

In-Service Courses

In-service training is a critical component of professional development in KVS. It helps teachers to enhance their skills and knowledge, improve the quality of education provided to students, meet the challenges of teaching in a rapidly changing educational landscape, promote professionalism, strengthen the teaching community and enhance career opportunities.

Objectives of In-service Courses

- a) To sensitize the teachers towards the needs interests and problems of the students.
- b) To facilitate the acquisition of new knowledge in their subjects of specialization and to provide them with a broad understanding of current problems and trends about it.
- c) To promote awareness and provide assistance in acquiring new competencies for effective teaching.
- d) To strive for desirable attitudinal change among the teachers.
- e) To initiate the teachers' innovation and improvisation of curricula, methods and aids.
- f) To provide adequate educational technocracy.
- g) To prepare the teachers for their changing roles as facilitators of learning in view of changing needs of students and societal demands.
- h) To help teachers identify their problems and solve them through pooled resources and wisdom.
- i) To promote the habits of self-study, independent thinking and creativity approaches.
- j) To encourage them to undertake action research; experiment to solve teaching-learning and behavioral problems of the learners.
- k) To help teachers to know the community and signal the ways and means of contributing to the welfare of the community.
