### 3. Introduction

The National Trust is an autonomous body constituted by an Act of Parliament namely "The National Trust for the welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities Act, 1999".

The objectives of the National Trust are as follows:-

- i. To enable and empower persons with disability to live as independently and as fully as possible within and as close to the community to which they belong;
- ii. To strengthen facilities to provide support to persons with disability to live within their own families;
- iii. To extend support to registered organizations to provide need based services during period of crisis in the family of persons with disability;
- iv. To deal with problems of persons with disability who do not have family support;
- v. To promote measures for the care and protection of persons with disability in the event of death of their parent or guardian;
- vi. To evolve procedures for the appointment of guardians and trustees for persons with disability requiring such protection;
- vii. To facilitate the realization of equal opportunities, protection of rights and full participation of persons with disability; and
- viii. To do any other act this is incidental to the aforesaid objects.

The National Trust has been set up to discharge two basic duties- legal and welfare. Legal duties are discharged through Local Level Committees (LLC) and providing Legal Guardianship. Welfare duty is discharged through the Schemes. The activities of the National Trust inter-alia include training, awareness and capacity building programmes and shelter, care giving and empowerment. The National Trust is committed to facilitate equal opportunities, protection of rights and full participation of persons with disabilities (Divyangjan), covered under the Act.

### 4. Local Level Committee

The function of Local Level Committee is to screen, appoint, monitor and remove legal guardians. LLCs also promote activities such as Awareness generation, convergence and mainstreaming of persons with disabilities. Under Section 13 of the National Trust Act 1999, a Local Level Committee is required to be constituted in every district of the country for a period of three years or till it is reconstituted by the Board consisting of following members:-

- An officer of the Civil Service of the Union or of the State not below the rank of District Magistrate or a District Commissioner of a District;
- A representative of an organization registered with the National Trust; and



- A person with disability as defined in Clause (t) of Section 2 of the Persons with Disabilities Act, 1995(1 of 1996)

745 LLCs have been constituted with DC/DM as Chairperson of the LLC.

## 5. Appointment of Legal Guardians

- Section 14-17 of The National Trust Act, 1999 elaborates on Guardianship for persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities, to be given by the Local Level Committee. Guardianship is a need based enabling provision.
- A guardian is a person, who is appointed to look after another person or his property, or both. He or she assumes the care and protection of the person for whom he/she is appointed the guardian. The guardian takes all legal decisions on behalf of the person and the property of the ward.
- Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities are in a special situation as even after they have acquired 18 years of age, they may not always be capable of managing their own lives or taking legal decisions for their own betterment. Therefore, they may require someone to represent their interests in the legal areas throughout their lives. However, in cases of cerebral palsy and multiple disabilities, there may be a need for only limited guardianship because of the availability of enabling mechanisms and/ or scientific facilitations, which enable such persons to function with varying degrees of independence.
- Under section 14 of the National Trust Act, the Local Level Committee headed by the District Collector/ District Magistrate is empowered to receive application in Form A under Rule 16(1) & appoint guardians in Form B under Rule 16(2) for persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities. It also provides mechanism for monitoring and protecting their interests including their properties. All these forms are built in the online Legal Guardianship Module.

Before 2016, 30,304 Guardians were appointed in offline manner. Through the new Scheme Management System (SMS), 31,701 Guardians have been appointed till 31st March 2023, which include 7,401 Legal Guardians applications approved in 2022-23.

## 6. Registration of Organizations (ROs)

As per section 12(1) of the National Trust Act, any voluntary organization, the association of parents of persons with disabilities or the association of persons with disabilities, working in the field of Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation And Multiple Disabilities”, already registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860(21 of 1860), or section 25 of the Companies Act, 1956(1 of 1956), or Public Charitable Trust Act and under Persons With Disability Act, 1995 or Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 in the concerned state and on NGO Darpan Portal of NITI Aayog, can apply for registration in the National Trust.



Proposal for Registration can be submitted by filling up online form along with Form 'E' ( to be generated through the online system while filling up the online registration form), duly stamped and signed by the Head of the organization. The registration of such organization with the Trust shall be necessary for availing benefits under the schemes of the Trust. The validity of the registration of NGOs is 5 years. For renewal of registration, NGOs need to apply 6 months before the expiry of registration.

**The total number of Registered Organizations of the National Trust is 534. The number of NGOs registered from 01.04.2022 to 31-03-2023 is 139. The list of ROs can be seen State-wise and District-wise, on the website of the National Trust ([www.thenationaltrust.gov.in](http://www.thenationaltrust.gov.in)).**

## **7. State Nodal Agency Centre (SNAC)**

In order to carry out the activities of the National Trust, its effective implementation at the state level and for coordination/liaison with the concerned State Government Departments, a reputed Registered Organization of the National Trust is appointed as State Nodal Agency Centre (SNAC). The National Trust provides funds for conducting institutional activities namely meetings of Registered Organizations / Local Level Committee(LLCs), State Level Coordination Committees (SLCCs), documentation/ Reporting, honorarium for coordinator, misc. activities. At present, there are 28 SNACs in the country.

**During the year 2022-2023, an amount of Rs.0.34 Crore has been released to the SNACs. A comprehensive list of all State Nodal Agency Centres (SNACs) is available on the website of the National Trust.**

## **8. State Level Coordination Committee (SLCC)**

Every State Government/UT Administration has been requested to set up a State Level Coordination Committee (SLCC) for effective implementation and monitoring of the schemes of the National Trust. The Principal Secretary of the State Government looking after disability affairs is the Chairperson and the respective SNAC is the convener of the Committee. The Composition of SLCC is as under:-

## 9. The Schemes highlights and the projects sanctioned under the schemes during the year 2022-23 are as under:

### 9.1. Disha (Early Intervention and School Readiness Scheme for 0-10 years)

This is an early intervention and school readiness scheme for children in the age group of 0-10 years with the four disabilities covered under the National Trust Act and aims at setting up Disha Centres for early intervention for Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) through therapies, trainings and providing support to family members. The project holders should provide day-care facilities to PwDs (Divyangjan) for at least 4 hours in a day (between 8 am and 6 pm) along with age specific activities. There should be a Special Educator or Early Intervention Therapist, Physiotherapist or Occupational Therapist and Counsellor for PwDs (Divyangjan) along with Caregiver and Ayas in the centre.

The scheme was launched in the year 2015-16. During the last 8 years, an amount of Rs.15.36 Crore has been spent under the scheme benefitting around 660 beneficiaries every year. This includes release of Rs.1.84 crore for 327 Divyangjan getting benefit through 33 Disha Centres in Financial Year 2022-23.

### 9.2. VIKAAS (Day Care Scheme for 10+ years)

years and above, primarily to expand the range of opportunities available to a person with disability for enhancing interpersonal and vocational skills as they are on a transition to higher age groups. The centre offers care giving support to Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) during the time the Divyangjan are in the Vikaas centre. In addition, it also helps in supporting family members to get some time during the day to fulfil other responsibilities. Project Holders should provide day-care facilities to Divyangjan for at least 6 hours in a day (between 8 am and 6 pm) along with age specific activities. Day care should be opened for at least 21 days in a month.

The scheme was launched in the year 2015-16. During the last 8 years, an amount of Rs.26.92 Crore has been spent under the scheme benefitting around 1,020 beneficiaries every year. This includes release of Rs.3.65 Crore for 724 Divyangjan getting benefit through 34 Vikaas Centres in Financial Year 2022-23.

### 9.3. Disha-cum Vikaas Scheme (Day Care)

For the Registered Organizations, who were implementing multiple schemes, an option for implementing merged scheme was given. Based on the consent given by the ROs and the scheme guidelines, 41 ROs were allotted the merged Disha-cum-Vikaas Scheme (Day Care) w.e.f. 01.04.2018.

**During the last 5 years an amount of Rs.25.94 Crore has been spent under the scheme benefitting around 1,350 beneficiaries every year. This includes release of Rs.5.85 Crore for 1,059 Divyangjan getting benefit through 45 Disha-cum-Vikaas Centres in Financial Year 2022-23.**

#### 9.4. Samarth (Respite Care Residential Scheme)

The objective of Samarth scheme is to provide respite care home for orphans or abandoned, families in crisis and also for Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) from BPL & LIG families including destitute with at least one of the four disabilities covered under the National Trust Act. The scheme provides for creating opportunities for family members to get respite time in order to fulfil other responsibilities. Under the Scheme Samarth Centres are set up for providing group home facility for all age groups with adequate and quality care service with acceptable living standards including provision of basic medical care from professional doctors.

**The scheme was launched in the year 2015-16. During the last 8 years, an amount of Rs.12.54 Crore has been spent under the scheme benefitting around 390 beneficiaries every year. This includes release of Rs.1.81 Crore for 221 Divyangjan getting benefit through 13 Samarth Centres in Financial Year 2022-23.**

#### 9.5. Gharaunda (Group Home for Adults)

The objective of Gharaunda scheme, which was launched in 2015-16, is to provide an assured home and minimum quality of care services throughout the life of the persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities. The scheme also facilitates the establishment of

requisite infrastructure for the assured care system throughout the country, encourage assisted living with independence and dignity and provide care services on a sustainable basis.

**The scheme was launched in the year 2015-16. During the last 8 years, an amount of Rs.22.05 Crore has been spent under the scheme benefitting around 480 beneficiaries every year. This includes release of Rs.3.87 Crore for 347 Divyangjan getting benefit through 24 Gharaunda Centres in Financial Year 2022-23.**

#### 9.6. Samarth-cum-Gharaunda Scheme (Residential)

For the Registered Organisations, who were implementing multiple schemes, an option for implementing merged scheme was given. Based on the consent given by the ROs and the scheme guidelines, 12 ROs were allotted the merged Samarth-cum-Gharaunda Scheme (Residential) w.e.f. 1.4.2018.

**During the last 5 years an amount of Rs.10.83 Crore has been spent under the scheme benefitting around 390 beneficiaries every year. This includes release of Rs.3.47 Crore for 338 Divyangjan getting benefit through 13 Samarth-cum-Gharaunda Centres in Financial Year 2022-23.**

#### 9.7. ‘Niramaya’ Health Insurance Scheme

The National Trust is implementing Niramaya Health Insurance Scheme for persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation (Intellectual Disabilities) and Multiple Disabilities. Under the Scheme, there is an insurance cover of Rs.1 lakh, which covers OPD, Diagnostic Test, Therapies, Corrective Surgeries, Alternative Medicine and Transportation. There is no age bar for enrolment under the scheme and the treatment can be taken from any authorized medical practitioner/health care center. It is on reimbursement basis. The scheme is operational in the entire country through more than 534 Registered Organisations who facilitate Divyangjan in filling the online application. Apart from Registered Organisations of National Trust for the next policy year 2023-24, National Institutes under DEPwD and Composite Regional Centers (CRCs) under National Institutes have also been allowed to enrol beneficiaries under the scheme expanding the reach.

Any person with aforesaid condition can avail benefit by paying a nominal fee. From 2021-22, renewal under the scheme can be done by parents/guardians themselves through the portal made



available by the National Trust. The enrollment/renewal fee is not charged for Divyangjan who have Legal Guardian other than natural parents.

Under Niramaya- Health Insurance Scheme, overall insurance cover is Rs.1.0 Lakh per annum, which is divided into sub limits under Hospitalization, OPD, Diagnostic Tests, Therapies, Alternative Medicine, Transport, etc. The disabilities covered under the National Trust Act are conditions that require long-term care. Therefore, the Expert Committee on Niramaya Scheme analyzed the matter and recommended for internal revision in the benefit chart, wherein, in some areas, amount has been increased while the amount has been curtailed in other areas. Based on the recommendations of the expert committee for internal revision in the overall insurance cover of Rs.1.0 lakh, the Board of the National Trust approved the recommendation of expert committee for implementation from 2022-23.




### (ii) Meeting on Local Level Committee (LLC)

A Meeting on constitution of LLC, disposal of legal guardianship applications with the help of LLC NGO Member and Person with disability (Divyangjan) and co-opted members, was organized for the States of Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand. The meeting was organized on 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 in virtual mode. During the meeting district officials, State Nodal Agency Centres of respective States and Registered organisations were present. The district

officials were guided on how to recommend one NGO and one Divyangjan member of the LLC, processing of the online legal guardianship applications and who can be appointed legal guardian of a person covered under the National Trust Act, 1999. Programme Director, National Trust answered all the queries raised by the participants during the meeting.

**(iii) Virtual review meeting of State Nodal Agency Centres (SNACs)**

The National Trust conducted a virtual review meeting of State Nodal Agency Centres (SNACs) on 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2022. The meeting was attended by Sh. U.K Shukla, Programme Director National Trust, Sh. Navnit Kumar, Deputy Director National Trust and All SNACs of 28 States/UTs. The purpose of the meeting was to highlight the importance of activities of SNACs and urged them to ensure effective implementation of schemes and activities of National Trust in states and promote NGOs for registration with National Trust in uncovered districts, so that the activities of National Trust can be reached to those districts.

**(iv) Meeting with implementing agencies of Niramaya Health Insurance Scheme-**

A Virtual Meeting with officials of Raksha TPA (Third Party Administrator) and Oriental Insurance Co. Ltd. implementing Niramaya- Health Insurance Scheme was organized on 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2022. During the meeting, several issues related to the claims settlement under the scheme were taken up. Alongwith this, National Trust officials interacted with head of the regional centres of Raksha TPA and discussed the issues raised related to claims settlement including submission of claim forms and scrutiny of documents etc. in their regional centres. The Programme Director instructed Raksha TPA and all its regional centre representatives about the severity of our disability and requested them to listen the parents/guardian properly and try to collect desired information from their senior and reply the claimant in time bound manner. The suggestions for further improvement in easy settlement of claims were also taken up.



- (v) As part of observing Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence, the National Trust identified 5 key areas of the theme "Inclusive Development" namely- Early Intervention, Unique Disability ID (UDID) Card/ Disability certificate, Skill Development/ Vocational Training, Employment/ Self- Employment and Govt. schemes/ activities. Accordingly, following meetings have been organized:-

**Early Intervention** - The National Trust organized a virtual meeting on Early Intervention under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence on 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2022. Mrs. Poonam Natrajan, former Chairperson, National Trust, Dr. V. Sravan Reddy, Assistant Professor in Psychiatry, National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Intellectual Disabilities (NIEPID), Secunderabad, Dr. B.S. Santosh Kanna, Lecturer, Physiotherapy, National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (NIEPMD), Chennai, Dr. C. Tulsi Das, Deva International Society for Child Care, Varanasi were Resource Persons in the meeting. Project Holders of Disha scheme and number of NGOs, Professionals and Parents attended the virtual meet.

**UDID Card/ Disability Certificate** - The National Trust organized a virtual meeting on UDID Card/ Disability Certificate under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence on 5<sup>th</sup> November, 2022. Dr. Ashish Kumar, Board Member, National Trust, Sh. Pankaj Maru, Sneh Nagda, Madhya Pradesh were Resource Persons in the meeting. The Officials of State Govt. of Assam, Registered Organizations (ROs) of National Trust and Parents attended the virtual meet. Procedure and issues related to issuance of UDID Card/ Disability Certificate were discussed during the meeting.

**Skill Development/ Vocational Training** - The National Trust organized a virtual meeting on Skill Development/ Vocational Training under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence on 23rd December, 2022. Mrs. Pooja Vaghasiya, Board Member, National Trust, Mr. Zaheer Abbas Jan, Rehabilitation Therapist/ Professional Social Worker, Srinagar, Kashmir, Mr. K.D. Mallikarjuna, President of Indian academy of Cerebral Palsy (IACP), India, Dr. Alok Bhuwan, State Nodal Agency Centre (SNAC) of National Trust in Delhi were Resource Persons in the meeting. The meeting was attended by Board Members of National Trust, Registered Organizations (ROs) and Parents. During the meeting, importance of Skill Development/ Vocational Training for Divyangjan for their livelihood was discussed.

**Employment/ Self Employment** - The National Trust organized a virtual meeting on Employment/ Self Employment under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence on 5th January, 2023. Sh. G.S. Bedi, Board Member, National Trust, Dr. Manish Samnani, Director, SOCH Organization, Gurgaon, Dr. Gita Jyoti Ojha, Occupational Therapist, IHBAS, Dilshad Garden, Delhi and Dr. Simi Srivastava, State Nodal Agency Centre (SNAC) of National Trust in Chhattisgarh were Resource Persons in the meeting. The meeting was attended by Board Members of National Trust, Registered Organizations (ROs) and Parents. During the meeting, various opportunities in Employment/ Self Employment for Persons with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (PwIDDS) were discussed.

On 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2023 in a virtual meeting on Employment/ Self Employment, Shri Mallikarjun, President, Indian Academy of Cerebral Palsy, Dr. Tulsi, Deva International, Varanasi, Ms. Seema Chadha, Muskaan, Delhi were the Resource Persons. During the meeting, Muskaan, Delhi, a

Registered Organization of National Trust presented 3 models for creating Employment/ Self Employment of PwIDDS. Apart from this, various opportunities in Employment/ Self Employment for PwIDDS were shared by other Resource Persons. The meeting was attended by Board Members of National Trust, Registered Organizations (ROs) and Parents.

**(vi) 3 Days Mentors Training Program on Self Advocacy**

The National Trust organized a 3 days Mentors Training Program on Self Advocacy on 31st January 2023, 1st and 2nd February 2023 at Dr. Ambedkar International Centre, New Delhi. Sh. Purushottam Sitaram Burde, President of PARIVAAR (National Confederation of Parents Organizations for Persons with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities), Sahyadri, Mumbai, Smt. Poonam Lal Chaudhary, Special Educator, Chandigarh, Smt. Charu Shah, Trainer in PARIVAAR on Self-Advocacy Project, Mumbai, Sh. Abhay Kumar Dubey, Vice President (Central Zone) PARIVAAR and Former, Board Member of the National Trust, Jabalpur and Mrs. Pooja S. Vaghasiya, Board Member of the National Trust were Resource Persons of the 3 days training program.

A total number of 27 trainees comprising 16 Mentors and 11 Self Advocates were trained in the 3 days training program. The Valedictory session of the 3 days training program was conducted under Chairmanship of Secretary, DEPwD and Chairperson, National Trust on 2nd February 2023.

The trained participants were given a 'Certificate of Participation' by the Secretary, DEPwD & Chairperson, National Trust. The program ended on 2nd February, 2023.

Rishi Bhuttan working in Multi National Company, and Ms. Tanya trained as Special Educator and working for Persons with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities, shared their experiences during the exhibition.

**1. ACCOUNTING CONVENTION:**

The financial statements are prepared on the basis of historical cost convention, unless otherwise stated and on the accrual method of accounting.

**2. INVENTORY VALUATION**

2.1 Stores and Spares, if any, are valued at cost.

2.2 Raw materials, semi-finished goods and finished goods are valued at lower of cost and net realizable value. The costs are based on weighted average cost. Cost of finished goods and semi-finished goods is determined by considering material, labour and related overheads.

**3. INVESTMENTS**

3.1 Investments classified as “long term investments” are carried at cost. Provision for decline, other than temporary, is made in carrying cost of such investments, if any.

3.2 Investments classified as “Current” are carried at lower of cost and fair value. Provision for shortfall on the value of such investments is made for each investment considered individually and not on a global basis, if any.

3.3 Cost includes acquisition expenses like brokerage, transfer stamps.

**4. EXCISE DUTY**

Liability for excise duty in respect of goods produced by the entity, other than for exports, is accounted upon completion of manufacture and provision is made for excisable manufactured goods as at the year end, if any.

**5. FIXED ASSETS**

5.1 Fixed Assets are stated at cost of acquisition inclusive of inward freight, duties and taxes and incidental and direct expenses related to acquisition. In respect of projects involving construction, if any, the related pre-operational expenses (including interest on loans for specific project prior to its completion), form part of the value of the assets capitalized.

5.2 Fixed Assets received by way of non-monetary grants (other than towards the Corpus Fund), are capitalized at values stated, by corresponding credit to Capital Fund/ Reserve.



## **6. DEPRECIATION:**

Depreciation on the assets has been provided at the rates prescribed by the Income Tax Act, at the close of financial earlier. During the year, a sum of Rs.6,59,546/- (Schedule-8) has been written off to Income & Expenditure on this account.

## **7. MISCELLANEOUS EXPENDITURE:**

Deferred revenue expenditure, if any, is written off over a period of 5 years from the year it is incurred.

## **8. ACCOUNTING FOR NIRAMAYA-HEALTH INSURANCE SCHEME :**

Accounting for expenditure incurred on “Niramaya” and revenue recovered on account of fee etc. is recorded in common ledger account namely “Health Insurance Scheme” under the head Programme and Projects. However, the total expenditure incurred on the scheme is shown under Programme & Projects vide Schedule-22 and the fee recovered during the year is shown as income under “Income from Fees/Subscriptions” vide Schedule-14.

## **9. GOVERNMENT GRANTS/SUBSIDIES :**

- 9.1 Government grants of the nature of contribution towards capital cost of setting up projects, if any, are treated as Capital Reserve and Grants in respect of specific fixed assets acquired are shown as a deduction from the cost of the related assets.
- 9.2 Other Government grants are accounted for as Income under the head Grants/Subsidies/Sponsorships as per Schedule-13.

## **10. FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSACTIONS :**

- 10.1 Transactions denominated in foreign currency are accounted at the exchange rate prevailing at the date of transaction.
- 10.2 Current assets, foreign currency loans and current liabilities are converted at the exchange rate prevailing as at the year end and the resultant gain/loss is adjusted to cost of fixed assets, if the foreign currency liability relates to fixed assets, and in other cases is considered to revenue.

## **11. LEASE :**

Lease rentals are expensed with reference to lease terms.

## **12. RETIREMENT BENEFITS :**

- 12.1 Additional provision on account of Gratuity payable to employees on their retirement/cessation of service has been provided for in accounts for the year ending on 31.3.2023. In addition, the provision for Leave Encashment is also made in accounts for the year ending on 31.3.2023.
- 12.2 Consequent upon introduction of new Contributory Pension Scheme, the provision for pensionary benefits is being made regularly and is being deposited with P.F.R.D.A. accordingly.

## Separate Audit Report of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India on the Accounts of National Trust for the Welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities (National Trust), New Delhi for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023.

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of National Trust for the Welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities, New Delhi (henceforth National Trust) as at 31st March 2023, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account for the year ended on that date under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller and Auditor General's (Duties, Powers & Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with Section 24(2) of the National Trust Act, 1999. These financial statements are the responsibility of the National Trust's Management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practice, accounting standards and disclosure norms, etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the Law, Rules & Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects, etc., if any, are reported through Inspection Report/CAG's Audit Reports separately.

3. We have conducted the audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining on a test basis, evidences supporting the amounts and disclosure in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

4. Based on our audit, we report:

- i. We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit.
- ii. The Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the common format of accounts approved by the Government of India, Ministry of Finance.
- iii. In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by the National Trust as required under Section 24(1) of the National Trust Act, 1999 in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.
- iv. We further report that:

### A BALANCE SHEET

#### A.1 Liabilities

##### A.1.1 Current Liabilities and Provisions (Schedule 7 - Rs. 183.61 lakh)

National Trust paid Rs. 111.67 lakh against due amount of Rs. 131.67 lakh, to Oriental Insurance Co. Ltd., Delhi, under "Niramaya" Health Insurance Scheme and balance amount of Rs. 20.00 lakh was to be paid during 2023-24 due to shortage of funds.

However, the balance payable amounting to Rs. 20.00 lakh was not shown as Liability under Schedule-7 of accounts. This resulted in understatement of Liabilities by Rs. 20.00 lakh and understatement of Expenditure of 2022-23 by the same amount.

#### B. General

B.1 Advances amounting to Rs.16.40 lakh were pending for adjustment as of 31st March 2023.



The advances have been lying unadjusted since year 2010. The long pending advances lying unadjusted need to be reviewed and settled. The observation was also mentioned in the SAR of 2021-22, however no concrete efforts were made by the National Trust for settlement of these advances.

- B.2** An amount of Rs.28.23 lakh was depicted as opening as well as closing balance under Schedule 3- Endowment Funds. This included an amount of Rs. 2.23 lakh pertaining to FCRA fund, which was lying dormant in a saving bank account. The balance amount of Rs. 26.00 lakh pertained to Dr. Lotika Sarkar Endowment Fund. This amount was being held in Fixed Deposits, however, interest earned was not shown as addition to the Fund. The amount could not be quantified in audit as separate accounting of Fixed Deposits held for this purpose was not being done by the Trust.

**C. Grants-in-Aid**

National Trust has a corpus fund of Rs. 100 crore (Rupees One hundred Crore). The Trust received a grant of Rs. 35.00 crore from Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment for the year 2022-23. Out of the total Grant-in-aid available, the National Trust utilized an amount of Rs.35.00 Crore.

**D. Management letter**

Deficiencies which have not been included in the audit Report have been brought to the notice of the National Trust for the welfare of persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities, New Delhi (National Trust) through a management letter issued separately for remedial/corrective action.

**V.** Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the book of accounts.

**vi.** In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanation given to us, the said financial statements read together with the Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts, and subject to the significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in Annexure to this Audit Report give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India:

- (a) In so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet of the state of affairs of the National Trust as at 31 March, 2023 and
- (b) In so far as, it relates to Income and Expenditure Account of the surplus for the year ended on that date.
