



FUNCTIONING OF THE PRISON LEGAL AID CLINICS

SUMMARY

Prison Legal Aid Clinics were setup in all prisons across India in the year 2015. In 2016, NALSA prepared Standard Operating Procedures for Representation of Persons in Custody with the aim to bring uniformity in the functioning of the Prison Legal Aid Clinics. These were subsequently revised in the year 2022 as the 'NALSA Standard Operating Procedures on Access to Legal Aid Services to Prisoners and Functioning of the Prison Legal Aid Clinics, 2022'.

In July 2024, the Hon'ble Executive Chairman, NALSA approved a Framework for strengthening the functioning of the Prison Legal Aid Clinics. The framework sought to ensure regular monitoring and supervision of the Prison Legal Aid Clinics and ensure that timely and quality legal services are made available to all prisoners. The framework included formats for monthly inspections by the Secretary, DLSA and quarterly inspections by the Chairman, DLSA.

This report documents the data and information received from SLSAs on the functioning of the Prison Legal Aid Clinics for the inspections conducted in **October 2024** by the Chairman and Secretary, DLSAs. It pertains to inspections conducted of **893** prison legal aid clinics across **36 States/UTs**. As per data received, there are at present **3529 jail visiting lawyers, 1132 community para legal volunteers and 1035 convict para legal volunteers** assigned to prison legal aid clinics. Data further indicates that for October 2024, a total of **30,428** applications were forwarded to the DLSA, **1507** to HCLSC and **258** to SCLSC. These resulted in the appointment of lawyers in **27,872, 1091 and 142** cases by the DLSA, HCLSC and SCLSC respectively. The average assessment marks obtained during inspection of the clinics is **43.6** out of a total of **60 marks**.

I. INTRODUCTION

Prison Legal Aid Clinics (PLAC) are functioning in all prisons across India since 2015. The clinics are mandated to perform the following functions:

- a) to ensure at all times that no person is without legal representation at any stage of the criminal proceeding and generate awareness about the same;
- b) to bridge the information gap between the prisoner and the Court;
- c) to facilitate communication between the prisoner and the lawyer, whether legal aid or private;
- d) to ensure that no person is illegally or unnecessarily detained;
- e) to ensure special needs of vulnerable groups (women, young offenders, mentally-ill, foreign nationals, persons from other states, etc.); in prisons are addressed;
- f) to collaborate with local authorities, universities, academic institutions and civil society organisations to further strengthen legal aid services for prisoners;
- g) to act as a One Stop Centre (OSC) to raise the grievances by prisoners and direct the grievances to appropriate authorities through DLSA; and
- h) to undertake implementation of the NALSA and SLSA campaigns for prisoners or any other work assigned to fulfil its mandate of providing legal aid services and assistance to the prisoners.

PLACs are setup in all prisons pursuant to the amendments made in Regulation 3 of the NALSA (Legal Services Clinics) Regulations, 2011 to include a mandate to establish legal services clinics in jails by the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA). In 2016, NALSA prepared the Standard Operating Procedures for Representation of Persons in Custody with the aim to bring uniformity in the functioning of the legal services clinics in prisons. The SOP 2016 aimed at standardising the frequency of visits by the jail visiting lawyers to prisons and to provide guidelines on the functioning of the clinics. The SOP mandated the Member Secretary, SLSAs to review the working of the clinics on a regular basis and to ensure that persons in custody are effectively represented in the courts and to make them aware of their rights and availability of legal aid.

In 2020, NALSA prepared formats for the Para Legal Volunteers and Jail Visiting Lawyers deputed at the clinics as part of 'NALSA Handbook of Formats, 2020' for

standardizing documentation and reporting processes of the clinics. In 2022, NALSA revised its earlier SOP, and prepared the ‘NALSA Standard Operating Procedures on Access to Legal Aid Services to Prisoners and Functioning of the Prison Legal Aid Clinics, 2022’. (hereinafter referred to as NALSA SOP- 2022) The revision process was undertaken to further strengthen the functioning of the clinics, and the revised SOP aimed to address the day-to-day socio-legal challenges faced by prisoners and mandated monthly inspections by the Secretary, DLSA and quarterly inspections by the Chairman, DLSA to ensure the effective functioning of the clinics. The SOP provided guidance on the processes to be adhered with by the clinics under 13 thematic parts viz.

- Part A: Set up and Functions of a Prison Legal Aid Clinic
- Part B: Process of Application for legal aid and Role of PLAC in Facilitating Appointment of legal aid lawyer
- Part C: PLAC’s Role in providing Legal Aid Services and Legal Assistance to Vulnerable Groups in Prisons
- Part D: PLAC’s Role in Providing Legal Information to Prisoners and their families
- Part E: PLAC’s Role in providing Legal Awareness to Prisoners and Grievance Redressal
- Part F: Legal Assistance in Filing of Petitions/Jail Appeals in the High Court/Supreme Court by Convict Prisoners
- Part G: PLAC’s Role in the Under Trial Review Committees (UTRC) process
- Part H: Strengthening Communication of Prisoners with their Lawyers
- Part I: Role of the Trial Court
- Part J: Role of the Prison Superintendent

In July 2024, NALSA circulated a ‘Framework for Strengthening the Functioning of the Prison Legal Aid Clinics’. The Framework reiterated the provisions given in the SOP 2022, attached to this report as ***Annexure A***, and outlined a number of steps to strengthen the functioning of the PLACs:-

- a) The Ld. Member Secretary, NALSA shall interact with the Chairmen & Secretaries, DLSAs regarding inspection of the PLACs and the reporting thereon, as per Formats A & B;

- b) The Secretaries, DLSAs shall conduct monthly inspections of PLACs in each prison in their districts, and complete the inspections as per Format A. In their inspection form, they will outline the gaps identified in the functioning of the PLACs and the proposed action points to address the same, and discuss the same with the Chairman, DLSA;
- c) The Ld. Chairmen, DLSAs shall conduct inspection of the PLACs in each prison in their district on a quarterly basis, as per Format B. Thereafter Format A and Format B shall be submitted to the SLSA by last week of March, June, September and December;
- d) The Ld. Member Secretary, SLSA shall share consolidated information on functioning of PLACs in the State/ Union Territory, based on the inspection reports of Ld. DLSAs, as per Format C and share it with NALSA by the 2nd week of April, July, October and January;
- e) The Ld. Member Secretary, SLSA shall designate one Nodal Officer for monitoring PLACs' functioning and reviewing the PLAC Inspection Sheets, and regularly interacting with the Secretaries, DLSAs for addressing any challenges or concerns.

The framework refers to three formats, which are annexed to this report as ***Annexure B***, and include:

- i. 'Inspection Form: Prison Legal Aid Clinic' i.e. Format A, to be filled up by the Secretaries of the DLSAs at the time of the monthly inspection of the PLACs in the jails in their respective districts.
- ii. 'Inspection & Evaluation Report of the Prison Legal Aid Clinic' i.e. Format B, to be filled up by the Chairmen of the DLSAs after they conduct the quarterly inspections of the PLACs in the jails in their respective districts. [Annexure 3] The abovementioned inspection Reports were required to be sent by the DLSA to the SLSA by the last week of March, June, September and December.
- iii. 'Report on Functioning of the Prison Legal Aid Clinics' i.e. Format C for SLSAs to send a combined and comprehensive report of inspection of all PLACs functioning in the respective State/ UT to NALSA. The said reports are to be sent to NALSA by 2nd week of April, July, October and January.

Pursuant to the framework which was circulated to all SLSAs in July, the first inspections were undertaken in October 2024. This report provides an analysis of the

data and information received from the SLSAs on the functioning of the PLACs. NALSA received data from 36 SLSAs¹ and 690 DLSAs pertaining to inspections conducted of 893 PLACs in India. Some SLSAs viz. Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Puducherry only submitted data pertaining to monthly inspections, and no quarterly inspection reports were submitted. Two SLSAs viz. Daman & Diu and Lakshadweep reported that there are no prisons in the Union Territory.

II. FUNCTIONING OF THE PRISON LEGAL AID CLINICS – OCTOBER 2024

1. Number of PLACs Inspected & Inspection Reports received:

As per the NALSA SOP 2022 monthly and quarterly inspections by the Secretary, DLSA and Chairman, DLSA have to be conducted regularly, and reports are to be submitted to NALSA every quarter as per the prescribed format.

ANALYSIS:

- The monthly inspection reports were submitted by 665 DLSAs, whereas the quarterly inspection reports were submitted by 631 DLSAs.
- Inspections were conducted in 893 PLACs across the country. In several prisons more than one clinic is functional.²
- 15 SLSAs ensured that all clinics were inspected in their States/UTs.
- The least percentage of inspections were conducted in Bihar (37.3%) and West Bengal (47.3%).

2. No. of meetings convened by the Member Secretary, SLSA:

As per the framework issued by NALSA, the Member Secretary, SLSA is to interact with the Chairmen & Secretaries, DLSA regarding the inspection of the PLACs and the reporting thereon.

ANALYSIS:

- a) As per the reports received, a total of 37 meetings were conducted by the Member Secretary, SLSAs.
- b) No meetings were conducted in Gujarat, Kerala, Sikkim, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Puducherry and Lakshadweep.

3. Legal Aid Providers assigned to the PLACs & their Training:

As per the NALSA SOP 2022, PLAC functionaries comprise Jail Visiting Lawyers (JVL), Community Para Legal Volunteers and Convict Para Legal Volunteers. The number of JVLs and PLVs deputed to the clinic is to be directly proportional to the population of inmates. It also provides for the appointment of women and transgender JVLs and PLVs for women and transgender prisons/enclosures. The SOP 2022 further provides that orientation training for JVLs and PLVs must be conducted, preferably, within the first month of their appointment.

ANALYSIS:

- a) A total of 3529 Jail Visiting Lawyers are deputed to the PLACs. 28% (991) of JVLs are female, while no Transgender JVL is deputed to the PLAC.
- b) A total of 1132 community PLVs are deputed to the clinics. 31.7% of such PLVs are women, whereas no Transgender Community PLV is deputed to the PLAC.
- c) A total of 1035 convict PLVs are deputed to the clinics. 140 of such PLVs are women. One Transgender convict PLV has been deputed in Maharashtra.
- d) 72% of JVLs, 81.2% of Community PLVs and 83.4% of Convict PLVs have received induction training.

4. Legal Aid Applications forwarded by the PLACs

As per the NALSA SOP 2022, if any prisoner, at any stage of the court proceedings wishes to apply for legal aid, they may contact the JVL or PLV deputed to the clinic. As soon as the request is received the application is to be handed over to the Secretary, DLSA within 24 hours of the request so received. Further, once the lawyer is appointed, an intimation is to be immediately sent to the prison, and prison authorities are required to intimate the concerned prisoner as per prescribed formats given in NALSA Handbook of Formats 2020.

ANALYSIS:

- a) A total of 32,193 applications for legal aid were forwarded to LSIs from the PLAC in the month preceding the inspection.
- b) The highest number of applications were forwarded in Uttar Pradesh (8373) and Punjab (4048).
- c) 94% of all applications were forwarded to the DLSA. The number of applications forwarded to the High Court Legal Services Committee (HCLSC) and Supreme Court Legal Services Committee (SCLSC) is comparatively lower at 1507 and 258 applications respectively. Delhi forwarded the highest number of applications to HCLSC – 359, whereas, West Bengal forwarded the highest number of applications to SCLSC – 170.

- d) Lawyers were appointed in 90% of the applications received, however the percentage is only 55% for SCLSC applications and 72% for HCLSC applications.
- e) 3% of all applications sent were pending, with 392 applications pending with the HCLSC and 64 with the SCLSC.
- f) Intimation of appointment of lawyer was sent to the prison in 94.3% of cases.

5. Number of Prisoners provided legal aid

As per the NALSA SOP 2022, a primary mandate of the PLACs is to ensure that no prisoner is without legal representation at any stage of the criminal proceeding.

ANALYSIS:

- a) A total of 32,193 applications were received in the month preceding the inspection, whereas the estimated undertrial prisoner population in October 2024 was 3.7 lakh prisoners.
- b) Legal aid applications were received from 8.5% of prisoners, with the highest percentage from Uttarakhand (22.2%), Chandigarh (19.2%) and Delhi (16.9%). Since there is no estimate of the actual demand for legal representation among prisoners, the adequacy of legal aid provision remains uncertain. However, given the variation in the percentage of prisoners seeking legal assistance across states/UTs, PLACs should aim to extend legal aid to a greater proportion of undertrial prisoners, ensuring better access to justice.

6. Evaluation Marks obtained in the Quarterly Inspection of October 2024

6.1 Set up and Functioning of the PLAC – [Part A SOP]

This section's evaluation marks were based on whether the PLAC was established, the location of the clinic, the infrastructure within the clinic, display of information regarding the PLAC timing, location etc, days of functioning, assigning of JVLs including women and Transgender JVLs, visits by JVLs and PLVs, payment of honorarium, trainings, usage of formats for documentation and reporting etc. The maximum obtainable marks for this section are 25.

ANALYSIS:

- a) The average marks obtained for Part A of the NALSA SOP 2022 is 18 out of 25. The highest average marks were obtained by PLACs in Punjab (21.6), whereas Kerala obtained the lowest (12.2).
- b) On an average, PLACs in only 5 SLSAs obtained more than 20 marks – Arunachal Pradesh, Haryana, Jharkhand, Orissa and Punjab.
- c) On an average, PLACs in 3 SLSAs obtained less than 15 marks – Kerala (12.2), Tamil Nadu (13.0) and Telangana. (14.1)

6.2 Processing of Applications for legal aid and Role of PLAC in facilitating appointment of legal aid lawyer [Part B – NALSA SOP]

This section's evaluation marks were based on processing of applications by the clinic, whether the applications were processed within 24 hours of request, whether JVLs and PLVs were interacting with prisoners and regularly informing them of their right to avail legal aid, and right to complain and seek redressal against legal aid lawyer, whether intimation of appointment of lawyer was sent to the prison and whether PLVs were regularly updating the registers and computer systems on status of applications etc. The maximum obtainable marks for this section are 5.

- a) The average marks obtained under this part is 4.6 out of the maximum 5 points attainable.
- b) 5 SLSAs obtained full marks – Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Sikkim, Chandigarh, Dadra & Nagar Haveli.
- c) On an average, 3 SLSAs scored the least – Ladakh (3), Meghalaya (3.8) and Mizoram (3.9).

6.3 PLAC's Role in providing Legal Aid Services and Legal Assistance to Vulnerable Groups in Prisons [Part C – NALSA SOP]

This section's evaluation marks were based on the conduct of case-table interaction between PLAC functionaries and prisoners, explanation to prisoner regarding their offences, rights and duties etc, submission of legal aid applications within 24 hours from the case-table interaction, follow up by PLVs, intimation to family members where they are not yet informed, information on urgent medical needs of prisoner and

assistance to vulnerable prisoners. The maximum points obtainable is 10 under this part.

This section's evaluation marks were based on prisoners getting regular updates (including in writing) on their cases from the PLAC functionaries, installation and functionality of e-court kiosk, awareness among prisoners on NALSA's LSMS portal, helpline etc. The maximum obtainable marks for this section are 5.

6.5 PLAC's Role in Raising Legal Awareness among Prisoners and Grievance Redressal [Part E– NALSA SOP]

This section's evaluation marks were based on display of posters on legal rights of prisoners, set-up of a complaint box, conduct of legal awareness programmes, conduct of a Grievance Redressal Day etc. The maximum obtainable marks for this section are 5.

6.6 Legal Assistance in Filing of Petitions/Jail Appeal in the High Court/Supreme Court by Convict Prisoners [Part F– NALSA SOP]

This section's evaluation marks were based on the mandate of PLAC functionaries to inform the prisoners regarding their right to challenge orders of rejection of bail applications, judgments before the Sessions Court, High Court and Supreme Court, interaction of lawyers of the HCLSC and SCLSC with prisoners, availability of copy of

impugned order/judgment with the prisoners, record-keeping of applications sent to HCLSC/SCLSC in the register and computer system and receipt of intimations from the HCLSC and SCLSC. The maximum obtainable marks for this section are 5.

- b) PLACs in only 1 SLSA obtained full marks – Arunachal Pradesh.
- c) PLACs in 6 SLSAs scored less than 3.5 marks – Ladakh (0), Mizoram (1), Kerala (2.8), Tamil Nadu (3.1) and West Bengal (3.2).

6.7 Strengthening Communication of Prisoners with their Lawyers [Part H–NALSA SOP]

This section's evaluation marks were based on the availability of space for JVLs to interact with their clients in a confidential manner, display of rules for lawyers to seek visitation/interviews with their clients displayed outside prison, availability of video conferencing facility in prison for client-lawyer communication, display of information regarding the VC facility in prison, and use of VC facility by lawyers empanelled by HCLSC and SCLSC. The maximum obtainable marks for this section are 5.

- The average marks obtained under this part by the PLACs is 3.6.
- PLACs in none of the SLSAs obtained full marks, the highest marks were obtained in Uttarakhand (4.5) and Punjab (4.4)
- PLACs in 4 SLSAs scored less than 3.0 marks – Kerala (2), Manipur (2), Tamil Nadu (2.4) and Assam (2.9).

6.8 Total Evaluation/Assessment Marks obtained by PLACs

A maximum of 60 evaluation/assessment marks could be obtained across all the various parts, as mentioned above. The table containing average marks received by each SLSA is given below, whereas the table on prison-wise evaluation/assessment marks obtained is annexed to this report as *Annexure C*.

ANALYSIS:

- a) The average marks obtained under this part by the PLACs is 46.1.
- b) Highest average total marks were obtained by PLACs in Arunachal Pradesh (54.8), Punjab (53.7) and Haryana (52.5).
- c) Lowest average total marks were obtained by PLACs in Kerala (33.8), Tamil Nadu (35.8) and Meghalaya (38.0).
- d) Interestingly, 16 prisons obtained full marks i.e. 60 – these being
 - i. Special Sub-Jail, Peddapuram, East Godavari DLSA, Andhra Pradesh,
 - ii. Sub-Jail, Pratthipadu, East Godavari DLSA, Andhra Pradesh,

While these prisons have obtained full marks, it is not certain that the marks were obtained because all parameters were met, or there were discrepancies in the manner in which the PLACs were inspected.

- e) The lowest marks were received by District Prison and Correctional Home, Tura DLSA in Meghalaya (5), Sub Jail Salumber, Udaipur DLSA in Rajasthan (13) and Sub-Jail Walajpet, Vellore DLSA in Tamil Nadu (14). Some PLACs obtained 0 marks, however it is unclear whether no inspection was conducted, or there was no PLAC established as yet in these prisons.

III. KEY OBSERVATIONS & ACTION POINTS

Some key observations that have emerged from the data on functioning of the PLACs for the inspections conducted in October 2024 are as follows:

- 1. Establishment of PLACs:** As per the Prison Statistics India Report 2022 published by the National Crime Records Bureau, India there are 1330 prisons. However, it appears that PLACs are not established as per mandate in all prisons, or where established the inspections were not conducted.
- 2. Monthly & Quarterly Inspections:** Only 665 of the 705 DLSAs submitted monthly inspection reports, whereas 631 DLSAs of the 705 DLSAs submitted quarterly inspection reports. Only 15 SLSAs ensured that all PLACs in their

State/UT were inspected, with some SLSAs reporting inspections in not even 50% of the prisons.

- 3. Review meetings:** 6 SLSAs did not conduct any meetings with the DLSA Chairmen and Secretaries to discuss the inspection report and action points. The review meetings are essential to ensure periodic deliberations on the functioning of the clinics and redressal of gaps in functioning.
- 4. PLAC Functionaries:** A total of 3539 JVLs, 1132 community PLVs and 1035 convict PLVs are assigned to the 893 PLACs inspected, this is an average of 4 JVLs, 1 community PLV and 1 Convict PLV per clinic. This indicates non-adherence with the mandate as outlined in the NALSA SOP 2022.
- 5. Training of PLAC Functionaries:** Only 72% of JVLs, 81.2% of Community PLVs and 83.4% of Convict PLVs have received induction training, whereas the mandate outlines that every PLAC functionary must receive induction training regarding the PLAC within one month of their assignment.
- 6. Legal Aid Applications:** A total of 32,193 applications were forwarded to LSIs from the PLACs, with 94% of applications being forwarded to the DLSA. Comparative figures for applications to HCLSC and SCLSC is fairly low at 1507 and 258 applications respectively. Only 3% of all applications sent were reported to be pending.
- 7. Appointment of lawyers:** Lawyers were appointed in 90% of all applications received, however the percentage is only 55% for SCLSC applications and 72% for HCLSC applications. Intimation of appointment is reported to be sent in 94.3% of cases.
- 8. Proportion of prisoners seeking legal representation through the PLAC:** On an average nearly 8.5% prisoners sought legal representation in the quarter preceding the inspection. In the absence of demand data, it is not possible to accurately evaluate if the PLACs are able to meet the demand for legal representation.

9. Evaluation marks: As per the average marks received across all the 7 parts of the evaluation process, the lowest percentage obtained was under the head of ‘PLAC’s Role in Providing Legal Information to Prisoners and their families [Part D – NALSA SOP]’ – 65.39%, followed by ‘Set up and Functions of a Prison Legal Aid Clinic (PLAC) [Part A - SOP]’ – 71.87% and ‘Strengthening Communication of Prisoners with their Lawyers [Part H– NALSA SOP]’ – 72.2%.

ACTION POINTS FOR STRENGTHENING THE FUNCTIONING OF THE PRISON LEGAL AID CLINICS

In November 2024, the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India has issued the following directives to NALSA, in *Suhas Chakma v. Union of India & Ors (WP No. 1082/2020)*, to further strengthen the functioning of the Prison Legal Aid Clinics:

- ii. *“NALSA in cooperation with the SLSAs and the DLSAs will ensure that the SOP on Access to Legal Aid Services to prisoners and functioning of PLACs are operated efficiently in practice. NALSA will periodically update and improve the measures prescribed under the SOP-2022 so as to address any of the inadequacies that may emerge while operating the same at the field level.*
- iii. *The Legal Services Authorities at different levels will adopt methods to strengthen the monitoring of PLACs and to review their functioning periodically.*
- iv. *The Legal Services Authorities will periodically update the statistical data and after analysing the results take steps to address the shortcomings that may come to light.*
- ...
- xi. *Interaction by the Legal Service Authorities at different levels with convicts who had not preferred appeals should be periodically undertaken and the convicts be informed of their right to free legal aid.*
- xii. *Periodic interaction should be held with Jail Visiting Lawyers (JVLs) and Para Legal Volunteers (PLVs). This is to ensure updation of their knowledge so that the system functions efficiently as a whole.”*

An analysis of the information and data received from the monthly and quarterly inspections of the Prison Legal Aid Clinics indicates several gaps in the functioning of the clinics. In pursuance of the Supreme Court directives, and based on the inspection

reports received from the State Legal Services Authorities (SLSAs), the following measures are suggested to further enhance their functioning:

1. SLSAs to regularly conduct meetings with the DLSA Chairmen and Secretaries to discuss the inspection reports after the monthly and quarterly inspections. As per the mandate outlined in the framework, the SLSAs should ensure that one Nodals Officer is designated to review the PLAC inspection sheets. Interact with the Secretary, DLSAs. This will ensure effective monitoring of the functioning of the PLACs.
2. SLSAs to ensure that a PLAC is established in every prison, and that monthly and quarterly inspections are conducted on a regular basis as per prescribed timelines.
3. SLSAs to ensure that adequate numbers of PLAC functionaries are assigned to the clinics, as per the provisions in the NALSA SOP 2022. Induction trainings must be carried out within a month of appointment, and refresher training may also be organised for the PLAC functionaries on a regular basis.
4. SLSAs to ensure that the inspections are conducted in an effective manner. The inspection reports are indicative of the manner in which the inspections must take place, i.e. observation of clinic infrastructure, interaction with PLAC functionaries, interaction with prisoners and inspection of PLAC registers etc. Effective inspections will ensure that the clinic functions effectively and provides effective legal services to prisoners.
5. SLSAs to review the data pertaining to their states/UTs in reference to legal services being provided by the High Court Legal Services Committee and the Supreme Court Legal Services Committee. Evaluation marks obtained under the part on 'Legal Assistance in Filing of Petitions/Jail Appeal in the High Court/Supreme Court by Convict Prisoners [Part F– NALSA SOP]' is indicative of gaps in the provision of legal services in the High Courts. This may be reviewed by the SLSAs and the concerned HCLSC. A communication may be sent to the SCLSC to address any gaps in communication and provision of legal services.

ANNEXURES

Annexure A

Framework for Strengthening the Functioning of Prison Legal Aid Clinics

1. The PLACs have been setup in all prisons across India pursuant to NALSA (Legal Services Clinics) Regulations, 2011. In 2016, NALSA prepared Standard Operating Procedures for Representation of Persons in Custody with the aim to bring uniformity in the functioning of the PLACs. These were subsequently revised in the year 2022 as the ‘NALSA Standard Operating Procedures on Access to Legal Aid Services to Prisoners and Functioning of the Prison Legal Aid Clinics, 2022’ (NALSA SOP- 2022).
2. The NALSA SOP- 2022 enumerates the following functions of the PLACs:
 - b) to ensure at all times that no person is without legal representation at any stage of the criminal proceeding and generate awareness about the same;
 - c) to bridge the information gap between the prisoner and the Court;
 - d) to facilitate communication between the prisoner and the lawyer, whether legal aid or private;
 - e) to ensure that no person is illegally or unnecessarily detained;
 - f) to ensure special needs of vulnerable groups (women, young offenders, mentally-ill, foreign nationals, persons from other states, etc.); in prisons are addressed;
 - g) to collaborate with local authorities, universities, academic institutions and civil society organisations to further strengthen legal aid services for prisoners;
 - h) to act as a One Stop Centre (OSC) to raise the grievances by prisoners and direct the grievances to appropriate authorities through DLSA; and
 - i) to undertake implementation of the NALSA and SLSA campaigns for prisoners or any other work assigned to fulfil its mandate of providing legal aid services and assistance to the prisoners.
3. In order to review and strengthen the functioning of the PLACs, the following steps shall be taken:

- f) *The Ld. Member Secretary, SLSA shall interact with the Chairmen & Secretaries, DLSAs regarding inspection of the PLACs and the reporting thereon, as per **Formats A & B**;*
- g) *The Secretaries, DLSAs shall conduct monthly inspections of PLACs in each prison in their districts, and complete the inspections as per **Format A**. In their inspection form, they will outline the gaps identified in the functioning of the PLACs and the proposed action points to address the same, and discuss the same with the Chairman, DLSA;*
- h) *The Ld. Chairmen, DLSAs shall conduct inspection of the PLACs in each prison in their district on a quarterly basis, as per **Format B**. Thereafter Format A and Format B shall be submitted to the SLSA by last week of March, June, September and December;*
- i) *The Ld. Member Secretary, SLSA shall share consolidated information on functioning of PLACs in the State/ Union Territory, based on the inspection reports of Ld. DLSAs, as per **Format C** and share it with NALSA by the 2nd week of April, July, October and January;*
- j) *The Ld. Member Secretary, SLSA shall designate one Nodal Officer for monitoring PLACs' functioning and reviewing the PLAC Inspection Sheets, and regularly interacting with the Secretaries, DLSAs for addressing any challenges or concerns.*

4. In addition to the above, the Ld. Member Secretary, SLSA shall also ensure that:

- 1. *DLSA Secretaries visit and inspect the Prison Legal Aid Clinics at least once a month.*
- 2. *DLSA Secretaries shall ensure that legal aid lawyers are appointed to represent all undertrials. In circumstances where any prisoner is found without legal representation during the visit by the DLSA, immediate steps shall be taken towards ensuring appointment of a counsel.*
- 3. *DLSA Secretaries shall verify whether panel lawyers are meeting and interacting with prisoners including legal aid beneficiaries. In circumstances where panel lawyers are not interacting and communicating with the prisoners, the lawyer must be called to understand the concern and best respond to it.*

4. *DLSA Secretaries shall check the prison conditions with respect to health, sanitation, food and hygiene in addition to access to legal representation. If any such concerns are raised, the same shall be shared with the Chairman of the DLSA, Member Secretary of SLISA as well as the Board of Visitors who have the authority to raise it to the Appropriate Authority.*
5. *DLSA Secretaries shall track whether there are any instances of non-production at court hearings, be it physical or virtual. If such instances are reported, DLSA Secretaries to take immediate steps to rectify such occurrences.*
6. *DLSA Secretaries shall ensure that concerns of vulnerable category of prisoners are heard and responded to.*
7. *DLSA Secretaries shall check the documentation and reporting practices of the Clinic.*
8. *DLSA Secretaries shall ensure that the PLVs and JVLs are able to perform their duties effectively and have access to the prison during official hours. They should ensure that no unnecessary hindrances are created by the prison officers, which may hamper the working of the PLACs.*
9. *Quarterly visits to prisons are made by the Ld. Chairman, DLSA (District & Sessions Judge) to understand any concerns regarding prison conditions and to also look into the functioning of the PLACs.*
