It also transpires from the petition that in this Un-aided school (Higher Secondary level) during the academic year 2020-21 total 750 students were studying and out of them 300 Students from the Sikh Minority Community, during the academic year 2021-22 total 814 students were studying and out of them 309 were from Sikh Minority Community and during the academic year 2022-23 total 1200 students were studying and out of them 450 students belongs to the Sikh Minority Community.

On perusal of the petition it is found that level of the Education of this school is Higher Secondary but recognition certificate filed by the petitioner is not issued by Central / State Examination Board.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for time to file updated recognition / affiliation certificate issued by Central / State Examination Board.

Office is directed to tag the previous file no. 182 of 2022 with this case.
