The Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 3945 of 2018 in case of Sisters of St. Joseph of Cluny vs. The State of West Bengal and Ors. vide order dated 18.04.2018, has held that any person who desires to establish minority educational institution after the amendment Act of 2006 came into force, must apply only to the competent authority for grant of No Objection Certificate for the said purpose.

All applications for the establishment of a minority educational institution after the amendment Act of 2006 must go to the competent authority set up under the statute.

It also transpires from the record, that the petitioner has also applied before the State Competent Authority for grant of Minority Status Certificate and that the application is still pending.

As per law and settled procedure, petitioner cannot apply before this Commission unless and until the Minority Status Certificate application is disposed by the State Competent Authority. Hence this application is not maintainable at this stage.

In this case, office has reported that petitioner has not filed affidavit, Unique ID, envelop with postage charges for sending notice to the respondent and affiliation/recognition certificate.

Since nobody has appeared to make any submission. The Commission has waited sufficiently. The Commission has been forced to dismiss the petition.

Hence, the petition is dismissed in default.
