

TRAINING OF APIO/CPIO

As part of the workshops on the Right to Information (RTI) Act, 2005 conducted for APIOs and CPIOs of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, a session on “Constitutional Provisions, Principles of Natural Justice, and Preventive Vigilance” was delivered by N. R. Murali, Additional Commissioner (Retired).

The RTI workshops were organized in two batches: the first from 24.06.2025 to 27.06.2025 with 34 participants, and the second from 15.07.2025 to 18.07.2025 with 35 participants.

The session was conducted with the objective of strengthening awareness and understanding of the legal and administrative principles underpinning the effective implementation of the Right to Information Act, 2005. Shri Murali elaborated on key constitutional provisions and emphasized the principles of natural justice, transparency, accountability, and fairness in administrative decision-making, which are essential for CPIOs and PIOs while handling RTI matters.

He also highlighted the role of preventive vigilance in promoting ethical administrative practices, minimizing procedural lapses, and ensuring transparency and accountability in public institutions. The session proved highly informative and significantly enriched the participants’ understanding of legal, procedural, and vigilance-related aspects relevant to the effective discharge of responsibilities under the RTI framework.
