The DG, ESIC extended warm welcome to the Hon'ble Chairman and members of the ESI Corporation. He, in his welcome address, mentioned about ongoing activities of the ESIC since the last meeting of the Corporation held on 31st July, 2014 and progress made in various initiatives (Annexure-II).

Sh.Sudarshan Sareen, Sh. C.P. Singh and Sh. Chandrakant Khaire, on behalf of their colleagues, welcomed the Chairman on his taking charge as Minister of State, Labour & Employment (I/C) and Chairman, ESIC. They also welcomed him to his first meeting of ESI Corporation.

If there is another ESI hospital within 50KM, then each ESI hospital should fulfil these norms in the respective catchment area. (For example, if the two ESI hospitals are at a distance of 40KM, then each hospital should satisfy these norms within a radius of 20KM.)
