Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar – 2025 KV Student Wins National Honour

Some victories announce themselves loudly. Others arrive softly, carrying years of discipline, curiosity, and courage in their wake. This year, two students of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan reminded the nation what quiet excellence looks like.

Aishi Prisha Bohra of KV RRL, Jorhat, and Dhinidhi Desinghu of KV DRDO were conferred the **Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar 2025**, India's highest civilian honour for children, by Hon'ble President Smt. Droupadi Murmu. Two young girls. Two very different journeys. One shared moment of national pride.



From Scrap to Innovation: Aishi's Exceptional Talent

Aishi's story begins not in a laboratory, but with scrap paper. Old newspapers became pencils. Simple ideas turned into sustainable solutions. Her work in natural farming and low-cost, electricity-free innovations reflects a belief that progress does not always need complexity, only intention. She started early, experimenting, failing, and trying again. When she says she wants to create solutions "useful for common people and friendly to nature," it doesn't sound like ambition. It sounds like instinct.

Recalling the moment of receiving the award from the President, she said, "This is the most memorable moment of my life, which I can never forget."

She began her journey in Class 4 through an ISRO model-making competition and later received the INSPIRE MANAK State Award in 2022.

After receiving the award, Aishi shared that the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi appreciated her innovations and blessed her for a bright future, motivating her to pursue her work with renewed purpose.

Historic Leap of Dhinidhi: A Young KV Swimmer

Dhinidhi's world moves faster. Water, lanes, seconds shaved off records. At the age of 7, she was already the youngest swimmer in the country. By 2024, she stood on the Olympic stage as India's second youngest swimmer, breaking three national records and winning 42 medals across international competitions. Her journey is built on early mornings, relentless practice, and an unwavering belief that the next lap can always be better.

Her achievements strongly highlight the growing capabilities and immense potential of youth in the Indian sports arena. Continuous practice and unwavering dedication toward her goal earned her one achievement after another. The honor bestowed by the President is not only a matter of pride for her but also a source of inspiration to reach even greater heights.

Dhinidhi shared that the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi appreciated her talent and encouraged her to keep representing India with excellence, words that continue to inspire her journey ahead.

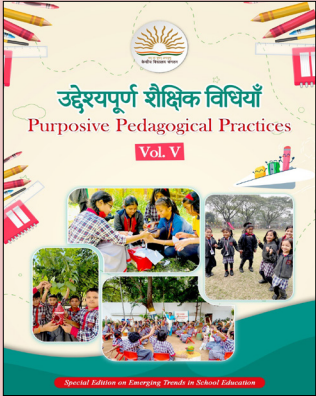

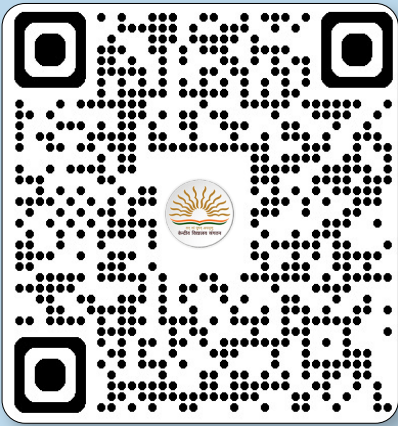

Tat Tvam Pushannapavrunu. From Prayer to Purpose. A quiet prayer, a call to the Sun, the Nourisher of the world, asking it to lift the golden lid that hides the truth. For generations of Kendriya Vidyalaya students, it has symbolised a way of learning that brings clarity, humility, and light.

The Small Beginning That Changed Everything

The story of KVS began in 1963. Just 20 schools. A few classrooms. A modest dream. A handful of children who arrived with heavy trunks, shifting homes from city to city. These children carried their entire world in a suitcase: new states, new languages, and new neighborhoods. But inside every KV, they found something familiar. A routine, a rhythm, a feeling of home where they could return to in every new city. A place where the morning assembly felt familiar, where the uniform brought comfort, where friendships formed before the books even opened. A place where belonging was stronger than geography. Teachers knew that children needed stability during constant transfers, and they gave them exactly that. A steady hand. A safe space. A place to grow.

A Place That Held Everyone Together

Today, 1289 KVs stretch across the country, each one a mini India, where a child from Kashmir shares a bench with one from Kanyakumari. Accents blending. Festivals crossing borders. From the beginning, KVS knew its deeper purpose: to instill Indianness, nurture national integration, and bring

together children from diverse cultures under one roof. Walk through any KV even today, and you will witness it. Accents mixing. Festivals blending. Students learning not only from books but from each other. Every KV stands as a living portrait of India.

Growth without Losing the Soul

The transformation has been steady and determined. The chalk dust of yesterday has given way to the glow of smart boards. Where teachers once drew diagrams with worn sticks of white, students now explore 3D models with a tap. AI labs hum with possibility. Coding clubs turn curious minds into creators. Digital libraries open windows to worlds beyond imagination.

NEP 2020 and a Fresh Way of Learning

We embraced NEP 2020 not as a policy but as a promise, reshaping education for minds that will inherit tomorrow. Learning became more experiential. Teachers became mentors. Subjects found life through experiments, stories, fieldwork, and real-world connections. It was education with heart and meaning.

Sports and arts were never side activities in KVS. But today, they stand shoulder to shoulder with academics. A child may shine in mathematics and still run like the wind on the field. Another may solve equations by day and dance in the school auditorium in the afternoon. Every spark is honoured. Every talent is nurtured. Because education is not marks alone. It is confidence. It is identity. It is the courage to stand tall in a world that keeps changing.

The Future Arrives in the Form of PM SHRI

And now, KVS is shaping the next chapter through the PM SHRI initiative. Schools are transforming into green, future-ready, sustainable campuses. Solar panels on roofs. Rainwater harvesting. Smart classrooms. Innovative labs. Learning environments where traditions and technologies live together. These schools will become national models of excellence, guiding the future of Indian schooling.

The Light That Never Dims

Six decades. Twenty schools to nearly thirteen hundred. A

handful of students to millions of lives transformed. But the numbers don't tell the full story. The story is about the Defence officer's daughter who never felt like an outsider. The Railway employee's son, who found his roots everywhere. The CRPF jawan's child, who calls every city home.

We are Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan. We are the keepers of that ancient promise: to remove the veil, to let truth shine through. And as we step into tomorrow, we carry with us the light that was lit in those first 20 schools, the same light that now guides over a million students toward their brightest futures.

Felicitated by the Hon’ble President

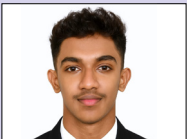

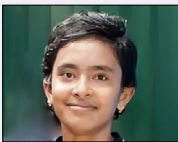
