No. CSG-1471/1088-(36)/5-C : In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules and orders issued in this behalf and in force in the State or any part thereof, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules for regulating recruitment to the post of Textile Expert in Maharashtra Cooperative Service Class I in the Directorate of Handlooms, Powerlooms and Cooperative Textiles, Nagpur, namely:-

RULES.

1. These rules may be called the Textile Expert (in the Directorate of Handlooms, Powerlooms and Cooperative Textiles) Recruitment Rules, 1978.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise -

(1) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra and

(2) "recognised" means recognised by Government

3. Appointment to the post of Textile Expert in the Directorate of Handlooms, Powerlooms, and Cooperative Textiles, Nagpur shall be made either, -

(1) by promotion of a suitable Assistant Director ~~Executive~~ in the Directorate of Handlooms, Powerlooms and Cooperative Textiles, who has served in that capacity for not less than five years and possesses the qualifications prescribed for appointment by nomination in clause (ii) of sub-rule (3); or

(2) by transfer of a suitable officer from any Technical Department of Government or

(3) by nomination from amongst ~~eligible~~ candidates who -

(i) unless already in the service of the Government, are not more than forty of age;

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- (ii) possess a degree in textile technology of a statutory University or a diploma in a textile technology of a recognised Technical Institute; and
- (iii) have gained experience, after obtaining such degree or diploma, in spinning and weaving in textile mills, for not less than three years in the case of degree holders and for not less than five years in the case of diploma holders; and
- (v) are conversant with -
- (a) the installation and maintenance of handlooms, powerlooms, spinning mills and the like;
 - (b) all the pre-weaving and post-weaving processes and the like; and
 - (c) the policies laid down by the Textile Commissioner, Government of India, Bombay, in respect of work of State Textile Controller regarding permits of powerlooms and other textile machinery, equipment, accessories, etc.

Provided that, the age limit may be relaxed in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both:

Provided further that, preference may be given to candidates who have experience and knowledge of the Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act., 1960 and the rules made thereunder:

Provided also that, if at any stage of selection, the Maharashtra Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates possessing the requisite experience are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Schedule Tribes or Nomadic Tribes then, the Commission may in the matter of such selection relax the condition of experience

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set out in sub-clause (iii) of clause (3), and select suitable candidates belonging to such castes or tribes to fill up such vacancies.

- 4. A candidate appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two - years.
- 5. A person appointed to the post whether by promotion or by transfer or by nomination shall be required to pass the accounts Text and examinations in Hindi and Marathi, according to the prescribed rules unless he has already passed, or is exempted from passing, such examinations.

No. CSG 1073/18203/116/80- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders and instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Joint Director (Technical) in Maharashtra Cooperative Service Class-I, in the Directorate of Handlooms, Powerlooms and Cooperative Textiles of the Government of Maharashtra, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Directorate of Handlooms, Powerlooms and Cooperative Textiles (Joint Director (Technical), Class-I, Recruitment Rules, 1980.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise, -

(i) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Handlooms, Powerlooms and Cooperative Textiles of Government;

(ii) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra.

3. Appointment to the post of Joint Director (Technical), Class-I, in the Directorate shall be made either ;

(1) by promotion of a suitable person from the cadre of Textile Experts in the Directorate possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination in clause (2) of this rule; or

(2) by nomination from amongst candidates who ;

(a) unless already in the service of the Government, are not more than forty years of age (on the date on which the post is advertised in the Official Gazette; and)

(b) possess a degree of a statutory University in textile technology;

(c) have, after obtaining such degree, acquired experience

(i) of spinning and weaving in a position of responsibility in textile mills for not less than five years;

(ii) of installation and maintenance of powerlooms and spinning mills with the pre-weaving and post weaving processes in textile industry; and

(d) have thorough knowledge of the policies laid down by the Government of India in respect of work of State Textile Controller, regarding permits for powerlooms and other textile machinery, equipment, accessories and the like :

Provided that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission, in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience or both :

Provided further that preference may be given to candidates having knowledge of the Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act, 1960 (Mah. Act of 1961)


and the rules framed thereunder.

Provided also that, if on any occasion, 22/7/50
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the post is reserved for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Nonotified Tribes or Nomadic Tribes and no candidate possessing the requisite experience is available to fill up the vacancy, then the Maharashtra Public Service Commission, may, notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause (c), relax the condition of experience set out therein and select any candidate who, but for such experience, is suitable.

4. A person appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion or by nomination, shall be required to pass the examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing, those examinations.




