Relying on the said unrebutted evidence produced on behalf  
of the petitioner, we find and hold that the St. Michael's  
Matriculation School, Big Bazaar Street, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu, is  
eligible for grant of minority status on religious basis. The evidence  
also proves that the said educational institution was established with  
the main objective of sub-serving the interests of the Christian  
minority community.

Consequently, St. Michael's Matriculation School, Big Bazaar  
Street, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu, is declared as unaided minority  
educational institution covered under Article 30 of the Constitution of  
India within the meaning of Section 2(g) of the National Commission  
for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004 subject to the  
condition that the petitioner would file an affidavit or undertaking to  
the fact that the petitioner institution shall not deny admission of  
eligible candidate of the Christian minority community subject to the  
eligibility of the students and availability of the accommodation in  
the petitioner institution. If the petitioner institution failed to comply  
the above order of this Commission within a period of three months  
from the date of order passed by this Commission then the petition  
filed by the petitioner for grant of MSC will be automatically deemed  
to be dismissed.

After compliance of the above order, a minority status  
certificate be issued accordingly.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in  
accordance with this order.

A bare reading of the physical inspection report makes it clear that during the academic year 2021-22, out of total 1722 students, 290 students were from the Muslim minority community, 51 students were from the Christian minority community, 03 students were from the Sikh minority community, 24 students were from the Jain minority community and 1390 students were Hindu. It is relevant to mention here that during the academic year 2021-22 out of total 62 teachers, 06 teachers were from Muslim minority community, 06 teachers were from the Christian minority community, 01 teacher was from Sikh minority community, 01 teacher was from Jain minority community and 48 teachers were Hindu.

Whereas the information supplied by the petitioner with regard to students and teachers strength are different from the physical inspection report.

In addition, the level of education of the petitioner institution mentioned in the physical inspection report is different from the information supplied against column no. 6 of the application format for grant of minority status certificate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to clarify the said inconsistencies.
