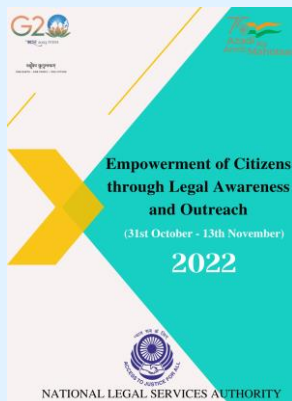

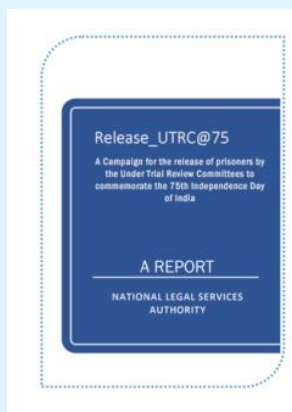

We have launched the campaign “Haq Hamara Bhi Toh Hai@75” aimed at providing basic legal assistance to under trial prisoners and children in conflict with law. Under this campaign, district teams formulated by District Legal Services Authorities will visit prisons and Child Care Institutions to interact with individual under-trial prisoner and children in conflict with law. Through these interaction, the teams not only ascertain, if the individual is represented by a lawyer, but also provide free legal counselling and assistance, including drafting and filing appropriate legal applications.

The district teams will also ascertain the needs of the individual's concerned and ensure that they in contact with their families and friends during the course of their custodial presence. Both the nationwide campaigns that we are launched today, are possible because of the tireless work of the State & District Legal Services Authorities of our Judicial Officers, Panel Lawyers, Law Students, Para Legal Volunteers, Social Workers, Anganwadi Workers and others, working towards the cause of legal aid.

INTRODUCTION TO THE CAMPAIGN

The 'Haq-humara_bhi-to-hai@75' campaign is a one of its kind country wide multistakeholder coordinated drive for providing basic legal assistance to persons confined in prisons and children in the child care institutions. The two-week campaign was launched on 31st October, 2022 by Hon'ble Dr. Justice D.Y. Chandrachud, Chief Justice of India (Designate) and Executive Chairperson of NALSA along with the campaign titled 'Empowerment of Citizens through Legal Awareness and Outreach' to commemorate the 75th year of independence. The campaign was concluded on 13th November, 2022.

Nelson Mandela's famously said, "It is said that one truly knows a nation until one has been inside its jails. A nation should not be judged by how it treats its highest citizens, but the lowest ones". Taking inspiration from Mandela's words, NALSA rose up to the task of ensuring that the persons confined behind bars and children in custody do not lag behind in availing the benefits of legal aid services and the advantages of legal awareness. Therefore, a dedicated campaign for prisoners and children in custody and care was designed by NALSA with the following broad objectives:

Objectives for the Campaign in Prisons:

1. Ascertaining legal representation to all.
2. Extending free legal services including drafting and filing of required applications.
3. Ensuring access to updated information on case status and facilitating communication with the lawyers.
4. Ensuring that requisite applications for bail or pre-mature release as per the eligibility are filed in appropriate cases.
5. Ensuring communication with family and friends for prisoners.
6. Ensuring medical assistance to all needy.
7. Redressal of grievances and meeting the needs of vulnerable prisoners.
8. Awareness on accessing the web portal for updated case status information.

Objectives of the Campaign in Observation Homes:

1. Ascertaining that the child is represented by a lawyer.
2. Ascertaining that the child is aware of the status of their case.
3. Ascertaining that the child is in contact with their guardians.
4. Sharing information with the child's guardian on the accessing the web portal to receive updated information on their cases.

Methodology for the campaign:

Creation of teams -

Three district level ad-hoc teams were formed in every district by the DLSA – one core team and two field teams for prisons and observation homes. Core team was headed by the Secretary DLSA and comprised of two senior lawyers and one subject-matter expert to assist the teams. The prison field teams comprised of jail visiting lawyers and paralegal volunteers and the observation homes field team also included a psychologist or social worker in addition to the lawyers and PLVs. The number of members in each team were decided on the basis of the population of the prisons and observation homes. At the district level, one data entry operator was also appointed for handling the data for the campaign.

Collection of data for preparation of the campaign -

Prisoner wise and children wise data on particulars involving the basic details, case information and case status was sought from the prisons and observation homes based on which individual prisoner/children information cards were made. These cards were later distributed to the concerned individuals for equipping them with the relevant information on their case status.

Orientation of the DLSAs and the district teams -

A pan India virtual orientation session on the campaign action plan for all the member secretaries of SLSAs, District and Sessions Judges, DLSA

Secretaries, data operators, prison superintendents, representative of prison headquarters, officer in-charge of observation homes and principal magistrates heading the juvenile justice boards was conducted on 1st November 2022. In addition to this, all relevant resources for equipping the teams with smooth conduction of the campaign was shared with the SLSAs to be further disseminated to all stakeholders.

Visits to prisons and observation homes -

Visits to the prisons and observation homes were conducted between 1st to 11th November, 2022 by the field teams in all districts. During the visits the lawyers and PLVs interacted with as many prisoners and children as possible on a one-to-one basis. During the one-to-one interviews the prisoners/children were given their information cards prepared in advance and they were made aware about the welfare provisions of legal aid and their grievances if any including the requirement of legal aid were noted. The information collected from the interactions were shared with the data operators to collate the data and later the core teams and field teams conducted meetings to address the grievances and requests received.

Monitoring of the campaign -

Monitoring formats were shared with all SLSAs in which the SLSAs compiled information received from all DLSAs and ensured a regular monitoring of the campaign activities and progress. The SLSAs thereafter prepared reports and shared with NALSA, which became the basis of the present report.

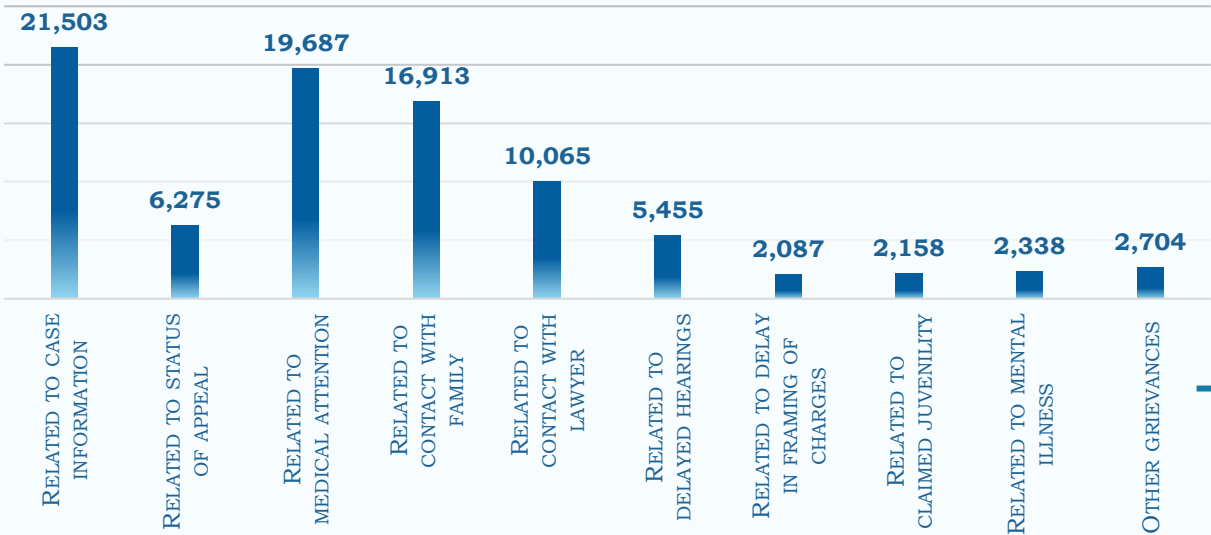

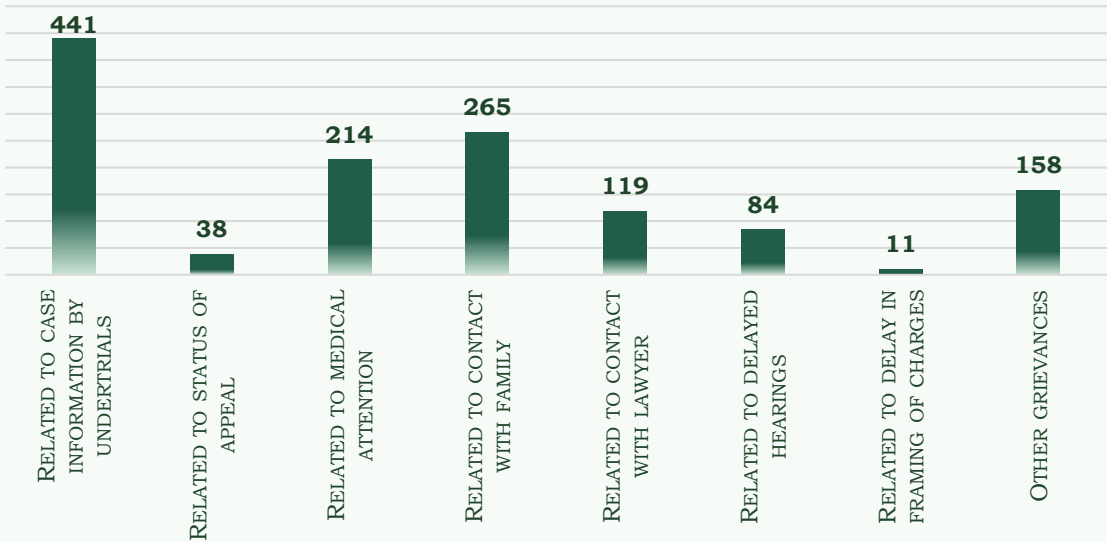

ANALYSIS OF COLLATED DATA

RECEIVED FROM SLSAs

I. ANALYSIS OF THE CAMPAIGN IN PRISONS

A. States/UTs covered: The campaign in prisons was carried out in 28 States and 5 Union Territories (UT) covering a total of 575 districts and reaching out to more than 4.5 lakh prisoners. Among the states, no information regarding the campaign was received from Nagaland after several reminders. Among the UTs, Andaman and Nicobar Islands did not send information and Ladakh and Lakshadweep did not have operational prisons during the period of the campaign.

B. Members in the field teams and prison visits: The campaign design required DLSA Secretaries to deploy lawyers and para legal volunteers on field for conducting prison visits and interacting with prisoners during the period. The numerical composition of the field teams was suggested to be decided in proportion to the respective prisons' population.

The field teams were tasked with conducting prison visits and interacting with prisoners for generating legal awareness and extending legal services in the appropriate cases where required. Overall, a total of 7,231 lawyers and PLVs (combined) were deployed in the field teams across the 33 States and UTs. A total of 5,472 visits were made to prisons during the period of the campaign in the 33 States and UTs by the members of the field teams. The following table provides state/UT wise information on average number of prisoners for each field team member:

On an average, there were 63 prisoners for each prison visitor or the field team member. The table above shows the States which had lesser number of prisoners per field team member (average) shown in green and the States with more prisoners per field team member (average) are shown in red. It must be noted that the number of prisoners per field team member is not a indication of the quality of campaign but only shows the variance in the work load on the field team members in different States.

C. Interaction with prisoners and distribution of individual information

cards: During the period of the campaign, overall, in 33 States and UTs a total of 4,22,355 prisoners were interacted with by the members of the filed teams which is 93% of the total 4.54 lakh prisoners held in these prisons in the said States and UTs. Further a total of 3,96,841 individual case information cards were distributed (87.35% of total prisoners) to the respective prisoners during the period of the campaign in the said 33 States and UTs. Following is a State wise table on the number of prisoners interacted with and number of case information cards distributed during the campaign:

D. Prisoners provided legal aid lawyers during the campaign: A total of 15,644 prisoners were either provided legal aid lawyers or the process for the same was initiated during the period of the campaign in the 33 States and Union Territories. It must be noted that the factor of new admissions could be the reason behind the large number of prisoners without legal representation which were identified during the campaign, however, it must be introspected as to why were the prisoners not allotted a legal aid lawyer at the time of production before the Magistrates itself before their admission into prison or at the time of the admission into prison.

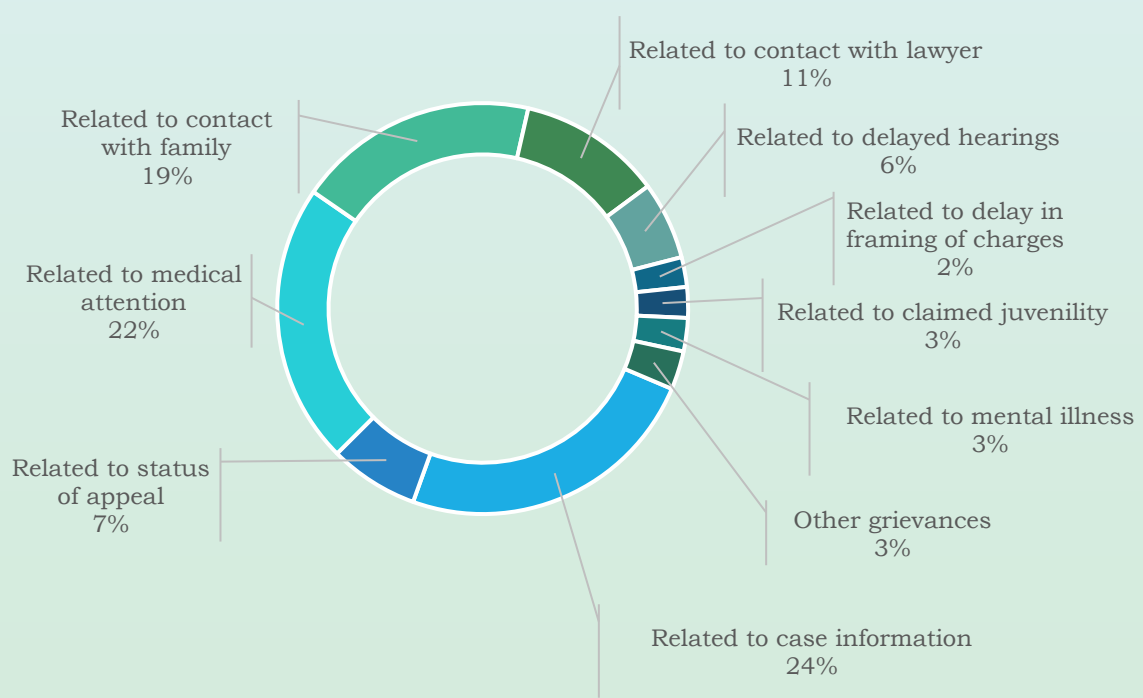
The table (on the following page) shows the percentage of prison inmates who requested for legal aid lawyers out of the total prison population during the period of the campaign. The States which have a high percentage of prisoners who requested for legal aid out of the total prison population are particularly concerning and must take reflective measures on identifying the factors responsible for it and addressing the same. Following is a State wise table on number of prisoners who requested for legal aid lawyers during the period of the campaign:

E. Analysis of categories of grievances received during the campaign: The members of the field teams during the visits to prisons collected information on grievances of prisoners if any. Overall, in the 33 States and UTs a total of 89,185 grievances were received during the period of the campaign. A category wise breakup of the same is given below:

The chart and the table show that the grievances related to case information form the largest share of grievances received followed by medical issues, contact with family and contact with lawyer in the order.



II. ANALYSIS OF THE CAMPAIGN IN OBSERVATION HOMES

A. Observation Homes covered: The campaign was carried out in the Observation Homes of 26 States out of total 29. Nagaland and Uttar Pradesh did not send information on the campaign activities despite several reminders and Puducherry did not have any observation home for children as stated. Among the Union Territories (UTs), the campaign was carried out in 3 UTs out of total 8. Andaman and Nicobar Islands did not send information and Dadar and Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu, Ladakh and Lakshadweep did not have any Observation Homes for children during the period of the campaign as stated. The following table provides a state wise number of Observation Homes covered in the campaign:

B. Members in the field teams and visits to Observation Homes: In the 29 States and UTs where the campaign in Observation Homes was conducted, a total of 937 members in the field teams were deployed involving lawyers and PLVs.

Overall, a total of 586 visits were made in the 280 Observation Homes in these States and UTs by the 937 members of the field teams for OH. The State wise total number of members in the field team and the visits made are given in the following table:

On an average, there were 7 children per field team member for the purpose of the campaign in Observation Homes. Since the ratio of children to field team member in the campaign in OHs is not high in any given State or UT, comparative analysis of the same is not required.

C. Interaction with children and distribution of case information cards:

During the period of the campaign in Observation Homes, a total of 6,124 children (95.77%) out of the total 6,394 children overall in all OHs in the States/UTs were interacted with by the field team members. During the period of the campaign, a total of 5,535 individual case information cards were distributed to the children in Observation Homes in these 29 States and UTs. The following table provides State/UT wise details of the total number of children interacted with and total number of case information cards distributed:

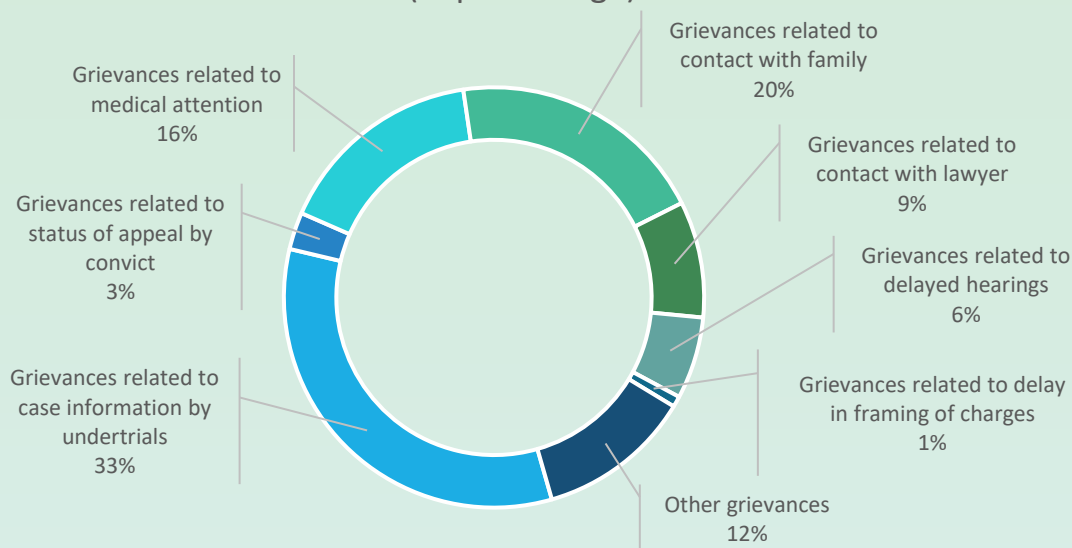

D. Analysis of categories of grievances received during the period of the campaign: During the period of the campaign, a total of 1330 grievances were received and addressed by the members of the field teams from the children of the Observation Homes. A category wise breakup of the grievances received is given below:

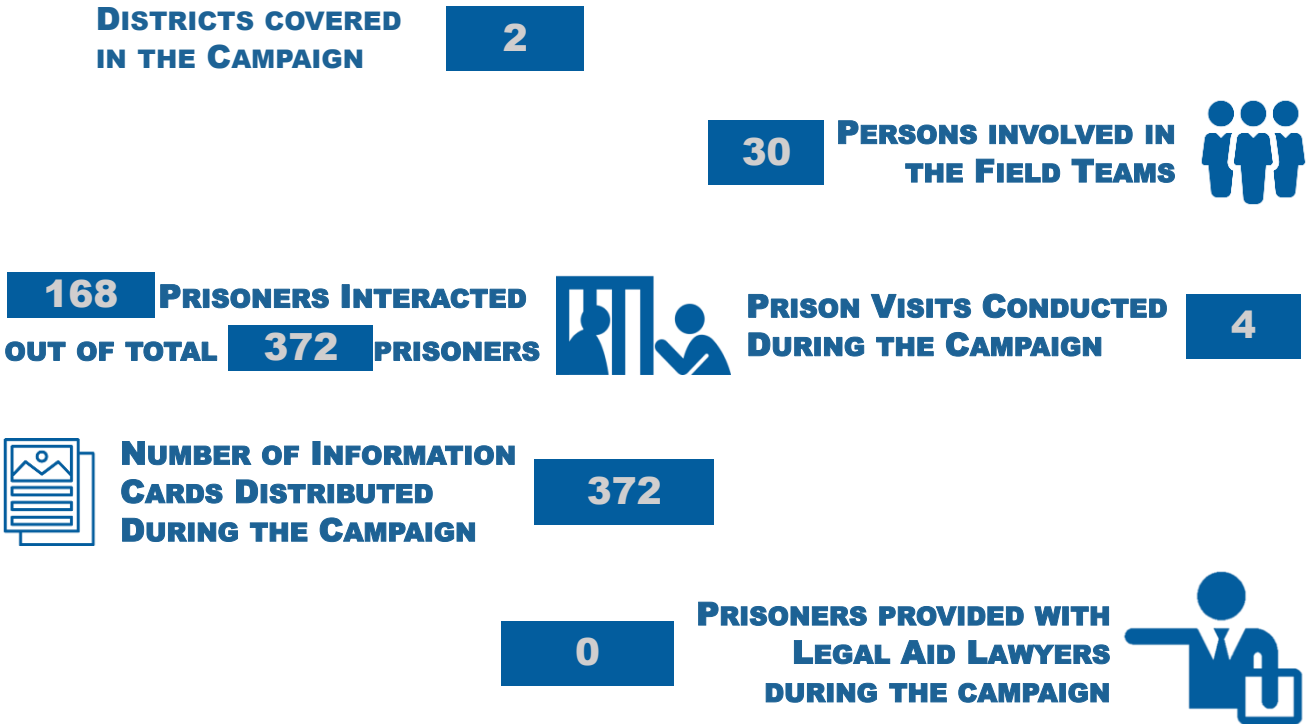

NALSA'S RECOMMENDATIONS

❖ General Follow Up Actions Recommended for SLSAs

- All State Legal Services Authorities (SLSAs) shall require the **DLSAs to send a report on the status of requests received for appointment of lawyers and grievances received** during the period of the campaign.

- **SLSAs are advised to send a letter to:**
 - State prison department,
 - District and Session Judges,
 - DLSA Secretaries,
 - Official visitors and non-official visitors of the prisons appointed as part of the Board of Visitors,
 - Juvenile Justice Boards,
 - Probation officers, and
 - Any other relevant authority of person of interest**highlighting the grievances received** from the prison inmates and children confined in observation homes **so that the concerned can focus on the pressing grievances as identified in the campaign.**

- **SLSAs may send a letter to NALSA highlighting their suggestions,** lessons learnt and any other information that the SLSAs may deem necessary to be put in the cognizance of Ld. Member Secretary NALSA.
