During the special session Mr. Sundhar R K, Chief Manager training, State Bank institute of learning and development, Numgambakkam, Chennai, detailed an overview of *schemes and Benefits in Nationalized Banks for Empowering Persons with Disabilities*", also specifically highlighted the options and support rended for families of persons with disabilities.

Bank Loan Facilities:

- Priority loan schemes with lower interest rates and easier terms for PWDs and their families.
- Collateral-free loans to access credit without security.
- Loans for assistive devices like hearing aids and wheelchairs.

Special Insurance Schemes:

- Discounted health insurance premiums for PWDs.
- Niramaya Health Insurance Scheme offering cashless treatment for specified diseases at empaneled hospitals.
- Accident and disability coverage for financial protection.
- Support in availing government schemes such as Deendayal Disabled Rehabilitation Scheme and NHFDC loans.

Tax Exemptions and Benefits:

- Assistance in claiming income tax exemptions, including medical and dependent care deductions.
- Facilitation of subsidies and grants for treatment, education, and rehabilitation.

Educational and Employment Benefits:

- Free or subsidized skill development programs for PWDs.
- Training and support for families of PWDs to start income-generating activities.

Financial Inclusion Initiatives:

- No-fee or low-fee savings accounts with no minimum balance and free ATM
- Improved digital banking with accessible online and mobile services for persons with disabilities.
