An email dated 5.3.2025 has been received from 'nodalofficerobc@mp.gov.in' attaching therewith a copy of the letter dated 4.3.2025 of Dy. Director, Backward classes and Minorities Welfare, Madhya Pradesh, which is taken on record.

It is stated in the said letter that due to non-receipt of the application in the prescribed format along with all the relevant documents, no action could be taken for granting minority status certificate to the petitioner institution.

It transpires from the record that the petitioner institution has filed an application dated 21.08.2024 before the competent authority of the State Government for No Objection Certificate.

The respondent has not murmured a single word with regard to the receipt and further process of the application for No Objection Certificate filed by the petitioner institution.

Section 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 clearly state that subject to the provisions contained in any other law for the time being in force, any person, who desires to establish a Minority Educational Institution may apply to the competent authority for the grant of No Objection Certificate for the said purpose.

Where within a period of 90 days from the receipt of the application, if the competent authority does not grant NOC or application has been rejected but not communicated to the applicant, it shall be deemed that NOC has been granted and the applicant can file an application for grant of MSC straightaway to this Commission.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 3945 of 2018 in case of Sisters of St. Joseph of Cluny vs. The State of West Bengal and Ors. vide order dated 18.04.2018, has held that any person who desires to establish a minority educational institution after the amendment Act of 2006 came into force, must apply only to the competent authority for grant of No Objection Certificate for the said purpose.

All applications for the establishment of a minority educational institution after the amendment Act of 2006 must go to the competent authority set up under the statute.
