Department, MDI Building, Post - Dhurwa, District - Ranchi, Jharkhand - 834004, which was received by the respondent on 22.09.2022. The said petition is still pending. The petitioner has waited sufficiently for period of 90 days, before filing this petition.

In this case office has reported that in the Trust Deed dated 13.02.2019 petitioner has mentioned only two members name and it is also not clear from the deed that whether the present members are the same as founding members or not.

We have perused the Trust Deed dated 13.02.2019, it is found that Ms. Khatiza Parween, W/o. Manjur Ansari is the settler of this Trust alongwith two other members namely Ms. Fatima Khatoon, W/o Abdul Gafur Ansari and Mr. Zakiarfin, S/o Haji Slahuddin Ehsan. In Trust Deed, it is mentioned that the total strength of the Trustees shall at no time be less than five and more than eleven.

In the Trust Deed, it is also mentioned that Mr. Khatiza Parween, W/o Mr. Manjur Ansari shall be the Chairman of the Trust and after she retires her son Mr. Manjar Hassan will be next Chairman of Abdul Gafur Ansari Education Trust.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for time to take instructions from his client.

So this petition is not maintainable at this stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh petition for the same relief. Leave and liberty is granted.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
