(e) whether Government will assure that no coercive measures will be taken to impose Hindi on non-Hindi-speaking States and that they will have the right to choose languages in their educational institutions?	<p>MoE may like to reply.</p> <p>However, as far as KVS is concerned, Kendriya Vidyalayas cater to students from diverse linguistic backgrounds, primarily children of transferable central government employees. Therefore, the medium of instruction is Hindi and English.</p> <p>The Education Code of KVS has provision for teaching regional languages. Article 112 of the Education Code says:</p> <p>Article 112. REGIONAL LANGUAGES: Additional arrangement for teaching of the regional language/ mother tongue shall be made, provided 15 or more students are willing to opt for the same. For this, part-time contractual teacher shall be appointed after obtaining sanction from the Deputy Commissioner.</p> <p>Additionally, the BoG has directed all KVs to engage regional language teachers on a need basis to support students in the Foundational and Preparatory stages who struggle with Hindi or English.</p>



(d)	the steps taken by Government so far to overcome the shortage of female teachers in the country particularly in rural areas?	<p>MoE may like to reply.</p> <p>Vacancies keep on arising due to opening of new KVs, retirement, resignation, promotion of employees, employees going on lien to another department, transfer and up-gradation of schools. Filling up of vacancies is a continuous process and efforts are made to fill up the vacancies as per the provision of the relevant recruitment rules. However, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has provision of engaging teachers, who possess requisite qualification as stipulated in the recruitment rules of KVS on contractual basis for temporary duration against vacant sanctioned post to ensure that the teaching-learning process is not hampered.</p>


