Order dictated separately and pronounced, which reads as under: -

Relying on the said un rebutted evidence produced on behalf of the petitioner, we find and hold that the Shibli Public School, Village and Post Raja Ka Tajpur, Tehseel Chandpur, District Bijnor, Uttar Pradesh, run by the Millat Academy, is eligible for grant of minority status on religious basis. The evidence also proves that the said educational institution was established with the main objective of sub-serving the interests of the Muslim minority community.

Consequently, Shibli Public School, Village and Post Raja Ka Tajpur, Tehseel Chandpur, District Bijnor, Uttar Pradesh, is declared as an Unaided minority educational institution covered under Article 30 of the Constitution of India within the meaning of Section 2(g) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004 subject to the condition that the petitioner would file an affidavit for undertaking to the fact that the petitioner institution shall not deny admission of eligible candidate of the Muslim minority community subject to the eligibility of the students and availability of the accommodation in the petitioner institution. If the petitioner institution failed to comply the above order of this Commission within a period of three months from the date of order passed by this Commission then the petition filed by the petitioner for grant of msc will be automatically deemed to be dismissed.

After compliance of the above order, a minority status certificate be issued accordingly.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in accordance with this order.
