The petitioner has filed copies of some internal communication letters of the State Competent Authority as proof of delivery of the NOC application.

Petitioner has filed Resolution Passed by the Governing Body to obtain Minority Status Certificate from this Commission and envelope with postage for sending notice to the State Competent Authority.

It also transpires from the petition that in this Un-aided school (Primary level) total 313 students are studying and out of them 237 Students belong to the Buddhist Minority Community.

In this petition Amendment in Memorandum of Association of the Society is prior to the filing application u/s 10 of NCMEI Act. 2004 before the State Competent Authority and also petition before this Commission for grant of Minority Status Certificate.

In this case office has reported that Petitioner has filed amended MoA but not filed original MoA with this petition and Society Registration certificate filed by the petitioner is not legible.

Office is directed to issue show cause notice by registered Ad and e-mail to the petitioner as to why this petition may not be dismissed at this stage.

The evidence also proves that the said educational institution was established with the main objective of sub-serving the interests of the Christian minority community.

Consequently, Acts Secondary School, 15 Km, Hosur Road, Electronic City P.O., Bangalore, Karnataka-560100, which is for ICSE Xth Examination, is declared as an unaided minority educational institution covered under Article 30 of the Constitution of India within the meaning of Section 2(g) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004 subject to the condition that the petitioner would file an affidavit or undertaking to the fact that the petitioner institution shall not deny admission of eligible candidate of the Christian minority community subject to the eligibility of the students and availability of the accommodation in the petitioner institution. If the petitioner institution failed to comply the above order of this Commission within a period of three months from the date of order passed by this Commission then the petition filed by the petitioner for grant of MSC will be automatically deemed to be dismissed."

After compliance of the above order, a minority status certificate be issued accordingly.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in accordance with this order.
