under: -

Relying on the said unrebutted evidence produced on behalf of the petitioner, we find and hold that the Mother Teresa Higher Secondary School, 576, W-Block, Keshav Nagar, Kanpur, Dist. Kanpur Nagar, Uttar Pradesh run by the Rev. B. Singh Memorial Mother Teresa Educational Society, is eligible for grant of minority status on religious basis. The evidence also proves that the said educational institution was established with the main objective of sub-serving the interests of the Christian minority community.

Consequently, Mother Teresa Higher Secondary School, 576, W-Block, Keshav Nagar, Kanpur, Dist. Kanpur Nagar, Uttar Pradesh, is declared as unaided minority educational institution covered under Article 30 of the Constitution of India within the meaning of Section 2(g) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004. subject to the condition that the petitioner would file an affidavit or undertaking to the fact that the petitioner institution shall not deny admission of eligible candidate of the Christian minority community subject to the eligibility of the students and availability of the accommodation in the petitioner institution. If the petitioner institution failed to comply the above order of this Commission within a period of three months from the date of order passed by this Commission then the petition filed by the petitioner for grant of MSC will be automatically deemed to be dismissed.

After compliance of the above order, a minority status certificate be issued accordingly.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in accordance with this order.
