2. **QUALIFICATION**

- i) Possession of a valid driving licence for motor cars;
- ii) Knowledge of motor mechanism (the candidate should be able to remove minor-defects in vehicle);
- iii) Experience of driving a motor car for at least 3 years; and
- iv) Pass in 10th standard.

The applicant should fulfil the condition of qualification on the last date of receipt of applications i.e. 30.04.2022 (last date of receipt of application).

3. <u>DISQUALIFICATION</u>

No person :-

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with aperson having a spouse living or;
- (b) Who having a spouse living has entered into orcontracted a marriage with any person.

Shall be eligible for appointment to the service.

Provided that the Recruitment Committee, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage may exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

4. MODE OF SELECTION

In case, a large number of applications are received, the Recruitment Committee may consider to shortlist the candidates on the basis of their performance in objective type written test consisting of General Knowledge and awareness, Knowledge of traffic signs/rules and driving skills questions etc. Thereafter, the shortlisted candidates as per merit will be called for practical driving test to check the practical knowledge of driving skills/rules/signs. It is clarified that out of total candidates, who qualify the written examination, the number of candidates as decided by the Hon'ble Recruitment Committee may be called for practical driving test. Final selection shall be based on the marks obtained by the candidates in the practical driving test.

5. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

The decision of the Recruitment Committee in all matters relating to acceptance or rejection of an application, eligibility/suitability of the applicants, mode/criteria for selection, etc. shall be final and binding on the applicants. The Recruitment Committee may shortlist the candidates at any stage of the recruitment process on the basis of some criteria. No inquiry or correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.

The Demand Draft received after last date will not be considered.

6. DATE OF EXAMINATION

The Written test and Skill Test examination are likely to be conducted in the month of May to June 2022. The exact date will be notified on the website of NALSA. (www.nalsa.gov.in) and candidates are advised to regularly visit the website. However, the month of examination may be changed as per administrative exigencies. Written examination and Skill Test can be conducted anywhere in Delhi/NCR or as per the availability of the Institutes.

7. LAST DATE

The applicant who fulfils the prescribed educational qualification and other eligibility conditions may apply online upto 30.04.2022 (10:00 PM).

Applicants are advised in their own interest to apply online much before the closing date and not to wait till the last date for and completion to avoid the possibility of disconnection/inability/failure to log on the website on account of heavy load on internet/website jam. NALSA shall not be responsible, if any applicant fail to apply or complete the Registration process due to aforementioned reasons. The cutoff date to apply for the post is sacrosanct, any relief to the candidate to apply after cutoff date will not be granted under any circumstances.

8. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The application can be submitted through online mode only. No other means/mode of submitting applications will be accepted or entertained in paper form, which is sent to the NALSA..
- 2. A candidate whether he/she belongs to General or Reserve Category can submit only one application for a particular category. In case, more than one application is received, his/her all applications may be rejected.
- 3. The conditions of employment/service, reservation and all other conditions of recruitment not covered in the above notice shall be regulated as per the Government of India Rules, as amended from time to time.
