It transpires from the petition that on 05.07.2022, the petitioner has applied for grant of No Objection Certificate to the State Competent Authority i.e. Principal Secretary, School Education Department, Government of Tamil Nadu, Rina Road, Fort St. George, Secretariat, Chennai, Tamil Nadu – 600009, which was received by the respondent on 07.07.2022, The said petition is still pending. The petitioner has waited sufficiently for a period of 90 days, before filing this petition.

The petitioner has already filed the proof of delivery of the registered AD to the respondent.

Petitioner has filed Resolution Passed by the Governing Body to obtain Minority Status Certificate from this Commission and envelope with postage for sending notice to the State Competent Authority.

It also transpires from the petition that in this Un-aided School (Higher Secondary level) during the academic year 2019-20 total 2252 students were studying and out of them 705 students were from Christian Minority Community, during the academic year 2020-21 total 2171 students were studying and out of them 696 students were from the Christian Minority Community and during the academic year 2021-22 total 2089 students were studying and out of them 643 students belongs to the Christian Minority Community.

On perusal of the petition it is found that this school is upto Higher Secondary level and recognition certificate filed by the petitioner is issued by Chief Educational officer instead of Central / State Examination Board.

Office is directed to tag the file no. 662 of 2019 with this case

Learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for time to file updated recognition certificate issued by the Central / State Examination Board.
