	willing to opt for the same. For this, part-time contractual teacher shall be appointed after obtaining sanction from the Deputy Commissioner. Additionally, the BoG has directed all KVs to engage regional language teachers on a need basis to support students in the Foundational and Preparatory stages who struggle with Hindi or English.



Vacancies keep on arising due to opening of new KVs, retirement, resignation, promotion of employees, employees going on lien to another department, transfer and up-gradation of schools. Filling up of vacancies is a continuous process and efforts are made to fill up the vacancies as per the provision of the relevant recruitment rules. However, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has provision of engaging teachers, who possess requisite qualification as stipulated in the recruitment rules of KVS on contractual basis for temporary duration against vacant sanctioned post to ensure that the teaching-learning process is not hampered.
