development to measure trend in the behavior of the industrial performance over a period of

time in comparison to a chosen base year. It indicates the relative change of physical

production in the field of industries during a specified year as compared to previous year.

The Department of Economic and Statistical Affairs, Haryana has been compiling

the Index of Industrial Production for Haryana State under the guidance of the National

Statistical Office (NSO), Govt. of India since 1971-72 and publishes its report on annual

basis. The present report containing information relating to IIP from the year 2021-22 is the

fifth issue of the series with base year 2011-12. This Index of Industrial Production of

Haryana State relates to Manufacturing and Electricity Sectors with an analysis of use-based

classification of the index numbers.

This report provides an useful information for planners, industrialists and researchers

etc. interested in the industrial development of the State.

I take this opportunity to thank the National Statistical Office, Government of India

for providing valuable guidance. Efforts made by the District Statistical Offices for collection

of production data from various industrial units are also acknowledged. The cooperation

extended by various industrial units of the State for providing required production data for

computation of IIP are appreciated and acknowledged.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Industrialization plays a vital and crucial role in the economic development of an economy. It accelerates economic growth of a State and thereby increases the contribution of Industry Sector in the State Domestic Product by way of increase in the production and employment. Index of Industrial Production (IIP) is one of the prime indicators of the economic development for measurement of trend in the industrial production over a period of time with reference to a chosen base year.

The Index of Industrial Production for the State is compiled in accordance with the guidelines of the National Statistical Office (NSO), Govt. of India. In Part-I of the report, the detailed methodology, sources of data and computation of index numbers have been presented.

A total of 178 items have been selected from Registered Manufacturing sector for the year 2011-12. Electricity has been taken as a single item. Mining and Quarrying sector has been excluded due to its insignificant contribution in GSDP which was 0.04% in 2011-12 in the State. The total weight of Industrial Sector has been taken as 1000 which has been distributed to Registered Manufacturing & Electricity sectors. The weights of Registered Manufacturing sector have further been distributed at 2/3 digit as well as item level as per criteria suggested by NSO. Production data of selected items are collected directly from the selected factories in the State.

Presently, Index of Industrial Production is being prepared in the State with 2011-12 base year and covers Manufacturing and Electricity sectors. Index number has been calculated at sector level, group level (2 digits) and item level. The same has been presented in the report accordingly. Review of index numbers for the year 2021-22 has also been given in the report.

The General Index of Industrial Production with 2011-12 base year increased from 151.2 in 2020-21 to 169.2 in 2021-22 registering a growth of 11.9 percent. The Index of Manufacturing sector which carries the highest weight in IIP increased from 158.1 in 2020-21 to 174.6 in 2021-22, positive growth of 10.4 percent. The Index of Electricity sector indicates a positive growth of 60.9 percent as it is increased from 61.9 in 2020-21 to 99.6 in 2021-22.

In last part of the report, the use-based classification which represents the changing pattern of customer's needs, based on taste and habits towards the purchase of industrial product has been given. Review of the use-based classification for the year 2021-22 has also been given therein. The report elaborates that the Index of Primary Goods Industries like argon gas, urea, bitumen, LPG cylinder of iron and steel, electricity etc. has increased from 57.4 in 2020-21 to 90.7 in 2021-22 which recorded an increase of 58.01 percent.

The Index of Capital Goods Industries like conveyor belts, tractor tyres, link forging, optical components, acephate/speedometer, diamond tools, spring pins etc. decreased from 209.2 in 2020-21 to 207.6 in 2021-22, which recorded a decrease of 0.76 percent.

The Index of Intermediate Goods Industries like plywood boards, wooden chips, cast iron, stone dust powder, motor vehicle seats etc. has increased from 173.8 in 2020-21 to 174.6 in 2021-22, recording a growth of 0.46 percent.


The Index of Infrastructure/Construction Goods Industries like paints, ceramic tiles, scrap cast iron etc. has increased from 110.0 in 2020-21 to 127.6 in 2021-22, recording a positive growth of 16 percent.

The Index of Consumer Durables Industries like cotton fabrics, blankets, artificial fur hand bags, books, rexin, button plastic, glass components, water pump, AC motor car etc. has increased from 151.6 in 2020-21 to 208.7 in 2021-22, registering a posiotive growth of 37.7 percent.

The Index of Consumer Non-Durables Industries like dried vegetables, milk, rice basmati, sugar, biscuits, black tea, waste paper etc. has decreased from 53.8 in 2020-21 to 40.8 in 2021-22, which registering a negative growth of -24.1 percent.

The General Index of Industrial Production for the series with base year 2011-12 is as under:-

### INTRODUCTION

Industrial sector occupies an important position in Indian Economy and has pivotal role to play in the rapid and balanced economic development. Index of Industrial Production (IIP) is one of the tools for measuring the growth of the industrial sector at a particular point of time. The index shows the relative change over time in the volume of industrial production and is an effective tool to measure the trend of current industrial production. IIP can be defined as a single representative figure (an abstract number) to measure the general level of industrial performance in the economy. It is a short-term micro- economic indicator of industrial growth which is used extensively by Government Departments, Industrial Associations, Research Institutes, and Academicians etc. for research and policy making.

Due to liberal industrial policy and close proximity of the Haryana State to National Capital, the investment in the industrial sector is growing rapidly. There is need to continuously measure the growth of industrial sector with a view to assess and plan the industrial development schemes in the State. IIP is an effective indicator to assess the performance of State economy under industrial sector over a period of time. The need to prepare IIP was also felt to facilitate comparative studies on performance of various States/UTs in the industrial sector and to bring uniformity in selection of items basket and preparation of weighting diagram, formula with a common methodology for preparation of IIP.

At the National level, National Statistical Office (NSO), Government of India prepares all India Index of Industrial Production. The Department of Economic and Statistical Affairs, Haryana is preparing Index of Industrial Production of Haryana since the year 1971-72. A number of State Directorates of Economics & Statistics are also engaged in compiling the State level Index of Industrial Production. The Govt. of India has constituted a Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) for an in-depth examination of various technical issues such as identification of representative items basket for individual State, development of corresponding weighting diagram with an appropriate linkage with the weighting diagram of all India's Index of Industrial Production etc. The TAC resolves technical issues relating to IIP and provides technical guidance in the matter of shifting the base year of current series to new series.

The recommendations of the Technical Advisory Committee on comparable Index of Industrial Production are examined by the NSO and the guidelines on compilation of State level Index of Industrial Production are prepared. According to criteria laid down in the guidelines issued by NSO, the Department of Economic and Statistical Affairs, Haryana prepared the comparable State level Index of Industrial Production with base year 2011-12 for the year 2021-22.

### **METHODOLOGY**

### **Scope and Coverage**

The Index of Industrial Production (IIP) is prepared as per National Industrial Classification (NIC)-2008 for manufacturing and electricity sectors. The manufacturing sector covers the industries registered under section 2m (i) and 2m (ii) of the factory Act, 1948 and functioning within jurisdiction of Haryana State. The section 2m (i) refers to the units employing 10 or more workers with power and section 2m (ii) refers to the units employing 20 or more workers without power on any day of the preceding twelve months.

### **Base Year**

To capture the changes in the industrial sector, the State series of IIP is revised from time to time by dropping obsolete items, including the new items in the items basket and also by shifting the base year to a more recent one. The current State series of IIP has been prepared on its base year 2011-12 under the overall guidance of National Statistical Office (NSO), Govt. of India, New Delhi.

The two stage methodology has been adopted for compiling an Index of Industrial Production. The first stage is to identify and select the items to be included in the items basket which could monitor and reflect the performance of the industrial sector. The second stage is to allocate the weights to the items included in the items basket.

The State level IIP with base year 2011-12 covers two major industrial sectors viz manufacturing (Registered) and electricity. Mining and Quarrying sector has been excluded due to its insignificant contribution in GSDP which was 0.04 percent in 2011-12 in the State. For selection of items weightage of each item in the base year has been determined. For this purpose total weight has been taken as 1000. The total weight of 1000 has been first distributed to registered manufacturing and electricity sectors on the basis of Gross Value Added of each sector for the base year 2011-12. For manufacturing sector, the weights of registered manufacturing sector have further been distributed to 2 digit industry groups (10-32) of NIC 2008. Previously, NSO (IS Wing), Kolkata used to explain the methodology, selection of item basket and preparation of weighting diagram and the States / UTs are to

prepare item basket and weighting diagram etc. but many States / UTs could not do it properly, therefore, NSO (IS Wing), Kolkata has selected the item basket and prepared weighting diagram and also prepared the list of factories (both selected and reserved) and provided to the States / UTs. The electricity sector has been taken as single item.

In all 178 items have been selected for the collection of production data for registered manufacturing sector of the base year 2011-12. The selected items have been assigned use based codes i.e. primary goods, capital goods, intermediate goods, infrastructure / construction goods, consumer durables and consumer non-durables.

The selected items have been classified under 3 digit industry groups which in turn have been classified under 2 digit industry group. List of selected items of manufacturing (registered) sector alongwith their respective item weight have been shown in table no 1.1.

### **Weighting Diagram**

For this purpose, total weight has been taken as 1000. The total weight of 1000 has been first distributed to registered manufacturing and electricity sectors on the basis of Gross Value Added (GVA) of each sector for the year 2011-12. The weights of registered manufacturing sector have further been distributed to various 2 digit industry groups 10-32 of NIC-08. After that the 2 digit level weights have further been distributed to represent 3 digit groups. The weighting diagram prepared at item level is further assigned use based categories. Since electricity sector is a single item sector, no apportioning of weight has been done.

Table number 1.2 shows the distribution of weights for the year 2011-12 at sector level. Distribution of weight among selected groups at 2 & 3 digit level of manufacturing sector have been shown in table no. 1.3. Item level distribution of weights of manufacturing sector is available at table no. 1.4.

### **Selection of units**

For selection of industrial units for collection of production data for manufacturing sector the unit wise ASI frame of items selected in the items basket for the year 2011-12 is used. Item-wise frame of Industrial units has been supplied by NSO (ISW), Kolkata. The month-wise data on generation of electricity taken from the website (<a href="www.cea.nic.in">www.cea.nic.in</a>) and (npp.gov.in) NPP portal of the Central Electricity Authority is used. In this way, 544 industrial units have been selected for collection of data.

### Source of data

For manufacturing sector, the Department of Economic & Statistical Affairs, Haryana has created necessary infrastructure for collection of data regularly from industrial units selected for the purpose. The data is collected directly from the selected industrial units by the District Statistical Officers of the department. Efforts are being made to promote online system for data collection. For electricity sector, the necessary data is obtained from the website of Central Electricity Authority www.cea.nic.in and NPP portal npp.gov.in.

### **Computation of Index Number**

The change in production of selected units producing the item in the current period viz-a-viz their production in base year is relative change in the production of the item. The total production of an item in the current period is estimated using the relative change in production of the selected units.

The Index is computed by using the Laspeyre's Formula: -

The production relative of an item is defined as percentage growth of the production compared to the base year production.

Ri =  $\frac{\text{Pei } X}{\text{Pei}}$  100

Where Ri = Production relative of ith selected item.

Pci = Current year production of ith item

Poi = Base year production of ith item.

The production relatives are thus calculated at product (3 digit) level of NIC code and the ultimate indices are calculated up to major group (2 digit) level. Sectoral Indices and General Index are based on weighted Laspeyre's Index Number.

# Part-II Review of Index of Industrial Production in

Haryana

### REVIEW OF INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION IN HARYANA 2021-22

The industry sector recorded an annual positive growth of 11.9 percent in 2021-22 over the previous year as the Index of Industrial Production increased from 151.2 in 2020-21 to 169.2 in 2021-22. The sector-wise and group-wise details of IIP are given below: -

### **Manufacturing Sector**

The Index of Manufacturing sector increased from 158.1 in 2020-21 to 174.6 in 2021-22 registering an annual positive growth of 10.4 percent over the previous year. The manufacture of Other manufacturing (32) recorded a growth of 38.0 percent, Manufacture of food products (10) recorded a negative growth of 30.7 percent, Manufacture of Basic metals (24) recorded a growth of 26.0 percent, Manufacture of Machinery equipment n.e.c (28) recorded a growth of 75.8 percent, Manufacture of tobacco products (12) recorded a negative growth of 14.6 percent, Manufacture of other transport equipment (30) recorded a negative growth of 36.1 percent, Manufacture of wearing apparel (14) recorded a negative growth of 54.7 percent respectively.

### **Electricity Sector**

The Index of Electricity Sector increased from 61.9 in 2020-21 to 99.6 in 2021-22 registering a positive growth of 60.7 percent over the previous year.

# Index of Industrial Production at Major Group (2-digit level) of Manufacturing Sector:-

### 1 - Manufacture of Food Products (10)

The food manufacturing industries carry a weight of 83.50 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group decreased from 52.1 in 2020-21 to 36.1 in 2021-22 recorded a negative growth of 30.7 percent. The index of Milk has recorded a highest growth of 308.4 percent followed by Husk (animal feed) 112.9 percent, Butter and other fats and oils derived from milk of cattle 112.4 percent, Dried vegetable 67.2 percent, Guar kernel 45.5 percent, Biscuit 25.8 percent, Other vegetable oils and fats, refined 11.0 percent, Gola (cattle feed) 5.9 percent, Sauces; mixed condiments; mustard flour and meals; prepared mustard 1.1 percent. The index of, Skim milk and whey powder, Black tea (CTC), Refined sugar, Mud/molasses waste, Vegetables, fruit, nuts, fruit-peel and other parts of plants, preserved by sugar, Rice basmati and Sugar recorded a negative growth respectively.

### 2 - Manufacture of Beverages (11)

The beverage carry a weight of 12.57 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has decreased from 77.9 in 2020-21 to 28.4 in 2021-22 recorded a negative growth of 63.5 percent. The index of Soft drinks, carbonated beverages other than soda water, Country Liquor and it variant, Bear made from malt, Malt whether or not roasted, Rectified spirit recorded a negative growth respectively.

### 3 - Manufacture of Tobacco Products (12)

Tobacco group carry a weight of only 0.75 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has decreased from 225.2 in 2020-21 to 178.5 in 2021-22, recorded a negative growth of 20.7 percent. The index of Other Shelled nuts and Tobacco, chewing (scented or not) in this group recorded a negative growth respectively.

### 4 - Manufacture of Textiles (13)

The textiles industries carry a weight of 40.43 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has decreased from 142.8 in 2020-21 to 117.2 in 2021-22 recorded a negative growth of 17.9 percent. The index of Yarn dyed and cotton is recorded highest growth 77.6 percent followed by Fabrics/cloth 36.6 percent, Carpets and other textile floor covering, tufted 30.3 percent, Fabrics mixed 24.4 percent, Fabrics cotton 13.4 percent respectively. The index of Cotton fabrics, Carpets and other textile floor coverings, Knotted, blankets, Terry towel (cotton), Man-made fiber fabrics, Cotton, carded or combed , Lining cloth, cotton recorded a negative growth respectively.

### 5 - Manufacture of Wearing Apparel (14)

The wearing apparel industry has been assigned the weight of 49.68 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group decreased from 229.2 in 2020-21 to 103.9 in 2021-22 recorded a negative growth of 54.6 percent. The index of Garments made up of textile fabrics impregnated, Garments cloth, cotton, Garments made up of textile fabrics coated with other materials and recorded a negative growth respectively.

### **6 - Manufacture of Leather and related Products (15)**

The leather industries have been allotted a weight of 27.44 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased 106.4 in 2020-21 to 127.2 in 2021-22 recorded a positive growth of 19.5 percent. The index of Other sports foot wear, except skating boots recorded a highest growth 50.0 percent. Footwear incorporating a protective metal toe-cap, except those covered in subclass 29320 recorded a growth of 38.7 percent. The index of

Footwear with uppers of leather, other than sports footwear, footwear incorporating a protective metal toe-cap and misc. special footwear and Hand Bag, artificial fur recorded a negative growth of 33.1 and 19.1 percent respectively.

### 7 -Manufacture of Wood & Products of Wood & Cork, except Furniture, Manufacture of Articles of Straw & Plaiting Materials (16)

The wood industry has been assigned a weight of 3.09 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased from 249.8 in 2020-21 to 339.5 in 2021-22 recorded a positive growth of 35.9 percent. The index of Plywood recorded a highest Growth of 203.2 percent followed by Plywood decorative 45.4 percent, Wooden chips 9.3 percent. The index of Wood cutting processed sized and plywood board recorded a negative growth respectively.

### 8 - Manufacture of Paper and Paper Products (17)

The paper industries have been assigned the weight of 9.27 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased from 77.8 in 2020-21 to 89.7 in 2021-22 recorded a positive growth of 15.2 percent. The index of laminated plastic recorded a highest positive growth of 338.2 percent followed by Paper polythene coated 55.9 percent, Other paper ,paper board, cellulose wadding and webs of cellulose fibers, cut to size or shape, cigarette paper, in booklets or in rolls of a width not exceeding 5cm; of other articles of paper pulp, paper, paperboard, cellulose wadding or webs recorded as 53.3 percent positive growth , Boxes, corrugated sheet, paper, prim boxes, corrugated sheet as 0.7 percent positive growth respectively. Paper printing and writing recorded a negative growth 1.9 percent.

### 9 - Printing and Reproduction of Recorded Media (18)

The printing and reproduction of recorded media carry a weight of 4.16 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group increased from 159.5 in 2020-21 to 200.5 in 2021-22 recorded apositive growth of 25.7 percent. The index of books and waste paper recorded a positive growth 72.1 and 24.7 respectively.

### 10 - Manufacture of Coke, Refined Petroleum Products (19)

The petroleum industries carry a weight of 0.41 only. The index of this group decreased from 104.8 in 2020-21 to 79.8 in 2021-22, recorded a negative growth of 31.3 percent. The index of industrial production of Argon gas increased 15.1 percent. nitrogen liquid, oxygen liquid recorded a negative growth 16.8 and 38.1 percent respectively.

### 11 - Manufacture of Chemical and Chemical Products (20)

The chemical and chemical products industry group carry a weight of 23.19 in the

Manufacturing sector. The index of this group increased from 85.5 in 2020-21 to 106.4 in 2021-22 recorded a positive growth of 24.4 percent. The index of Bitumen recorded a highest growth 306.1 followed by, Paint, plastics emulsion 39.6, recorded a positive growth 39.6 percent, Paint 25.0 percent, Primer, stoving, synthetic 2.8 percent positive growth respectively.

# 12 - Manufacture of Pharmaceuticals, Medicinal Chemical and Botanical Products (21)

The pharmaceuticals industries carry a weight 13.35 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group inreased from 38.8 in 2020-21 to 77.8 in 2021-22 with a positive growth of 100.5 percent. The vaccine for Anti diabetic drugs excl. insulin (metformin, pioglitazone, glimepiride etc.) recorded a positive growth1216.9 percent followed by vaccine for veterinary medicine 444.3 percent, Bandage including adhesive gauze bandage 35.6 percent. The index of Ointments, allopathic and Glues and gelatin, peptones and their derivatives and related products; castigates and other casein derivatives; aluminates and other albumin derivatives recorded negative growth respectively.

### 13 - Manufacture of Rubber and Plastics Products (22)

The rubber and plastic industries have been assigned a weight of 22.53. The index of this group increased from 37.4 in 2020-21 to 38.9 in 2021-22 with a positive growth of 4.0 percent. The index of Button plastic highest positive growth 659.9 percent followed by Tyre tractor 218.9 percent, Rubber cloth/sheet 70.2 percent growth, Component plastic 35.7 percent, Unsaturated polyester resin 34.1 percent, Plastic bag 8.9 percent. The index of Parts of footwear, removable insoles, heel cushions and similar articles, gaiters, leggings and similar articles and parts, plastic bag, rubber cloth/sheet, Button moulds and other parts of button, button blanks, parts of slide fasteners, Rubber break lining, recorded a negative growth respectively.

### 14 - Manufacture of other Non-Metallic Mineral Products (23)

This industry group carry a weight of 18.73 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has decreased from 142.5 in 2020-21 to 91.5 in 2021-22 recorded a negative growth of 35.7 percent. The index of Tiles, flagstones, bricks and similar articles, of cement, concrete or artificial stone recorded highest growth of 134.1 percent followed by sanitary ware others of iron and steel,58.2 percent, cement, ceramic tiles 44.6 percent cement, others products 11.3 percent. The index of Cement Portland, Cement, others products, Sanitary ware

others of iron and steel, Cement Portland, Cement White, Stone dust/powder, Glass components, Asbestos, corrugated sheet, Fibre glass sheet/board recorded a negative growth respectively.

### 15 - Manufacture of Basic Metals (24)

The basic metal group carry a weight of 48.60 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased from 104.2 in 2020-21 to 131.3 in 2021-22 recorded a positive growth of 26.0 percent. The index recorded a highest positive growth of Aluminum ingots 1786.8 percent followed by CR sheet 1t 600mm 71.0 percent, copper wire bars, refined 44.3 percent, cast iron 41.0 percent Aluminum circles alloyed 22.5 percent, Tubes, pipes of stainless steel 5.8 percent. The index of Plates, hot rolled, Cold finished/formed of flat rolled, Copper zinc, base alloys, brass recorded a negative growth respectively.

# 16 - Manufacture of Fabricated Metal Products, Except Machinery and Equipment (25)

The fabricated metal products industry carry a weight of 32.54 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group decreased from 121.4 in 2020-21 to 118.2 percent in 2021-22 recorded a negative growth of 2.6 percent. The index recorded a highest growth link forging 479.9 percent followed by heavy Machinery for fabrication 344.1 percent Grease guns excl compressed air type 200.0 percent, Bolts, screws, nuts, iron/steel 18.4 percent. The index of Link forging, Machine screw iron and steel, Forging, die stamping machines, Presses and hammers, Liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) cylinders of iron and steel, Utensils of iron (other than cast iron) or steel, enameled, recorded a negative growth respectively.

### 17 - Manufacture of Computer, Electronic and Optical Products (26)

This industry group carry a weight of 11.16 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has decreased from 255.2 in 2020-21to 90.9 percent in 2021-22, recorded a negative growth of 99.9 percent. The index of Optical components recorded a highest growth 58.2 percent followed by electro-diagnostic apparatus used in medical, surgical, dental 17.4 percent, Drafting tables and machines, and other drawing, marking out or mathematical calculating instruments, Electronic pcb/microcircuit 8.2 percent. The index of Film polyester (metalized), Meter, electric-others, Biological microscope, Instruments and apparatus (except cathode-ray oscilloscopes and oscillograph) for telecommunications, Audio cd/dvd player. recorded a negative growth respectively.

### **18-** Manufacture of Electrical Equipment (27)

The electrical equipment industries carry a weight of 58.22 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this industry group decreased from 251.2 in 2020-21 to 187.6 in 2021-22, recorded a negative growth of 25.3 percent. The index of cable, pvc insulated recorded the highest growth of 654.1 percent followed by Fluorescent tubes 160.2 percent, wire, stainless steel, electrode quality 90.5 percent, Light fitting accessories 19.3 percent, Optical fiber cables, made up of individually sheathed fibers 16.6 percent. The index of Motor fan, Cable, rubber insulated, parts of electricity distribution or control apparatus, boards, consoles, cabinets and other bases, equipped with electrical switching etc. apparatus, for electric control of the distribution of electricity, for a voltage exceeding 1000v, Parts of electric motors, generators and the like, fabricated metal products, recorded a negative growth respectively.

### 19 - Manufacture of Machinery and Equipment (28)

The machinery equipment industry carry a weight of 106.6 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased from 222.9 in 2020-21 to 391.8 in 2021-22 with a positive growth of 75.8 percent. Air conditioner-window/wall 785.5 percent recorded a highest positive growth of 785.5 percent followed by scrap cast iron 68.7 percent, compressor used in refrigerator 47.9 percent, Offset printing machines 12.7 percent. The index of AC motor car, Bearing, steel, Book Binding machinery, machinery for type-setting and the for for uses ancillary to printing (except office type sheet-fed), Hydraulic equipment, Filter for beverages, Water pump, Tamping machines and rod rollers, self propelled, Acephate/speedo meter, Cultivators, Diamond tools, Other agricultural tractors, internal combustion piston engines, cultivators, other than for motor vehicles and aircraft parts of agricultural machinery, recorded a negative growth respectively.

### 20 - Manufacture of Motor Vehicles, Trailers and Semi-Trailers (29)

This industry group carry highest weight of 230.72 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group increased from 174.3 in 2020-21 20 to 225.9 in 2021-22 recorded a Positive growth of 29.6 percent. The index of engine assembly parts recorded as highest positive growth 125.5 percent followed by Exhaust tubes 122.4 percent, Spring pinch 75.9 percent, Locks used in motor vehicle 75.3 percent, Axel 54.2 percent, Shafts all kinds 32.7 percent, Mini bus/bus-complete 11.2 percent, Gear boxes, motor vehicles 10.7 percent, Silencer 10.6 percent, Air break sets 0.1 percent, Steering gear control system, Auto door rubber fittings, Shock absorbers, Sheet for motor vehicle, Gear case assemblies, Parts and

accessories for the good job subclass 49211, Parts of petrol engine for motor vehicles, Trailers and semi trailer of caravan type, for housing or camping, Leaf spring for motor vehicles recorded a negative growth respectively.

.

### 21 - Manufacture of Other Transport Equipment (30)

The other transport equipment industry has assigned a weight of 121.25 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group decreased from 119.7 in 2020-21 to 76.5 percent in 2021-22 recorded a negative growth of 36.0 percent. Tracks, railway/tramway recorded a highest growth 11.8 percent. The index of Motor cycle, racing with cylinder capacity exceeding 50 cc, Parts and accessories of motorcycles and side cars, Parts for motorcycle/moped/cycle recorded a negative growth respectively.

### 22 - Manufacture of Furniture (31)

The furniture industry carry a weight of 0.41 only in the Manufacturing sector. This group contained only one product i.e. furniture and fixture wooden with a negative growth of 99.7 percent.

## 23 - Other Manufacturing (32)

The other manufacturing industry group has been assigned a weight of 9.21 in the Manufacturing sector. The index of this group has increased from 859.6 in 2020-21 to 1186.0 in 2021-22 recorded as positive growth of 38.0 percent. The index of blade, stainless steel has recorded highest growth of 77.2 percent followed by staplers 69.1 percent, Electricity 60.7 percent, Medical surgical or laboratory sterilizers 18.8 percent, Lens, ophthalmic 15.8 percent. The index of Sports goods rubber, Pen body plastic, has recorded a negative growth respectively.

# Part-III Use-Based Classification of Index of Industrial Production in Haryana

### INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION IN HARYANA

### **Use-Based Classification**

The Use-Based Classification represents the changing pattern of customer's needs, based on the tastes and habits towards the purchase of industrial products. The industrial products have been clubbed into four major groups comprising of Basic Goods Industries, Capital Goods Industries, Intermediate Goods Industries and Consumer Goods Industries with a view to analyse the movement of growth rate of different groups of industries and their achievements within the frame of organized sector.

The Use-Based Classification represents the classification of the industrial products according to the product applications. Each industry group reflects the variations in the production of a particular class of industries based on product usage. The industries are classified into six groups viz., Primary Goods, Capital Goods, Intermediate Goods, Infrastructure/Construction Goods, Consumer Durables and Consumer Non-Durables Goods. Concepts and definitions for Use-Based Classification are given below.

### (i) Primary Goods

Only such goods which are directly obtained from natural sources and used for further processing and consumption in manufacturing and power generating activities.

### (ii) Capital Goods

Plants, machinery and goods used for further investments.

### (iii) Infrastructure/Construction Goods

Finished goods which are primarily used in infrastructure industry or construction industry as an input. This category has been created to precisely items which could not be classified under consumer durables or intermediate goods

### (iv) Intermediate Goods

Any goods/products produced as incomplete product or which goes as input in production for further finishing or forming a part of a product.

### (v) Consumer Durables

Products directly used by consumers and having a longer durability (more than 2 to 3 years).

### (vi) Consumer Non-Durables

Products that are directly used by consumers and cannot be preserved for long periods.

The share of each use-based industry group to the industry sector of the State and the number of industrial groups and items covered representing the use-based groups are as under: -


During the year 2021-22, Primary Goods Industries recorded highest growth of 58.0 percent, followed by Consumer Durables Goods 37.7 percent. Infrastructure / Construction Goods 16.0 percent, Intermediate Goods Industries 0.5 percent, Capital Goods Industries and Consumer Non-Durables recorded a negative growth.

















### **A. Primary Goods Industries**

Primary Goods Industries which has been assigned the weight of 83.59 recorded a positive growth of 58.0 percent during the year 2021-22 as compared to the previous year. The index of this industry group increased from 57.4 in 2020-21 to 90.7 in 2021-22. The Bitumen, Electricity, Argon gas recorded a positive growth in this group. The index of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) Cylinders of iron and steel, Oxygen liquid, Urea and Liquid Nitrogen have recorded negative growth over the previous year.

### **B.** Capital Goods Industries

The Index of Capital Goods Industries having weight of 312.42 showing a stable growth of 209.2 in 2020-21 to 207.6 in 2021-22. recorded a negative growth of -0.8 Percent. The Link forging, Heavy machinery for fabrication, Tyre tractor, Steering gear control system, Engine assembly parts, Exhaust tubes, Wire, stainless steel, electrode quality, Spring pins, Optical components, Axel, Compressors used in refrigerator, Leaf spring for motor vehicles, Shafts, all kinds, Electro-diagnostic apparatus, used in medical, surgical, dental, Offset printing machines, Tracks, railway/tramway, Mini bus / bus - complete and Air brake sets recorded a positive growth in this group. The index of Conveyor belts, Forging, die stamping machines incl. Presses and hammers, Motors, fan, Bookbinding machinery; machinery for type-setting and the and offset printing machinery) like; printing machinery machines for uses ancillary to printing (except office type sheet-fed, Auto door rubber fittings, Shock absorbers, Parts of electricity distribution or control apparatus, Hydraulic equipment, Tamping machines and road rollers, self-propelled, Acephate / Speedometer, Biological microscope, Parts of electric motors, generators and the like, Cultivators, Fabricated metal products, Diamond tools, Other agricultural tractors, Rubber brake lining, Internal combustion piston engines, other than for motor vehicles and aircraft and Parts of agricultural machinery recorded a negative growth in this group.

### C. Intermediate Goods Industries

The Intermediate Goods Industries carry a weight of 108.14. The Index of this industry group has increased from 173.8 in 2020-21 to 174.6 in 2021-22 recorded a increased of 0.5 percent. The Aluminium ingots, Sheet laminatied plastic, Plywood, Locks used in motor vehicles, C R sheet 1 t 600 mm, Sanitary ware others of iron and steel, Plywood decorative, Copper wire bars, refined, Cast iron, Unsaturated Polyester Resin, Aluminium

circles alloyed, Medical, surgical or laboratory sterilizers, Bolts, screws, nuts, iron /steel, Gear boxes, motor vehicles, Wooden chips and Tubes, pipes of stainless steel recorded as positive growth in this group. The index of Aluminium alloys profile hollow, Machine screw iron and steel, Bearing, steel, Plates, hot rolled, Wood cutting processed sized, Seat for motor vehicle, Plywood board, Gear case assemblies, Film polyester (metalised), Utensils of iron ( other than cast iron) or steel, enamelled, Towers for transmission lines of iron and steel, Mud / molasses waste, Copper zinc base alloys, brass, Stone dust/powder and Fibre glass sheet/board recorded as negative growth during the year over previous year.

### D. Infrastructure/Construction Goods Industries

Infrastructure/construction Goods Industries has captured the weight of 49.01. This industry group has recorded a positive growth of 16.0 percent during the year 2021-22 as the index of this group increased from 110 in 2020-21 to 127.6 in 2021-22. The Cable, pvc insulated, Tiles, flagstones, bricks and similar articles, of cement, concrete or artificial stone, Scrap cast iron, Ceramic tiles, Paints, plastic emulsion, Paint, Optical fibre cables made up of individually sheathed fibres, Cement, others products and Primer, stoving, synthetic recorded as positive growth in this group. The index of Cement, portland, Cable, rubber insulated, Cold finished/formed of flat rolled products, Cement, White and Asbestos, corrugated sheet recorded a negative growth in this group.

### E. Consumer Durables Industries

The Consumer Durable Goods Industries has been assigned the weight of 335.27. The Index of this industry group has increased from 151.6 in 2020-21 to 208.7 in 2021-22 recorded a positive growth of 37.7 percent. The index of Ornaments imitation, Air conditioner-window/wall, Button plastic, Grease guns excl compressed air type, Fluorescent tubes, Yarn dyed, cotton, Blade, stainless steel, Rubber cloth/sheet, Staplers, Paper polythene coated, Other paper, paperboard, cellulose wadding and webs of cellulose fibres, cut to size or shape; cigarette paper, in booklets or tubes, or in rolls of a width not exceeding 5 cm; of other articles of paper pulp, paper, paperboard, cellulose wadding or webs, Other sports footwear, except skating boots, Footwear incorporating a protective metal toe-cap, except those covered in subclass 29320, Fabrics/cloth, Components plastic, Carpets and other textile floor coverings, tufted, Books, Fabrics, mixed, Light fitting accessories, Lens, ophthalmic, Drafting tables and machines, and other drawing, marking-out or mathematical calculating

instruments, Fabrics, cotton, Silencer, Plastic bag, Electronic p c b /micro circuit, Handicraft / decorative fancy items, Yarn of wool, containing 85% or more by weight of wool, not put up for retail sale and Boxes, corrugated sheet recorded as positive growth in this group. ### F. Consumer Non -Durables Industries

The Consumer Non-Durable Goods Industries has been allotted the weight of 111.57. The Index of this industry group has decreased from 53.8 in 2020-21 to 40.8 in 2021-22 have recorded a negative growth of -24.1 percent as compared to previous year. The index of Antidiabetic drugs excl.insulin (metformin, pioglitazone, glimepiride etc), Vaccine for veterinary medicine, Milk, Husk (animal feed), Butter and other fats and oils derived from milk of cattle, Waste paper, Dried vegetables, Guar kernel, Bandage including adhesive gauze bandage, Biscuits, Other vegetable oils and fats, refined, Gola (cattle feed) and Sauces; mixed condiments; mustard flour and meal; prepared mustard recorded as a positive growth. The index of Ointments, allopathic, Tobacco, chewing (scented or not ), Other shelled nuts, Skim milk and whey powder, Black Tea (CTC), Filters for beverages,

Soft drink, carbonated beverage other than soda water, Refined sugar, Sugar confectionery (including white chocolate), not containing cocoa; vegetables, fruit, nuts, fruit-peel and other parts of plants, preserved by sugar, Rice basmati, Country Liqour and it variant, Beer made from malt, Sugar, Malt, whether or not roasted, Glues and gelatine, peptones and their derivatives, and related products; caseinates and other casein derivatives; albuminates and other albumin derivatives and Rectified spirit have recorded as negative growth respectively.
