- 4. The petitioner has filed downloaded copy of letter dated 28.7.2023 issued by CBSE granting extension of affiliation to the petitioner institution for the period 1.4.2024 to 31.3.2029.
- 5. Petitioner has filed Resolution Passed by the Governing Body to obtain Minority Status Certificate from this Commission and envelope with postage for sending notice to the State Competent Authority.
- 6. It also transpires from the petition that the petitioner Institute is an unaided institution (Secondary). During the academic year 2021-22, out of 211 students, 18 students were from the Christian Minority Community and in the year 2022-23, out of 460 students, 21 students were from the Christian Minority Community and in the year 2023-24, out of total 577 students, 32 students were from the Christian minority community.
- 7. It transpires that the Amendment in the Trust Deed of the petitioner Trust is done prior to the filing application u/s 10 of NCMEI Act. 2004 before the State Competent Authority and also petition before this Commission for grant of Minority Status Certificate.
- 8. Office is directed to issue notice to the respondent by registered AD and e-mail.
