2017-18 to 151.9 in 2018-19, recorded a growth of 5.7 percent. The index of paints, plastics emulsion recorded a growth of 40.0 percent, primer, stoving, synthetic and paint recorded a growth of 11.7 percent & 6.4 percent respectively. The index of urea and bitumen recorded a negative growth 11.8 percent and 24.1 percent respectively.

#### 12 - Manufacture of Pharmaceuticals, Medicinal Chemical and Botanical Products (21)

The pharmaceuticals industries carry a weight 13.35 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group decreased from 132.1 in 2017-18 to 92.5 in 2018-19 with a negative growth of 30.0 percent. The index of glues and gelatine, peptones and their derivatives, and related products; caseinates and other casein derivatives; albuminates and other albumin derivatives increased 87.0 percent, bandage including adhesive gauze bandage recorded a growth of 6.4 percent. Ointments, allopathic, vaccine for veterinary medicine antidiabetic drugs excl. insulin (metformin, pioglitazone, glimepiride etc.) recorded negative growth.

#### 13 - Manufacture of Rubber and Plastics Products (22)

The rubber and plastic industries have been assigned a weight of 22.53. The index of this group increased from 100.0 in 2017-18 to 105.1 in 2018-19 with a positive growth of 5.1 percent. The index of component plastic 34.5 percent, plastic bag 31.6 percent, parts of footwear, removable insoles, heel cushions and similar articles, gaiters, leggings and similar articles and parts of thereof 16.7 percent, unsaturated polyester resin 9.4 percent, rubber break lining 6.4 percent, tyre tractor 4.9 percent, conveyor belts 3.5 percent, button plastic 0.7 percent recorded positive growth. Button moulds and other parts of button, button blanks, parts of slide fasteners, rubber cloth/sheet recorded a negative growth respectively.

#### 14 - Manufacture of other Non-Metallic Mineral Products (23)

This industry group carry a weight of 18.73 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased from 132.5 in 2017-18 to 155.0 in 2018-19 recorded a positive growth of 16.9 percent. The index of stone dust/powder 102.0 percent, asbestos, corrugated sheet 54.7 percent tiles, flagstones, bricks and similar articles, of cement, concrete or artificial stone 49.6

percent, cement, portland 12.1 percent, ceramic tiles 11.1 percent recorded positive growth and glass components, fiber glass sheet/board, cement, white, sanitary ware others of iron and steel, cement, others products recorded a negative growth respectively.

#### 15 - Manufacture of Basic Metals (24)

The basic metal group carry a weight of 48.60 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has decreased from 107.9 in 2017-18 to 94.5 in 2018-19 with a negative growth of 12.4 percent. The index recorded a positive growth of CR sheet 1t 600mm 34.8 percent, cast iron 34.1 percent, aluminum circles alloyed 13.2 percent, aluminum profile hollow 6.9 percent, aluminum ingots 6.4 percent, copper zinc base alloys, brass 5.3 percent, copper wire bars, refined 3.2 percent, cold finished/formed of flat rolled products 2.3 percent. The index of tubes, pipes of stainless steel, and plats hot rolled recorded a negative growth of 30.0 percent and 45.0 percent respectively.

## 16 - Manufacture of Fabricated Metal Products, Except Machinery and Equipment (25)

The fabricated metal products industry carry a weight of 32.54 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group increased from 124.8 in 2017-18 to 155.6 in 2018-19, recorded a positive growth of 24.6 percent. The index recorded a positive growth of utensils of iron (other than cast iron) or steel, enameled 57.0 percent, grease guns excl compressed air type 9.5 percent, tower for transmission lines of iron and steel 8.2 percent, liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) cylinders of iron and steel 2.9 percent, bolts, screws, nuts, iron/steel 1.8 percent, heavy machinery for fabrication 0.5 percent and link forging 0.3 percent. The index of machine screw iron and steel, forging, die stamping machines incl. presses and hammers recorded a negative growth 1.9 percent and 10.4 percent respectively.

#### 17 - Manufacture of Computer, Electronic and Optical Products (26)

This industry group carry a weight of 11.16 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased from 218.9 in 2017-18 to 253.5 in 2018-19, recorded a positive growth of 15.8 percent. The index of meter, electric-others, recorded the highest growth of 40.8 percent followed by electro-diagnostic apparatus used in medical, surgical, dental 31.5 percent, Biological microscope 25.6 percent, instruments and apparatus (except cathode-ray oscilloscopes and oscillograph) for telecommunications 19.6 percent, film polyester (metalized) 6.0 percent, audio cd/dvd player 5.5 percent, Electronic P c b/micro circuit 5.0 percent, optical

components 2.9 percent and Drafting tables and machines, and other drawing, marking out or mathematical calculating instruments 1.4 percent respectively.

#### **18-** Manufacture of Electrical Equipment (27)

The electrical equipment industries carry a weight of 58.22 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this industry group increased from 171.2 in 2017-18 to 175.7 in 2018-19, recorded a growth of 2.6 percent. The index of motor, fan recorded the highest growth of 57.0 percent followed by parts of electric motors, generators and the like 17.2 percent, fluorescent tubes 6.0 percent, cable, pvc insulated 4.2 percent, parts of electricity distribution or control apparatus 2.8 percent, fabricated metal products 0.6 percent. The index of light fitting accessories 0.6, cable, rubber insulated 5.8, wire, stainless steel, electrode quality 7.4, optical fiber cables, made up of individually sheathed fibers 19.0, boards, consoles, cabinets and other bases, equipped with electrical switching etc. apparatus, for electric control of the distribution of electricity, for a voltage exceeding 1000v, 28.8 percent recorded a negative growth respectively.

#### **19** - Manufacture of Machinery and Equipment (28)

The machinery equipment industry carry a weight of 106.63 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased from 217.4 in 2017-18 to 224.8 in 2018-19 with a growth of 3.4 percent. The filter for beverages has recorded highest growth of 52.8 percent followed by compressor used in refrigerator 15.9 percent, hydraulic equipment 13.6 percent, water pump 13.3 percent, diamond tools 12.8 percent, other agricultural tractors 10.5 percent, parts of agricultural machinery 7.7 percent, book binding machinery 5.8 percent, cultivators 2.9 percent, scrap cast iron 2.9 percent, acephate/speedometer 1.2 percent, air conditioner-window/wall 0.6 percent, bearing, steel 0.1 percent. The index of other internal combustion piston engines, other than for motor vehicles and aircraft, AC motor car 7.6, offset printing machines 15.4, tamping machines and road rollers, self-propelled 45.8 percent recorded as negative growth respectively.

#### 20 - Manufacture of Motor Vehicles, Trailers and Semi-Trailers (29)

This industry group carry highest weight of 230.72 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group increased from 134.9 in 2017-18 to 148.8 in 2018-19, recorded a growth of 10.3 percent. The leaf spring for motor vehicles has recorded highest growth of 144.6 percent followed by silencer 46.5 percent, locks used in motor vehicles 31.2 percent, engine assembly parts 28.2 percent, gear box motor vehicles 15.3 percent, trailers and semi trailer of caravan

type, for housing or camping 10.6 percent, shock absorbers 10.4 percent, mini bus/bus-complete 7.2 percent, auto door rubber fittings 7.1 percent, shafts, all kinds 5.5 percent, Axel 2.5 percent, seat for motor vehicle 1.8 percent, gear case assembles 1.5 percent. The index of spring pins 1.2, exhaust tubes 4.4, parts and accessories for the goods of subclass 49211, 6.9, air break sets 14.4 percent recorded a negative growth respectively.

#### 21 - Manufacture of Other Transport Equipment (30)

The other transport equipment industry has assigned a weight of 121.25 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group increased from 87.3 in 2017-18 to 97.0 in 2018-19, recorded a growth of 11.1 percent. Parts of motor cycle/moped/cycle has recorded highest growth of 30.1 percent followed by parts and accessories of motorcycles and side cars 7.8 percent, motorcycle, racing with cylinder capacity exceeding 50CC 0.8 percent. Tracks, railway/ tramway tracks recorded a negative growth of 2.3 percent.

#### 22 - Manufacture of Furniture (31)

The furniture industry carry a weight of 0.41 only in the Manufacturing sector. This group contained only one product i.e. furniture and fixture wooden with a negative growth of 27.4 percent.

#### 23 - Other Manufacturing (32)

The other manufacturing industry group has been assigned a weight of 9.21 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has decreased from 155.9 in 2017-18 to 155.3 in 2018-19 recorded as negative growth of 0.4 percent. The pen body plastic 38.6 percent, staplers 26.1 percent, handicraft/decorative fancy items 18.5 percent, blade, stainless steel 4.1 percent, sports goods rubber 3.6 percent, ornaments imitation 0.1 percent has recorded a positive growth respectively. Lens, ophthalmic 0.9, medical surgical or laboratory sterilizers 5.6 percent has recorded as negative growth respectively.




### Annual Index of Industrial Production in Haryana at Group Level

# Part-III Use-Based Classification of Index of Industrial Production in Haryana

## INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION IN HARYANA Use-Based Classification

The Use-Based Classification represents the changing pattern of customer's needs, based on the tastes and habits towards the purchase of industrial products. The industrial products have been clubbed into four major groups comprising of Basic Goods Industries, Capital Goods Industries, Intermediate Goods Industries and Consumer Goods Industries with a view to analyse the movement of growth rate of different groups of industries and their achievements within the frame of organized sector.

The Use-Based Classification represents the classification of the industrial products according to the product applications. Each industry group reflects the variations in the production of a particular class of industries based on product usage. The industries are classified into six groups viz., Primary Goods, Capital Goods, Intermediate Goods, Infrastructure/Construction Goods, Consumer Durables and Consumer Non-Durables Goods. Concepts and definitions for Use-Based Classification are given below.

#### (i) Primary Goods

Only such goods which are directly obtained from natural sources and used for further processing and consumption in manufacturing and power generating activities.

#### (ii) Capital Goods

Plants, machinery and goods used for further investments.

#### (iii) Infrastructure/Construction Goods

Finished goods which are primarily used in infrastructure industry or construction industry as an input. This category has been created to precisely items which could not be classified under consumer durables or intermediate goods

#### (iv) Intermediate Goods

Any goods/products produced as incomplete product or which goes as input in production for further finishing or forming a part of a product.

#### (v) Consumer Durables

Products directly used by consumers and having a longer durability (more than 2 to 3 years).

#### (vi) Consumer Non-Durables


Products that are directly used by consumers and cannot be preserved for long periods.


During the year 2018-19, Capital Goods Industries recorded highest growth of 14.4 percent, followed by Intermediate Goods 8.3 percent, Infrastructure/Construction Goods 7.2 percent Consumer Durables 1.4 percent. Primary Goods 4.9 percent and Consumer Non-Durables goods 3.5 percent recorded a negative growth.











#### **A. Primary Goods Industries**

Primary Goods Industries which has been assigned the weight of 83.59 recorded a negative growth of 4.9 percent during the year 2018-19 as compared to the previous year. The index of this industry group decreased from 117.5 in 2017-18 to 111.8 in 2018-19. Argon gas, Liquid Nitrogen, Urea, Bitumen, LPG and generation of electricity are the major products in this group. Oxygen Liquid, Argon gas, Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) Cylinders of iron and steel, Nitrogen liquid recorded a notable increase during the year 2018-19. Index of Electricity, Urea, Bitumen have recorded negative growth over the previous year.

#### **B.** Capital Goods Industries

The Index of Capital Goods Industries having weight of 312.42 showing a stable growth of 142.1 in 2017-18 to 162.5 in 2018-19. Conveyer belts, tyre tractor, link forging, optical components, biological microscope, fabricated metal products, acephate/speedometer, hydraulic equipment, diamond tools, cultivators, spring pins, mini bus, axel and shock absorbers are major products of this group. Leaf Spring for motor vehicles recorded the highest growth of 144.6 percent followed by Motors, Fan, Electro-diagnostic apparatus, used in medical, surgical, dental, engine assembly parts, biological microscope, parts of electric motors, generator and the like, compressors used in refrigerators, hydraulic equipment, diamond tools, other agriculture tractors, shock absorbers, parts of agriculture machinery, mini bus/bus complete, auto door rubber fittings, rubber break lining, book binding machinery, machinery for type setting and the offset printing, shafts, all kinds etc. have recorded as positive growth. Spring pins tracks, railway/tramway internal combustion piston engine, other than for motor vehicle and aircraft etc. have recorded a negative growth in this group.

#### **C. Intermediate Goods Industries**

The Intermediate Goods Industries carry a weight of 108.14. The Index of this industry group has increased from 117.4 in 2017-18 to 127.1 in 2018-19 recorded a increased of 8.3 percent. The stone dust/powder recorded the highest growth of 102.0 percent followed by Plywood board, Mud/molasses waste, utensils iron, CR sheet 1t 600mm, caste iron, plywood, locks used in motor vehicle, gear boxes, motor vehicle, Aluminum circle alloyed, wooden chips, saturated polyester resin, tower for transmission lines of iron and steel, aluminum alloys profile hollow, aluminum ingots, film polyester (metalized) copper zinc base alloys, brass, copper wire bars, refined etc. are including in this group have recorded as positive growth. Plywood decorative, machine screw iron and steel, fiber glass sheet/board, sanitary ware others of iron and steel etc. have recorded negative growth during the year over previous year.

#### **D. Infrastructure/Construction Goods Industries**

Infrastructure/construction Goods Industries has captured the weight of 49.01. This industry group has recorded a positive growth of 7.2 percent during the year 2018-19 as the index of this group increased from 136.1 in 2017-18 to 145.9 in 2018-19. The Asbestos, corrugated sheet recorded the highest growth of 54.7 percent followed by tiles, flagstones, bricks and similar articles of cement, concrete or artificial, Paint, Plastic, emulsion, cement Portland, primer, stoving, synthetic, ceramic tiles, paint, cable, pvc insulated etc. have recorded a positive growth. Cement white, cement other products, cable rubber insulated optical fiber cables, made up of indivisibly sheathed fiber recorded as negative growth in this group.

#### **E.** Consumer Durables Industries

The Consumer Durable Goods Industries has been assigned the weight of 335.27. The Index of this industry group has increased from 159.7 in 2017-18 to 161.9 in 2018-19 recorded a positive growth of 1.4 percent. The Hand bag, artificial fur recorded the highest growth of 128.2 percent followed by carpets and other textile floor coverings, knotted, silencer, Meter, electric-others Pen body plastic, component plastic, Cotton, carded or combed, plastic bags, parts for motor cycle/moped/cycle, staplers, fabrics, cotton, terry towel (cotton), garments made up of textile fab, impregnated, instruments and apparatus (except cathode-ray oscilloscopes and oscillographs) for telecommunication, handicraft/decorative fancy, items, parts of footwear, removable insoles, heel cushions and similar articles, gaiters, leggings and similar articles and parts thereof, water pump, lining cloth, cotton yarn dyed, cotton, trailer & semi-trailer of the caravan type, housing or camping, carpets and other textile floor covering, tufted, Grease guns excl compressed air type, parts and accessories of motor cycle and side cars, blankets, fluorescent tubes audio cd and dvd player, electronic pcb/micro circuit, books, blade, stainless steel, sports goods rubber, other sports footwear, except skating boots etc. have recorded as a positive growth. The light fitting accessories lens, ophathalmic, glass components, footwear with uppers of leather, other than sports footwear, footwear incorporating a protective metal toe-cap & miscellaneous special footwear etc. recorded as a negative growth.

#### **F.** Consumer Non -Durables Industries

The Consumer Non-Durable Goods Industries has been allotted the weight of 111.57. The Index of this industry group has decreased from 66.5 in 2017-18 to 64.2 in 2018-19 have recorded a negative growth of 3.5 percent as compared to previous year. The Clues & Gelatine, peptones & derivatives & related products caseinates & other casein derivatives; albuminates & other albumin derivatives recorded the highest growth of 87.0 percent followed by filter for

beverages, refined sugar, bear made from malt rectified spirit, rectify spirit, soft drink, carbonated beverages other than soda water, black tear (CTC) dried vegetables, butter and other fats and oils Derived from milk of cattle, country liquor and its variant, waste paper, sugar confectionery (including white chocolate), not containing cocoa; vegetables, fruit, nuts, fruit-peel and other parts of plants, preserved by sugar, bandage including adhesive gauze bandage etc. recorded as positive growth. Other shelled nuts, ornaments, allopathic, Husk (animal feed), milk, sauces; mixed condiments; mustard flour and meal; prepared mustard, there vegetable oils and fats, refined sugar, tobacco, chewing (scented or not) Gola (cattle feed) guar kernel vaccine for veterinary medicine, Biscuits, Antidiabetic drugs excl. insulin (metformin, pioglitazone, glimepiride etc.) have recorded a negative growth.
