“Relying on the said unrebutted evidence produced on behalf of the petitioner, we find and hold that Anita Methodist Matriculation Higher Secondary School, No. 5 & 6, BKN Avenue, Ritherdon Road, Vepery, Chennai, Tamil Nadu-600007 run by Anita Methodist Matriculation Higher Secondary School and Educational Trust is eligible for grant of minority status on religious basis. The evidence also proves that the said educational institution was established with the main objective of subserving the interests of the Christian minority community.

Consequently, Anita Methodist Matriculation Higher Secondary School, No. 5 & 6, BKN Avenue, Ritherdon Road, Vepery, Chennai, Tamil Nadu-600007 is declared as a minority educational institution covered under Article 30 of the Constitution of India within the meaning of Section 2(g) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004 subject to the condition that the petitioner would file an affidavit or undertaking to the fact that the petitioner institution shall not deny admission of eligible candidate of the Christian minority community subject to the eligibility of the students and availability of the accommodation in the petitioner institution, file resolution of the General Body of the Trust to authorize Mr. Andrew B.
