

at **Kohima**, the State Capital, as the first District cum State Centre along with District Unit offices at **Mokokchung**, **Mon** & **Phek** districts







- ➤ Apart from Ensuring Stability of the Core Network, the team also performs other tasks such as Mitigating Network Failures, Remote Handholding Support & Monitoring, setting up LAN Connection Requests, addressing LAN Problems at Department User End and Configuring Firewalls & Routers
- Many important Webcasts & Video Conferences for facilitating virtual meetings were set up by this team at the height of the COVID19 pandemic lockdown, which ensured Business Continuity of various Government functionaries





- ➤NKN is now being looked as the harbinger of change in our knowledge society but this also brings together the responsibility to continuously look forward to providing the much-required impetus to R&D initiatives related to networking technology




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Some Important NICNET Nodes in Nagaland are:

➤ National Informatics Centre (NIC) through its Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Network — NICNET, has institutional linkages across all the Ministries /Departments of the Central Government, State Governments, Union Territories, and District administrations of the country. NICNET is a satellite-based nation-wide computer-communication network, that is a type of Wide Area Network (WAN)


Through NICNET, NIC has been instrumental in steering e-Governance applications in Government Ministries/ Departments at the Centre, States, Districts and Block level, facilitating improvement in Government services, wider transparency, promoting decentralized planning and management, resulting in better efficiency and accountability to the people of India


Poirect peering of NICNET with BSNL, PGCIL and Railtel are completed at Delhi and Hyderabad for saving Internet Bandwidth and faster access of each other's Network and Data Centre. Peering with Google, Microsoft and Akamai Content Delivery Network has facilitated faster access to Google services and other important International web sites. Re-structuring of Videoconferencing network has enabled to minimize delay and handle large scale important video conferencing such as PRAGATI of Hon'ble Prime Minister, GST Council Meetings by Hon'ble Finance Minister among others

Dedicated 2 Mbps Wi-Max connectivity is provided to 64 State Government Directorates, Central Government Offices and Government Educational Institutes a Kohima, which is used mainly for e-Office & e-Government Projects

➤ Wi-Fi services are provided in strategic locations such as **Secretariat**Conference Hall, Chief Minister's Conference Hall, Chief Secretary's

Conference Hall and Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Dimapur

➤ About **250** users are connected to Wi-Fi Services in the **Nagaland Civil Secretariat Complex**, Kohima

Messaging Services

- ➤ Electronic Mail (better known as E-Mail), is the most used Network Service across the country. National Informatics Centre (NIC) provides different kinds of E-mail services to its users, over NICNET, which is NIC's satellite-based communication network
- ➤ The different types of e-mail services being provided include SMTP, UUCP and X.400
- The NICNET e-mail service is distributed over many mail servers located at different NIC Centers. These are inter-linked with each other in a way that mails can be exchanged amongst all types of services
- ➤ E-mail can be used as part of the electronic file processing in Government of India
- ➤ All services under e-mail are offered free of cost to all officials under Ministries / Departments / Statutory Bodies / Autonomous bodies of both Central and State/ UT Governments





Messaging Services

➤ Each network connected to the Internet has a Domain Name associated with it, to ensure email and other traffic getting directed to the right recipient. In the case of NICNET, this domain is known as "nic.in". "Gov.in" domain accounts are also maintained by NIC for use by Government departments.

➤Under the Digital India initiative, NIC has established a robust Messaging framework that includes core eMail application Gateway services, Short Messaging Service (SMS), OBD (Outbound Dialing) and an IT Platform for citizen engagement (Sampark). These services collectively create a value chain over the existing NIC web portals that host Digital Services and are used extensively by Central & State Governments for citizen engagement & disseminating information

Facilitating creation of email account for officials of various departments, about **1045** official email IDs have been created from NIC Nagaland under "nic.in" & "gov.in" domains from 2015 till date

➤ With upgraded state-of-art technology in all locations, NIC provides one of the largest High Definition Video Conferencing Network in the country

➤ It is offering VC services since 1995, that are being used for monitoring various Government Projects, Schemes, Public Grievances, Monitoring of Law and Order, Hearings of RTI cases, Distance Education, Tele-Medicine, monitoring of Election processes, Launching of new schemes and more

➤ NIC-VC Services seamlessly integrate with laptops, desktops, tablets, smart phones, room systems and legacy equipment. NIC's VC services are regularly being used by Hon'ble President of India, Hon'ble Prime Minister, Chief Ministers of various states, Cabinet Secretary and Chief Secretaries, Chief Information Commissioner, Central and State Government Ministers and Department Officials across country at all levels

➤NIC has various studios for videoconferencing including NIC Studio and Departmental Studios in different states and each state has multiple studios available for videoconferencing. Each state has VC Coordinators who conducts the videoconferencing by managing the connecting sites, network connectivity in the MCU during VC session

➤ In Nagaland, all NIC District Units at the DC Office Complexes, NIC State Centre, Chief Secretary's Office, Nagaland Commissioner's Office & Guwahati High Court, Kohima Bench are provided with High Definition Video Conferencing facility

➤ EVCS VC System is provided at the Offices of the **Director General of Police**, **Police Headquarter**, **Raj Bhavan Secretariat**, **Industries & Commerce** and **Chief Election Officer** at **Kohima**

➤In 2020, 707 multisite conferences with 1471 site hours of Video Conferencing sessions have been used in Nagaland

Data Centre

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- ➤ With the increased expectations from citizens for online services and the number of e-Governance Projects being launched by the Government, the Data Centre requirements are growing exponentially
- ➤ Data Centre combines round-the-clock operations and management of systems with onsite skilled personnel
- ➤ Data Centres form the core of e-Governance Infrastructure in the State by providing services to various e-Governance initiatives undertaken by the State Government
- ➤ In Nagaland, a mini Data Centre was set up in the year 2005 at NIC Nagaland State Centre, Kohima located at the Civil Secretariat Complex
- ➤ The current set up consists of 5 racks with 22 Physical Servers & 7 Virtual Machines, 5TB + 1TB SAN and LTO-4 backup system

- The web hosting services are also extended on the other country level domains like .IN, AC.IN, ORG.IN etc. as well as on generic domain names like .COM, .ORG, .NET etc.
- ➤NIC is the exclusive Registrar for GOV.IN domain names. The use of GOV.IN Domain is restricted to the constituents of Indian Government at various levels, right from Central, State/ Union Territory, District and Sub-District to block, village etc.

Introduction to e-Governance

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Over the years, a large number of initiatives have been undertaken by various State Governments and Central Ministries to usher in an era of e-Government

Sustained efforts have been made at multiple levels to improve the delivery of public services and simplify the process of accessing them

e-Governance in India has steadily evolved from computerization of Government Departments to initiatives that encapsulate the finer points of Governance, such as citizen centricity, service orientation and transparency

Lessons from previous e-Governance initiatives have played an important role in shaping the progressive e-Governance strategy of the country



Role of NIC Nagaland toward e-Governance

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NIC has been training the Government Employees on a regular basis to enable them use computerized MIS and Databases, up to the district level

Since inception, NIC Nagaland has been instrumental in implementing various e-Governance Projects of the Central & State Government in the State of Nagaland, collaborating & working alongside stakeholder departments such as Agriculture, Census Operations, Comptroller & Auditor General of India, Health & Family Welfare, High Court, Home, Horticulture, Rural Development, School Education, Transport, Treasury, Urban Development, Veterinary & Animal Husbandry etc.
