An application for grant of Minority Status Certificate to Idhaya Engineering College for Women, Idhaya Nagar, Nainarpalayam Road, Chinnasalem, Villupuram Dt., Tamil Nadu has been received on 06.09.2019 from the petitioner institution.

Notice was issued to the respondent but respondent State Competent Authority has not filed any reply and no response received from the State Competent Authority of Tamil Nadu that is why this Commission has appointed Physical Inspection Committee for sending their report on dated 10.08.2021 and thereafter physical inspection committee has sent a letter dated 28.03.2022, which was received in the Commission's Office on dated 04.04.2022 and stated that as per the Order of this Commission Physical Inspection Committee inspected the petitioner institution and ascertained that Tamil Nadu Government vide Go(1D) No.113 Higher Education department dated 30.04.2021 issued Minority Status to the institution for the period of five years from 2018-19 to 2022-23. Committee has also sent a photocopy of an Order in which it is stated that the Government after careful examination ratified the action of treating Idhaya Engineering College for Women, Idhaya Nagar, nainarpalayam Road, Chinnasalem, Villupuram Dt., Tamil Nadu, as Minority Educational Institution during the period from the year 2012-13 to 2017-18 and grant continuance of Minority Status (Religiou/Christian) to Idhaya Engineering College for Women, Idhaya Nagar, nainarpalayam Road, Chinnasalem, Villupuram Dt., Tamil Nadu, run by the Immaculate Heart of Mary Society, Cuddalore for a period of five years from the year 2018-19 to 2022-23, subject to some conditions.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn our attention specially on the judgment passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 826-827 of 2017 in the case of The Manager, Corporate Educational Agency Vs. James Mathews & Ors., decided on dated 11.0.7.2017 and in that Judgment of N. Ammad Vs. Manager, Emjay High School and Others [(1998) 6 SCD 674] is relied.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that Minority Status Certificate cannot be issued by the State on periodical basis (five years) and order passed by the State Competent Authority is against the Judgment of Hon'ble High Court of Madras passed in case T.K.V.T.S.S Medical Educational and Charitable Trust Vs. State of Tamil Nadu AIR 2002 Madras 42 which says that Minority Status Certificate cannot be renewed just like driving license.

We are agree with the contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner but in this case which is in our hands the issue is whether we can grant Minority Status Certificate to the petitioner institute at this time for unlimited period.

First of all we make it clear that petitioner has not furnished any information about the facts that petitioner has already obtained Minority Status from the State of Tamil Nadu. Petitioner has also submitted information against the column no. 5 of the MSC application that no authority has granted minority status to the petitioner institution. Petitioner also declared that particulars furnished in the application for grant of MSC are true to the best of his knowledge and belief and certainly this declaration is not correct as per the record.

It is clear from the above mentioned facts that the petitioner has not come with the clean hands before the Commission.

Petitioner has not challenged any order of the State Competent Authority, even this Commission has Appellate Powers also. Without going to pass any order on merits, we are of the considered opinion that this application for grant of MSC is not maintainable at this stage, because at this time petitioner institution has Minority Status granted by the State Competent Authority. Hence, this application is deserved to dismissed.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of as dismissed.
