2.) Broad Campaign of Legal Awareness- under Pan India Awareness Programme :-

The Chhattisgarh State Legal Services Authority, Bilaspur launched statewide legal awareness drive from the 2nd of October, 2021 to 14th of November, 2021 with an objective to bring justice to the doorsteps of the common people. This campaign was done in collaboration with National Legal Services Authority and Ministry of Justice, Government of India under the banner of "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav" to celebrate and commemorate 75 years of progressive India and the glorious history of its people, culture and achievements. For cherishing the Gandhian ideology that true spirit of India lies in village, this campaign was aimed to create mass legal lawareness drive in more than 20,000 villages by covering each and every village of the state of Chhattisgarh thrice.

For this purpose, an exhaustive plan of action was drafted and the same has been successfully implemented across Chhattisgarh by deploying 251 teams consisting of PLVs, Law Students, Aganwadi Karyakarta, and Panel Lawyers.








6 Observation of 02nd October (Gandhi Jayanti):-


(B) Legal Awareness through Social Media Platforms,

In the year 2021, this channel has witnessed 42,100 views with watch time of 1.3K hours. There is also an increase of 1.2K subscribers. Achievement of this channel are as follows:

- * It has first of its kind "Sadbhavana Series" for Differently abled persons, wherein, videos for legal awareness have been articulated for differently abled persons and the same have been uploaded on Jan Chetna CGSLSA Youtube Channel. So far, 10 videos have been uploaded, which have earned more than 5822 views.

2) Front Offices in Legal Services Institutions :

Under National Legal Services Authority (Free and Competent Legal Services) Regulations 2010, 01 Front Office is established in HCLSC, 25 Front Offices are established in DLSAs and 51 Front Offices are established in TLSCs. Thus, a total of 77 Front Offices have been established for providing court-based legal services, which are manned by panel lawyers and one or more para-legal volunteers remain available during office hours. 1 Special Campaign to Prisoners "Unmukt"



pilot project was assigned to our state besides U.P & Bihar. Under this Project, life convicts, falling with in the criteria of State Government, need to be released prematurely. During this campaign, 356 prisoners have been identified for premature release, out of which 166 prisoners have already been released.

Application of 123 prisoners are pending for consideration before the State Government, whereas, application of 67 prisoners have been rejected by State Government. Legal assistance has already been provided to these life convicts in order to challenge the rejection of their application before the Hon'ble High Court.


6 Special Campaign to Child "Umang"

- * Under the joint aegis with UNICEF, a booklet "Umang" was released by the Hon'ble The Chief Justice of India on 09th of November, 2021. This booklet is for the mental development and Physo-social need of abandoned children. Core features of this booklet are as follows:
 - a. This booklet aims to train Para Legal Volunteers (PLVs) employed by the State Legal Services Authority, Chhattisgarh, on implementing mental health group work sessions with children in the age group of 6-12 years and 13-18 years.


- b. These mental health group work sessions are aimed at promoting positive mental health amongst the children whilst helping the PLVs to identify children experiencing mental health concerns to aid early identification and intervention for the same.
- c. They also help in preventing the development of mental health disorders amongst children by providing them with a safe and non judgmental space to grow, learn and express themselves. These mental health group work sessions will foster an overall sense of happiness, safety and resilience amongst the children and aid the same time help them in utilizing their cognitive, psychomotor and creative thinking abilities.
- d. The activities are aimed at promoting teamwork, collective decision making and planning which will facilitate appropriate socio-emotional, intellectual and moral development of the children.
- e. There are a total of 20 activities in the booklet and the booklet categoriges activity for children belonging to different age group.
- f. Under each activity the instructions to facilitate the activity and the rules to be followed during the facilitation are provided in detail. The expected outcomes of each activity are also provided in the booklet to serve as a guiding tool for the PLVs, which will gear their focus towards certain essential aspects of the activity and prevent the session from digressing towards casual conversations.



Five year old child was returned to mother by prompt and speedy action of DLSA Korba

Applicant Mrs. Maheshwari Nirmalker, w/o Mr. Sanjay Nirmalkar, R/o Ratakhar, Manas Chowk, District- Korba, lodged police complaint against her husband at PS-kotwali, alleging that he beats and abuses her. The police found the case to be in-eligible for police interfearence and advised the applicant Mrs. Maheshwari Nirmalkar, to seek redressal from Court. There-after, the applicant requested District Legal Services Authority, Korba for providing legal aid. Panel advocate Shri Naresh Shrivas was immediately provided to the aplicant. She told that her husband has forcibly kept their five year old daughter in his house, and her neighbors have informed her over phone that her daughter is continuously crying.

In this sitution, District Legal Services Authority promptly directed Child welfare committee, Korba, to immediately take action according to rules.

Child welfare committee, Korba immediately summoned applicant's husband along with five year old child. Ms. Seema Jagdalla, Secy. District Legal Services Authority persuaded and encouraged them to reconcile the dispute. Due to sincere and prompt efforts of District Legal Services Authority, the dispute between the couple was resolved. The non applicant apologized his wife and took her home along with their five year old daughter with promise to take care in future.



A person was prevented from becoming prey of cyber crime under "Prayas" - A special campaign for legal awareness in realtion to cyber crime.

"Parayas" - A special awareness program for prevention of cyber frauds was organized between 09-02-21 to 12-02-21 at financial institute in sector 6, Durg, C.G. on 11-12-2021. Ramu Sarthi, resident of Dhamdha, Durg came to the camp organized at civic center, Bhilai for obtaining loan of Rs. 50,000/-. Ramu told the Para Legal Volunteer, that he was informed by an unknown person over a mobile call that he has won lottery price worth one crore. The unknown person also told Ramu to deposit 50,000/- Rs. tax in advance, in order receive the complete lottery amount. Para leagl volunteer, Mr. Praveen Agrawal, prevented Ramu Sarthi from becoming prey of cyber fraud by providing him relevant information regarding cyber fraud. Hence, due to the effort of District Legal Services Authority, Ramu Sarthi was saved from falling into the traps of cyber crime

Four year old missing child Found and returned to the family by relentless efforts of CGSLSA

The family of applicant Jagdish Chauhan R/o Chakradhar Chowk, Raigarh, went to a picnic spot Ramjharna. Applicant's four year old daughter Riya Chauhan was acidently left behind and lost by the family. Chhattisgarh State Legal Services Authority was telephonically informed by an unknown person. Shri Siddharth Aggarwal, Member Secretary, Chhattisgarh legal service authority, immediately contacted his subordinate staff Devanandan Sahu, in Raigarh. CGSLA's Member Secretary, directed him to reach Ramjharna and look out for missing child. Shri Sahu reached Ramjharna and found missing child Riya chauhan. Shri Sahu telephonically informed local police about this incident and requested to find the family of the missing girl. During interaction Riya chauhan, told that her father's name is Jagdish chauhan, who is owner of Auto, she also told that their family came Ramjharna by their own auto which is at auto stand. Shri Sahu with Riya chauhan went to auto stand, where she identified the auto. When Shri Jagdish chauhan father of Riya chauhan went to lodge missing complaint, he was informed that his daughter is recovered by staff of District Legal Services Authority. Thus, by effort of Chhattisgarh State Legal Service Authority, missing child returned to her family.



Efficient functioning of DLSA, Raipur in getting Income Certificate, Caste Certificate, BPL Cards etc.

Under the guidance of Chairman, District Legal Services Authority, Raipur, para legal volunteen Miss Devaki Sahu was conducting a survey at Gandhi Chowk, Sarora, Raipur. During the survey applicant Mrs. Shivmati, w/o Mr. Jaiprakash sought her legal assistance in getting BPL (below poverty line) Card. She told the para legal volunteer, that she has applied for BPL card several times, but till date she has not got the same. The para legal volunteer promptly filled her application form and helped her in getting BPL card. Similarly she assisted, Miss Radhika Sahu and helped her in getting cast certificate. Like wise para legal volunteer Pooja Yadav provided effective legal assistance to Jitendra Yadav in getting income certificate and Asharam Yadav in getting compensation against land acquition during survey at Rajatalab and Abhanpur respectively. In a similar case para legal volunteer Pooja yadav was doing survey at Kachana Raipur. During her survey she found Ms Puni Nihal who was blind by birth, she was facing problems in getting medical certificate regarding her blindness. Para legal volunteer provided her with requisite assistance and completed legal formalities. Hence, due to the timely help of DLSA Raipur Ms Puni Nihal received her blindness certificate on time.

Story 5

Resolution of Martimonial dispute by innovative Mobile Man Facility at DLSA, Balod.

Complainant Mrs. Rukhmani Patel was wife of accused Ram kumar Patel. Accused Ramkumar Patel was employee at Bharat Gas Agency Balod. One day when accused Ramkumar Patel returned from work, around 10:00 PM in the night, complainant Rukhmani was on a phone call with his mother. The accused Ramkumar Patel and his mother Dewla Patel had an argument with complainant, as she always remain busy in phone with her mother's family members and she ignore their family. Her mother in-law accused her for disrespecting and unnecessarily arguing with accused. Within no time their argument turned into fighting. Accused Ramlal and his mother Dewla bashed the complainant with hand and fist and abused her badly, due to which complainant got injured. The complainant lodged FIR against the accused persons, at Rajhara police station. Charge sheet was filed in the Court of Mrs. Shantiprabhu Jain. The matter was fixed for pre-sitting. The dispute was resolved by the efforts and necessary counselling by the advocates and the presiding officer. The complainant submitted application under section 320 (8) Cr.P.C. for rajinama. The matter was fixed for rajinama in Lok Adalat. On the said date of Lok Adalat a complainant could not reach the Court on account of some urgent work. In present case consent of complainant was recorded by means of mobile man. Mobile man refers to a para legal volunteer who specially designated to visit and complete legal formalities at the residence of the complainant. In present case para legal volunteer Deepak kumar sahu was mobile man who went to complainant Rajkumari's house assisted in virtual appearance of complainant in the Court. The consent of complainant regarding rajinama was recorded by virtual medium. The rajinama was made possible due to combined efforts of advocates presiding officer and mobile man.



An old man showed tolerance and forgiveness after counselling at National Lok Adalat.

The accused was spitting on the public road, the complainant senior citizen, objected him and asked not to spit on the road. On being objected and stopped the accused got furious and thrashed the senior citzen, abused him and threatend to kill him. The senior citzen, during the fight collided with a tractor parked nearby, and got severe injuries. The above case was taken up for pre-seating before the Lok Adalat and the parties were given conselling and were encouraged to resolve their dispute amicably in Lok Adalat. On being encouraged by the presiding officer the accused admitted his fault and apologized and the senior citizen decided to forgive. The matter was fixed in the Lok Adalat. On the day of Lok Adalat, the senior citizen failed to appear in the Court due to bad health reasons. It was promptly decided by Chairman, DLSA to immediately send the trainee judge to the elderly through mobile-van for recording his consent and thus after obtaining consent from the elderly, the matter was resolved in the Lok Adalat.

Virtual connection was established by Mobile Van, and rajinama was facilitated successfully

Parties were farmers, and their fields were situated adjecent to each other. Quarrel between the parties started regarding agricultural boundary. The dispute got severe and resulted into a fight resulting in injury to one of them. The injured applicant filed the complaint against other party. Both the parties were summoned and given necessary counselling in pre-seating, resultantly, they agreed to settle their dispute. On the day of Lok Adalat, it was expressed by the advocate that the applicant runs a photocopy shop, he earns his livelihood from the same shop, if he appears today then he will have to suffer a financial loss. Considering the above request of the advocate seriously, the newly appointed judges were authorized and sent via mobile van for obtaining the statement of the applicant and accordingly the consent was recorded through video call and the matter was disposed of. In this way, a cordial relation was again created between the two neighbors by the District Legal Services Authority.

Story 8

Prompt medical assistance to patient suffering from ovarian cancer, by DLSA, Raipur.

Strong determination and continuos observation are indeed key essentials for saving life. With the said virtues, respected Chairman District Legal Services Authority, Raipur, successfully helped Mrs. Shanti Bai in medical treatment. The applicant was a poor lady, she was not capable of bearing the expense of medical treatment. She was suffering from ovarian cancer and had no means to incur the treatment expenses. Due to the timely help of District Legal Services Authority, Raipur, and medical care and attention of the Doctors, Shanti Bai healed and recovered from the deadly disease of cancer. Respected Chairman, District Legal Services Authority, Raipur, made arrangement for her safe return to her home in Koria District with blessings and prayers for her healthy life.

Story 9

Senior Citizen saved from being alienated from family by the efforts of DLSA, Ambikapur.

During Amrit Mahotsava, a special legal aid camp was organised at Khalpara village in Ambikapur District on 12-03-2021. Para legal volunteer Nidhi met with a woman, who wanted to send her father in law, Jitiyaram to old age home. Para legal volunteer, Nidhi very politely explain her elderly people are like shady tree. As a shady tree provides shelter to everyone, like wise our elders at home provide shelter to whole family by their wisdom. The para legal volunteer appealed the woman to alter her flawed attitude to-wards old age people, as their life experience and knowledge enlightens the whole family. After contemplation, the woman realised the relevance of senior family members. Therefore, due to efforts of para legal volunteer of District Legal Services Authority, a senior citizen was saved from being alienated from family.



Poor tribal girl was provided legal assistance in obtaining admission in school.

Tribal girl named Akanksha Mandavi d/o of Suresh Mandavi R/o Boriamokasa, PS-Khadgaon, Ambagarh chowki, District-Rajnandgaon, use to live with her mother. Her father had deserted them, due to which they were facing economic crisis. The economic condition of the girl and her mother was so week that she had to discontinue her studies. Maternal uncle of Akanksha Mandavi requested local schools in Ambagarh chowki for admission, but no help could be provided to her. There - after, her uncle Mr. Balwant Sori, wrote an application for legal assistance to Taluka Legal Services Committee, Ambagarh chowki, District-Rajnandgaon. On the basis of application, Chairman, Taluka Legal Services Committee, directed para legal volunteer Jaiprakash Sahu to immediately seek assistance of Block Education Officer. Due to the sincere effort of Taluka Legal Services Committee and Block Education Officer, the girl was given admission at Girls Higher Secondary School Ambagarh Chowki. The girl conveyed her gratitude towards District Legal Services Authority. Hence under the guidance of Chairman, District Legal Services Authority, Rajnandgaon and due to the efforts of the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority and Chairman, Taluka Legal Services Committee, the education of girl child was saved from being discontinued.

Story 11

Paralyzed patient was unable to appear in Lok Adalat – Mobile Van facility proved to be a boon.

In a cheque bounce matter, under Section 138, Negotiable Instruments Act, pending in the Court of Mrs. Prateeksha Sharma, Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Durg. The non applicant in the said case was suffering from paralysis, due to which it was impossible for him to appear in the Court for rajinama. Settlement of dispute was not possible without presence of both the parties in Court. On being informed, about the situation, District Legal Services Authority immediately made contact with the paralysed party. The said party was unable to appear before Court. The Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, informed respected Chairman, Shri Rajesh Shrivastava regarding inability of the party to appear before the Court. Respected Chairman sent para legal volunteer Shri Parmeshwar, in mobile van to the house of paralyzed party. The consent of said party for rajinama was noted and there-by, the case which was pending since 2019 was successfully resolved.
