This petition has been received by Mr. Suresh P.C., Sooryalayam, K.G.Nagar, Ware House Junction, Kalpetta, Wayanand District, Kerala for cancellation of Minority Status Certificate (in short 'MSC') under Section 12(C) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions (in short 'NCMEI') Act, 2004 issued to Kaypees International School, Crescent Hill, Kunnumbatta, Wayanad, Kerala vide Case No. 2437 of 2012 on dated 20.02.2013.
3. During the course of arguments Mr. Junais P., Advocate for the respondent i.e. Kaypees International School, Crescent Hill, Kunnumbatta, Wayanad, Kerala filed an application which is taken on record. Copy of application supplied to the Learned Counsel for the petitioner. By the said application Learned Counsel for the respondent stated that application had filed to get No Objection Certificate (in short 'NOC') from the State of Kerala for affiliating the institution with CBSE for many years, due to the Education Policy of the State Govt. and due to other reasons the applicant institution did not get the said NOC. Therefore, finding no other option, as the school cannot function without recognition. The applicant institution has shut down the institution from this academic year onwards.
4. With the above facts and circumstances the applicant institution would like to surrender the original MSC issued by this Commission. So the applicant humbly prayed that the applicant institution may kindly be permitted to surrender the original MSC issued by this Commission.

5. Learned Counsel for the petitioner has no objection in accepting the application filed by the respondent and prayed to cancel the MSC issued in favour of Kaypees International School, Crescent Hill, Kunnumbatta, Wayanad, Kerala vide Case No. 2437 of 2012 on dated 20.02.2013.
6. We have gone through the application filed by the respondent and perused the case file no. 716 of 2015.
7. Without going on merits of the case as per the information supplied by the respondent institution that institution has shut down from the current academic session onwards and he is ready to surrender the original MSC issued by this Commission.
8. In above facts and circumstances the petition filed by Mr. Suresh P.C., Sooryalayam, K.G.Nagar, Ware House Junction, Kalpetta, Wayanad District, Kerala succeeds and allowed. The impugned order dated 20.02.2013 passed by this Commission in favour of Kaypees International School, Crescent Hill, Kunnumbatta, Wayanad, Kerala vide case no. 2437 of 2012 is hereby cancelled. Respondent is directed to surrender their original MSC issued by this Commission within one month from the date of this order.
9. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
