A rotation system ensures equitable access, with student monitors fostering responsibility.



Over 357 students and 12 teachers participate weekly, showing marked improvements in participation, cooperation, and foundational competencies. 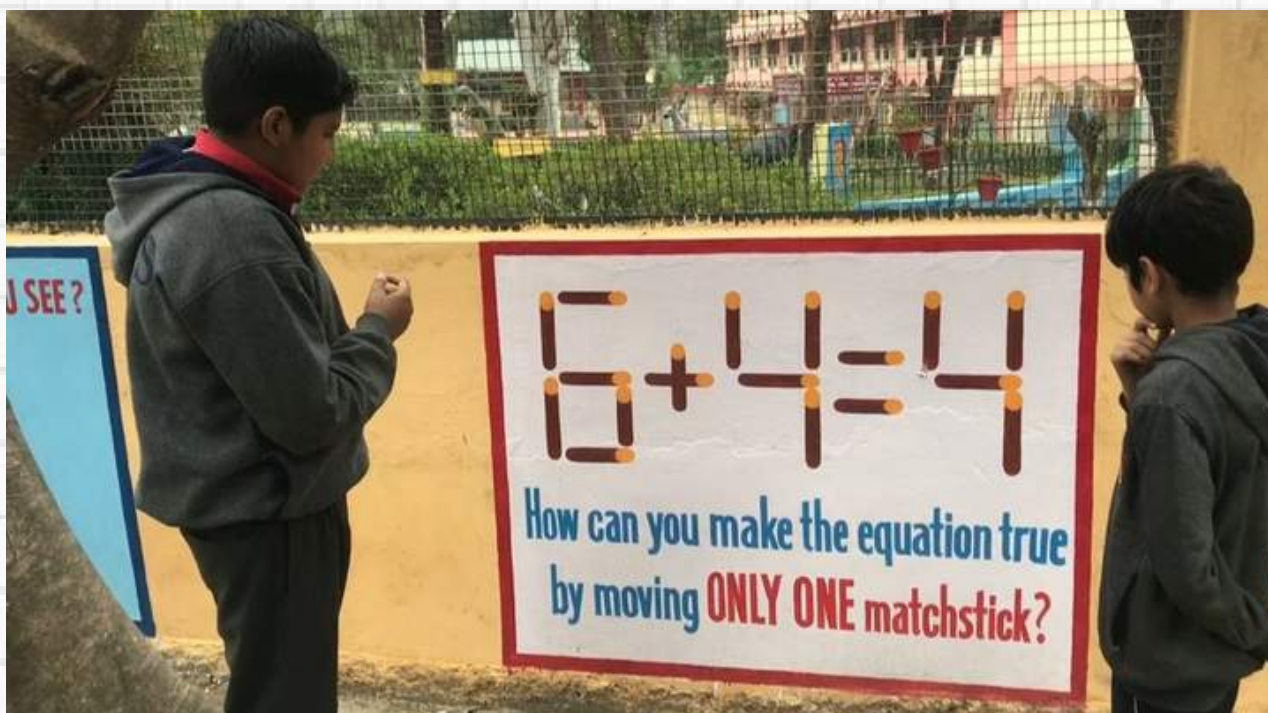
## REGION 16: JAMMU
