It transpires from the petition that on 6.11.2024, the petitioner institution has applied for grant of No Objection Certificate to the State Competent Authority i.e. Director, Primary Education, Department of School Education & Literacy, MDI Building, Post Dhurwa, District Ranchi, Jharkhand- 834 004, which was received by the respondent on 11.11.2024. The said petition is still pending as per the petitioner institution. The petitioner has waited sufficiently for period of 90 days as per Section 10 of NCMEI Act, 2004, before filing this petition.

3. The petitioner has already filed the proof of delivery of track consignment to the respondent.

4. The petitioner has filed notarized copy of letter dated 9.10.2024 issued by District Education Officer, Godda, granting recognition to the petitioner institution from academic year 2023-24 for three years.

5. Petitioner has filed Resolution Passed by the Governing Body to obtain Minority Status Certificate from this Commission and envelope with postage for sending notice to the State Competent Authority.

6. It also transpires from the petition that the petitioner Institute is un-aided institution (Middle).

7. During the academic year 2022-23, out of 198 students, 111 students were from the Christian minority community, in the year 2023-24, out of 190 students, 108 students were from the Christian minority community and in the year 2024-25, out of 161 students, 63 students were from the Christian minority community.

8. In this petition Amendment in the Memorandum of Association of the petitioner Society is done prior to the filing application u/s 10 of NCMEI Act. 2004 before the State Competent Authority and also petition before this Commission for grant of Minority Status Certificate.

9. Office is directed to issue notice to the respondent by registered AD and e-mail. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to file certified copies of all the relevant documents.

The said petition is still pending as per the petitioner institution. The petitioner has waited sufficiently for period of 90 days as per Section 10 of NCMEI Act, 2004, before filing this petition.

3. The petitioner has filed Certificate dated 18.7.2024 issued by ICSE granting affiliation to the petitioner institution which is valid upto 31.3.2029.

4. Petitioner has filed Resolution Passed by the Governing Body to obtain Minority Status Certificate from this Commission and envelope with postage for sending notice to the State Competent Authority.

5. It also transpires from the petition that the petitioner Institute is un-aided institution (Secondary Education).

6. During the academic year 2022-23, out of 1131 students, 79 students were from the Christian minority community, in the year 2023-24, out of 1370 students, 94 students were from the Christian minority community and in the year 2024-25, out of 1525 students, 109 students were from the Christian minority community.

7. It transpires from the record that the Memorandum of Association of the petitioner Society does not reflect the beneficiary clause.

8. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh petition for the same relief. Leave and liberty is granted. The petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
