In this case office has reported that the petitioner has not filed certified list of Society's Founding Members, Society Registration Certificate, Governing Body Resolution to obtain Minority Status Certificate from this Commission and submitted envelope but without postal charges.

Office is directed to issue show cause notice to the petitioner by email as to why this petition may not be dismissed at this stage.
