4. Petitioner has filed Resolution Passed by the Governing Body to obtain Minority Status Certificate from this Commission and envelope with postage for sending notice to the State Competent Authority.

5. It also transpires from the petition that the petitioner Institute is an unaided institution (Higher Secondary).

6. During the academic year 2020-21, out of 190 students, 06 students were from the Sikh minority community, in the year 2021-22, out of 234 students, 08 students were from the Sikh minority community and in the year 2022-23, out of 490, 14 students were from the Sikh minority community.

7. It transpires from the petition that the amendment in the Trust Deed of the petitioner Trust was done prior to the filing application u/s 10 of NCMEI Act. 2004 and also petition before this Commission for grant of Minority Status Certificate.
