It transpires from the petition that on 14.12.2021, the petitioner has applied for grant of No Objection Certificate to the State Competent Authority i.e. Secretary, Department of Minorities Welfare, Government of Andhra Pradesh, 3rd Floor, Andhra Pradesh Secretariat, Velagapudi, Amaravati, Andhra Pradesh - 521185, which was received by the respondent on 20.12.2021. The said petition is still pending. The petitioner has waited sufficiently for a period of 90 days, before filing this petition.

The petitioner has already filed the proof of delivery of the registered AD to the respondent.

Petitioner has filed Resolution Passed by the Governing Body to obtain Minority Status Certificate from this Commission.

It also transpires from the petition that in this Un-aided School (Secondary Level) during the academic year 2020-21 total 348 students were studying and out of them 32 students were from Christian Minority Community, during the academic year 2021-22 total 435 students were studying and out of them 46 students were from the Christian Minority Community and during the academic year 2022-23 total 685 students were studying and out of them 215 students belongs to the Christian Minority Community.
