Nomination is invited for the 2024 UNESCO International Literacy Prize. The prizes are:


- (i) UNESCO King Sejong Literacy Prize: for rewarding activities promoting mother-language based literacy development. It is supported by the Government of the Republic of Korea
- (ii) UNESCO Confucius Prize For Literacy: Given for functional literacy, leveraging technological environments, in support of adults in rural areas and out-of-school youth. It is endorsed by the Government of the People's Republic of China.

Eligibility for the award :

- Individuals, institutions and organizations promoting literacy.
- Programmes must be still in operation and have a proven record of innovative work in the field of literacy for at least 2 years.
- Programmes that have not been awarded the UNESCO International Literacy Prizes in the past five years.

All the Minority Educational Institution are requested to disseminate the information and forward the applications to Indian National Commission for Cooperation with UNESCO (INCCU) by 5th July, 2024 so as to enable INCCU to screen and forward the recommended applications to UNESCO by 19th July 2024.
