Dear Sin,

In terms of Article 280 of the Constitution, the President of India has constituted the Sixteenth Finance Commission, to make recommendation on distribution of the net proceeds of taxes between the Union and the States, principles governing grants-in-aid of the revenues of the States out of the Consolidated Fund of India and measures to augment the Consolidated Fund of States to supplement the resources of Local Bodies. The Commission is also mandated to review and recommend on the present arrangements on financing disaster management initiatives.

- 2. We would request you to share with us the views of the State Government regarding distribution of net proceeds of central taxes between Union and States and inter-se distribution between States; principles that should govern grants-in-aid of the revenues of the States; the measures to supplement the resources of the Panchayats and Municipalities in the State; and present arrangements on financing disaster management initiatives.
- 3. The Commission would be undertaking a detailed assessment of the finances of the States and would require data on State finances and related aspects in the format enclosed with this letter. These formats are available on the website of the Commission (<a href="https://fincomindia.nic.in/">https://fincomindia.nic.in/</a>). I would request you to furnish the information as per the format. We would also request you to share your projections for the awards period of the Commission, i.e. 2026-31 and the underlying assumptions for your projections.
- 4. In order to facilitate electronic submission of the filled-up statements and the Memorandum, a web-based portal is developed, for which, the respective State needs to create its login account on the abovementioned portal. The Commission has a very tight time schedule to complete its tasks and it is, therefore, requested that **filled up statements and the views of the State be uploaded on the above portal latest by 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2024**. Any additional data or views, should the need arise, may be submitted later in form of supplementary information or memoranda.
