A strategic meeting has been conducted on Monday, the 28<sup>th</sup> July 2025, at Haryana Bhawan, New Delhi, in the esteemed presence of following chairing authorities to promote commercial Airline Operations and Cargo Services at Hisar Airport :-

Representatives of IndiGo Airlines, Alliance Air, and SpiceJet Airlines attended the meeting in person, while representatives of Air India and Flybig Airlines attended the meeting virtually. *The attendance sheet of the attendees is attached herewith as **Annexure - I**.*

At the outset of the meeting, the participating airlines introduced themselves to the Chairing Authorities. Following the introductions, the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Haryana Airports Development Corporation Limited (HADC) delivered a detailed presentation outlining the existing infrastructure and upcoming developments at Hisar Airport. Subsequently, the Worthy Commissioner & Secretary, Civil Aviation Department, Government of Haryana, briefed the participants on the strategic significance of Hisar Airport, which spans 7,200 acres and is envisioned as a key aviation and logistics hub in North India. The airport's alignment with the Amritsar-Kolkata Industrial Corridor (AKIC) and its planned integration with the proposed Integrated Manufacturing Cluster (IMC) a flagship initiative of the State Government were also highlighted. It was emphasized that Hisar Airport offers strong potential for commercial flight operations, air cargo services, and Maintenance, Repair & Overhaul (MRO) facilities. The State Government reiterated its commitment to extending all necessary support to airlines interested in leveraging these opportunities.

Representatives from Air India, IndiGo, SpiceJet, Alliance Air, and Flybig acknowledged the initiative and expressed interest in assessing the feasibility of launching operations from Hisar Airport under the Viability Gap Funding (VGF) Scheme. They assured to provide detailed feedback post internal consultations with their respective planning and operational teams.

During the discussions, Alliance Air Aviation Limited shared its operational experience at Hisar Airport and encouraged other airlines by highlighting the positive outcomes. Alliance Air also proposed organizing a familiarization visit to Hisar Airport for airline representatives to assess the existing infrastructure and future preparedness.

A familiarization visit has been scheduled for 29<sup>th</sup> August 2025 to facilitate an on-ground assessment of Hisar Airport by airline officials. The visit will be conducted via the Hisar-Delhi-Hisar flight operated by Alliance Air, allowing participants to experience the airport's infrastructure and operational readiness firsthand. Invitees for the visit include all airlines that participated in the recent meeting, as well as agencies previously engaged in discussions related to MRO and cargo infrastructure during the meeting held on 9th July 2025.
