The evidence also proves that the said educational institution was established with the main objective of sub-serving the interests of the muslim minority community.*

*Consequently, Unity Nursery and Primary School, 824, Peria Arisikara Street, Gandarvakottai, Pudukkottai District, Tamil Nadu-613301 is declared as a minority educational institution covered under Article 30 of the Constitution of India within the meaning of Section 2(g) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004 subject to the condition that the petitioner would file an affidavit or undertaking to the fact that the petitioner institution shall not deny admission of eligible candidate of the Muslim minority community subject to the eligibility of the students and availability of the accommodation in the petitioner institution and also file resolution of the General Body of the Trust to authorize Shri M. Sheikh Alauddin, Chairman, Abdullah Educational and Charitable Trust for obtaining MSC from this Commission.”*

After compliance of the above order, a minority status certificate be issued accordingly.

So in the interest of justice, we are of the considered opinion, without going on the merits of the case, it is just, proper and fit case to send the matter back to the state competent authority to decide the application of the petitioner institution for grant of NOC under Section 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 on merits after considering all the documents produced by the petitioner institutions at the earliest, expeditiously.”*

Office is directed to send copy of this order to the State Competent Authority and in the interest of justice, in addition the petitioner institution is also directed to produce certified copy of this order before the State Competent Authority immediately for compliance of this order.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of in accordance with this order.
